

instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is receipted by our office before any penalties apply. The bank requires time to process the payment and advise the Town.

Reminder to Balgonie Residents:

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property.

All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.

TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS are open to the public. They are regularly scheduled on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of every month starting at 6:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Balgonie Administration Building.

Council meetings are scheduled for July 11th, 2016.

TAX NOTICES

Please note that Tax Notices have been mailed to property owners on June 23, 2016. Taxes are due on December 31/16. There is a 5% discount on the Municipal portion if received by our office prior to August 31, 2016. Payments can be made by cash, debit, cheque, or internet banking. Construction, Roads, Travel Times and Conditions

The Regina Bypass Project is currently in full swing. This has caused speed reductions, one lane traffic and some temporary lights at highway intersections. Understandably, this can cause confusion and tempers may flare as the work is proceeding.

This monumental project will be completed eventually – the difficulties of today will result in a safer and more efficient traffic corridor.

Things to keep in mind during this challenging period:

- ®Expect delays
- [®]The reduced speeds are to prevent injuries to workers.
- [®]If you must use a cell phone, use a hands free device.
- [®]Pay attention for new signage and lights.
- [®]Show respect for those working on the road.



Every day, thousands of road construction workers in our province are depending on you to drive responsibly and keep them safe in a construction zone.

These road construction workers do their part to keep you out of harm's way from heavy equipment and road hazards. However, they are vulnerable to passing traffic or distracted drivers. There is literally nothing between them and the thousands of pounds of steel in your vehicle. Please, do your part to keep them safe.

Everyone deserves to go home safely to their families and friends at the end of the day. Please slow down, stay alert and show respect for those making improvements to our roadways and infrastructure – for their sake, and yours.

ROAD RAGE is a term that has become popular to describe angry, hostile reactions when driving that are directed toward other drivers. Ranging from acts of true violence (such as using the auto mobile as a weapon or physically assaulting another driver) to aggressive tailgating and gesturing, road rage is on the rise all over the world.



Experts agree that crowding of roads and highways

is one reason people resort to road rage. The construction of new roads has not kept pace with the number of cars, leaving today's drivers feeling more cramped than ever. The territorial nature of humans - to react defensively when we feel that our spaces have been invaded - certainly also plays a role. Finally, the anonymity and security of having a ton of steel between us and the outside world can embolden even the usually timid driver and remove the inhibitions one might normally feel about aggressive or inappropriate behavior.

Both victims and perpetrators of road rage are most likely to be young males, but road rage occurs across all ages and genders. It is most common in urban areas where overcrowding of roadways is greatest. Up to 90% of people report having been the victim of an aggressive act by another driver, and over half admit to having acted aggressively themselves.

If you are overcome with anger while driving, try to remain calm and regain control over your emotions. The following tips can help tame anger on the roadways:

- 1. Remember that safety is the number one concern for you, other drivers and/or pedestrians.
- 2. To control an angry, adrenaline-driven response, focus on your <u>breathing</u>. Pay attention to each breath as it goes in and out and maintain a normal breathing rhythm.
- 3. Recognize that an aggressive driver is just unleashing his or her anger on the rest of the world and *not at you* specifically. Don't personalize the incident.
- 4. Keep in mind that, unless you are a police officer, it isn't your job to punish others for poor driving.
- 5. Accept the fact that mistakes occur. We all make them, and maybe what you perceived as an aggressive act was a simple mistake.
- 6. Refuse to allow another driver someone you do not know and will probably never see again to dictate your mood and determine the quality of your day.
- 7. If you feel out of control, find a safe place to pull over, stop and unwind. An angry or stressed-out driver is a potentially dangerous driver.

The 2015 Saskatchewan Driver's Handbook has the following suggestions for avoiding road rage situations.

Don't cut off other drivers.

Don't drive slowly in the left (fast) lane.

Don't tailgate.

Don't make gestures to other drivers.

Use your horn for emergencies only.

Avoid eye contact with an angry driver.

Give an angry driver plenty of space.



Division Boundary Realignment and the RM of Edenwold

Council has provided a plan that would see a restructuring of the current six division boundaries beginning in 2016. These alterations will see Emerald Park become its own Division 3 in 2016 with another scheduled modification of divisional boundaries for 2018.

<u>Our goal in this</u>: for there to be a more equitable balance of representation by population amongst the divisional boundaries; as well as, recognizing the diversity and geographical area of the Municipality and the need for fair representation for all ratepayers of the Municipality.

As part of coming up with the well thought out plan, council members had discussions in chambers, one-on-one with ratepayers and hosted public meetings to get feedback to fully flush out the issues amongst ratepayers and council members.

We believe this final decision is in the very best interest of our ratepayers.

With Division 1, 3 and 5 up this year for election it was decided this was the perfect opportunity to adjust the east side of the Municipality and address the requests we have been receiving for a representative on Council for Emerald Park. Therefore the divisional boundary proposal is to divide Divisions 1, 3 and 5 into 2 divisions, namely Division 1 and 5 with Tp Rd 182 as the north/south division line (located one mile north of the Town of Balgonie and 1.5 miles North of the Town of Pilot Butte). Division 3 will become the new division for Emerald Park. Then in 2018 the proposal is that we will realign the west half of the Municipality by moving the Division 6 boundary south to Tp Rd 182 and Division 2 border north to Hwy #1 which will make the new Division 4 to be in between Hwy #1 and Tp Rd 182, Division 3 will also be realigned to include all of Aspen Village Drive. The phasing of the divisional boundary realignment will provide a balanced reconfiguration by ensuring there are always members of the current council at the table as the transition occurs from 2016 to 2018. Detailed descriptions with maps are located on our website www.rmedenwold.ca

Fast facts on Division boundaries and the RM:

- * There are six divisions within the RM each represented by a councillor. The council is made up of six Councillors and one Reeve. This seven-person council was set up under the legal structure and framework provisions of *The Municipalities Act*.
- * Five council seat positions will be up for election on October 26th, 2016, namely Councillors for Divisions 1, 3, 4, 5 and the Reeve of the Municipality.
- * Any ratepayer within the RM can run for a council seat anywhere within the RM as long as they meet the requirements to be a qualified candidate. Ratepayers, who are eligible to vote, vote for the Councillor within their polling division. The voting process ensures you get to choose your representatives with the votes you cast.
- * The RM of Edenwold is currently represented by:

Division 1 – Grant Fahlman Division 2 – Stan Capnerhurst

Division 3 – Craig Strudwick Division 4 – Lorne Beer

Division 5 – Dwayne Radmacher Division 6 – Tim Brodt

Reeve Mitchell Huber

- * All Councillors and the Reeve are aware of what is happening in each division within the RM and make informed decisions for the **entire** RM at the council table. Council meetings are held twice monthly. Council members also sit on various sub-committees and they make themselves available to ratepayers.
- * The Council works closely with their administration team of four people plus two planners, two community safety officers and a maintenance staff of fourteen, who all work to ensure services are delivered to ratepayers consistently, effectively and efficiently throughout the RM.
