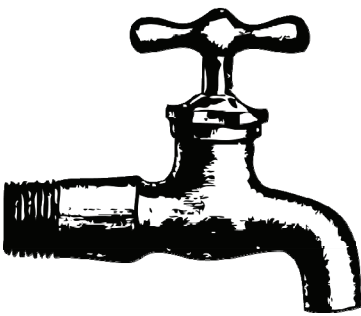
ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS:

Recreational Vehicle Parking

There are now seasonal restrictions on the parking and storage of recreational vehicles such as campers and motor homes which are used for travelling and recreational activities.

No more than 2 recreational vehicles may be parked in the front, rear or side yards on a drive way on residential sites from April 1 to November 1 inclusive, and these vehicles can not be within 2 meters (6.57 feet) of the outside edge of the curb.

Council is concerned about the safety of other residents when these large recreational vehicles are parked on roads and driveways and could possibly be impeding on people's sight lines while walking, or driving.



Just a friendly reminder that grass clippings and branches are not to be left in back alleys , put into your garbage containers or surrounding ditches. Please bag your clippings and take to the designated area at the transfer station.

With the nice weather upon us, it's time to get our yards cleaned up and looking beautiful. Please remove all garbage, and unsightly items . Keeping grass cut, and weeds to a minimal helps to keep the town looking nice.

Yards that are not maintained will be sent letters from the Town asking to clean them up.



BE A RESPONSIBLE PET OWNER:

- Walk your dog on a leash, always.
- **There is no off leash area in the Town of Balgonie.**
- Pick up after your dog—bring a baggy, pick it up and dispose of it.
- Spay /neuter your pet.
- License your pet with the Town .



Fines are applicable if your dog is found unlicensed, running at large or if you fail to pick up after your dog.

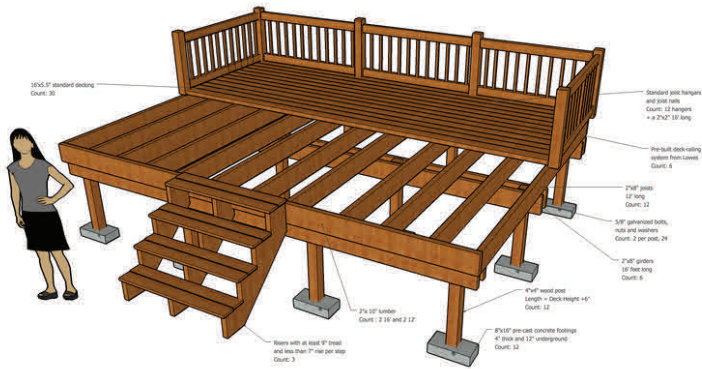

Chemical – Health Category

All waterworks serving 5000 persons or more are required to submit water samples for Saskatchewan Environment's "Chemical Health" based on population size. The "Chemical Health" category includes analysis for arsenic, barium, boron, cadmium, chromium, fluoride, lead, nitrate, selenium and uranium.

Permits

The Town of Balgonie requires building permits for anyone building houses, accessory buildings, renovations and decks. Please ensure that you have completed the paperwork with the Town before starting construction.

Permits are also required if you will be moving a structure or demolishing a structure on your property.

Applications can be obtained at the Town Office and permits will be issued once they have been reviewed and approved by the Town and the Building Inspector. Please speak to staff at the Town Office to ensure that you have the information BEFORE moving, demolishing or constructing. The planned construction needs to comply with our Zoning Bylaw and be authorized for development. Please ensure that you have submitted these forms in advance of your project. There may be 2– 3 weeks after submission until a decision has been reached regarding your application.

Accessory Building: \$200.00

(non—insulated)

Addition: \$800

Deck: \$200

Garage detached: \$200.00

(non– insulated)

Garage detached: \$400.00

(insulated)

Demolition: \$200.00

(\$500 refundable clean-up fee)

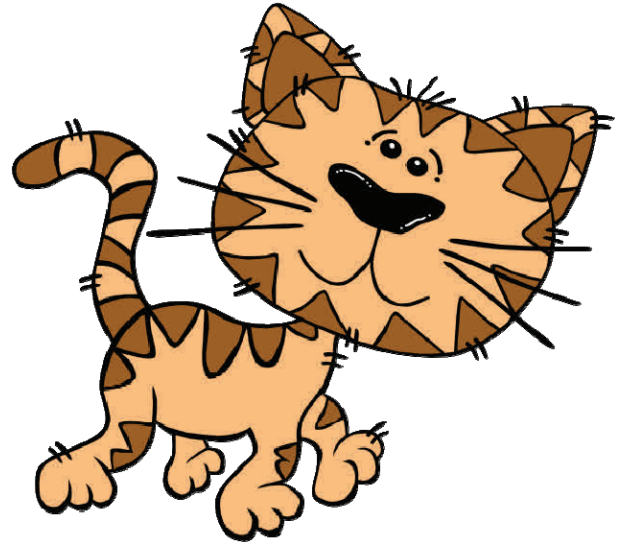
Moving a building: \$250.00

(\$500.00 refundable clean -up fee)

These costs may change dependent on fees charged to the Town by Professional Building Inspections.

Trimming and removing trees:

Before cutting down any trees, please note the following:

- Residents must receive permission from the town to remove any trees which are on "Town Property".
- depending on your lot, the first number of meters from the curb, is considered Town Property.
- Elm trees must not be pruned between April 30th—August 31st.
- SaskPower will trim trees in danger of coming into contact with power lines. You may submit a request for them to trim trees on line at saskpower.com or by phoning them at 310-2120.

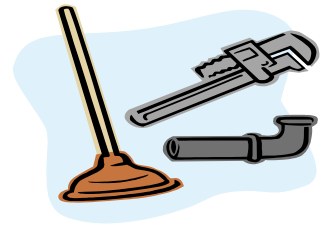

Fats, Oils, and Grease -

Store it, don't pour it.

Pouring fats, oils, and grease down your drain can cause significant problems in your home sewer system as it solidifies in your pipes and causes sewer back up. The result can be property damage and considerable expense and inconvenience to you and to the Town of Balgonie. Used cooking oils and grease should be cooled and put into a container with a lid for storage that can be put into the garbage receptacle.



Blocked Sewer Drains:

Blockages in the sewer lines are the homeowner's responsibility. The Town of Balgonie may issue a reimbursement for sewer cleanout only if it is on the Town portion and due to tree roots. The Town of Balgonie should be called to have an employee present when the plumbing company inspects the line. Please call our office to arrange this: 306-771-2284 or after hours 306-535-4235.

Reimbursement for the plumbing costs will not be paid if our office is not called, or if the blockage is due to disposal of improper items.

All of the above items have been found in Town sewer lift station screens and have caused drainage issues. These materials do not "break down" in the sewer system. These items travel down the sewer system and combine with other items and cause a blockage at some point in the line. These blockages cost property owners directly through blockages to their homes or indirectly through the costs to the Town for removal.

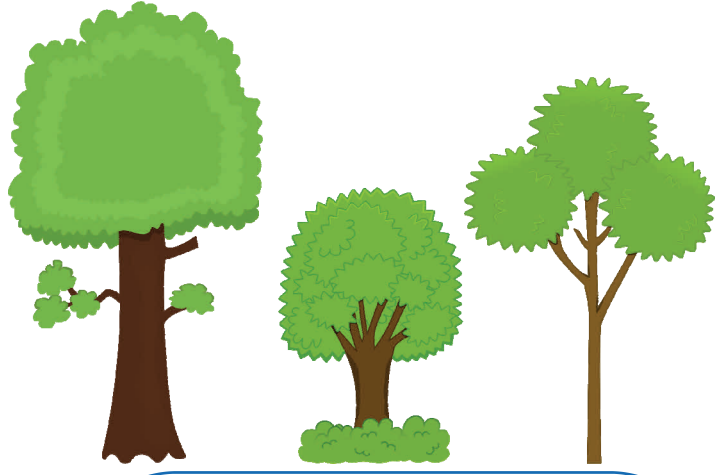

TRANSFER STATION

The TRANSFER STATION is electronically set up to provide our town residents with accessibility day or night. The Town of Balgonie offers these services on site at the TRANSFER STATION, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not disposing of things in the manner set forth by the Provincial Ministry of Environment and the Provincial Clean Air Act.

Recently, items have been left at the TRANSFER STATION which are not permitted. Please ensure that you read and understand what items are allowed and not allowed to be left at the TRANSFER STATION. Individuals who leave items which are not allowed will be required to clean up the improper disposal, and/or pay charges for the Town to remove the items. The transfer station cards can be cancelled at the discretion of the Council of the Town of Balgonie.

THE TRANSFER STATION IS NOT A GARBAGE DUMP!

The Transfer Station is a location where the following items can be left:

Scrap Metal

Tree Branches and Grass Clippings (removed from the plastic bags)

Compostable materials

Oil and Containers - There is now an oil recycling centre station where you are able to dump unused oils and their containers on the south side of the station.

The first Friday of every month, a Loraas bin is delivered to the transfer station. This is for town residents to use for the items which are too large for the household carts. Please note, this is only to be used by Balgonie residents. Larger loads due to fence removal, renovation etc, should be taken to the Regina landfill.

If the bins is full or not at the site, do not leave items, take them to the landfill.

Key cards, which are lost, should be reported to the Town Office. They will be removed from the computer system and a new card will be issued at a cost to you of \$25.00. If you are moving, please return the key card to the Town Office. Diabetes also have clothing bins to take donations.

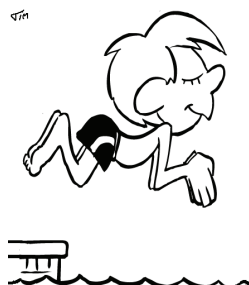

TENT CATERPILLARS

Got worms? Some residents have reported large clusters of caterpillar larvae nesting in trees around town. The Town has consulted with the Ministry of Environment and have learned that there is a high number of Tent Caterpillars all over Saskatchewan. The Caterpillars will not kill the trees they nest in, they eat the leaves until they cocoon in mid-June. The trees affected will re-leaf once the caterpillars become moths. Our maintenance staff will be using BTK to spray the Town trees only. If you have them on your property, a natural method to get rid of tent caterpillars is simply vegetable oil. Use vegetable oil and pour it into a small spray bottle. Just spray it onto the caterpillar nest later in the evening when they have all come in to sleep for the night. It will kill them quickly because the insects breath through their skin. Once they are coated in oil they can no longer breath.

Tent caterpillar larvae feed on the leaves of most deciduous trees and shrubs, but especially crab apples, ash, aspens and wild cherry trees.
