The Town of Balgonie is well maintained, growing community located 25 km East of Regina, just off of Highway #1 and Highway #46. The Town of Balgonie also uses [Voyent Alert](#) to communicate critical and timely notices directly to your cell phone, email or home phone. Download the Voyent Alert app to receive alerts via SMS text, email or your home phone.

TAXES & UTILITIES

Tax notices are sent out in June or July of each year. A 5% discount is offered on the municipal portion of taxes until August 31 and taxes are due in full by December 31. A connection fee of \$75 is applied to all new utility accounts. Utility bills are sent out quarterly (January, April, July and October) and are due within 30 days of the date of the bill.

The [Customer Portal](#) provides residents with the ability to view balances owing on utilities and taxes. Residents have the ability to view notices, invoices, and receipts sent by the Town Office. To sign up for the Customer Portal, please fill out Email Consent Form on page 10 and contact the Town Office for your Customer Number. Payment Options:

Online: Set up Town of Balgonie Utilities AND Town of Balgonie Taxes as payees through your online banking. If you are unsure of your account number, please contact the Town Office to obtain it.

In person: We accept debit, cheque or cash. Credit cards are not accepted in the office.

Credit Cards: Go to www.townofbalgonie.ca and pay with Plastiq on the bottom right hand side of the screen. Please note that there are fees associated with this payment method.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION & TRANSFER STATION

Curbside Collection:

The Town provides **compost** (green bin) pickup on Fridays. From April—October, compost is picked up every Friday and from November—March, compost is picked up on the **third** Friday of every month.

The Town provides alternating **garbage** (black bin) and **recycling** (blue bin) pickup on Tuesdays. Garbage one week and recycling the following week.

Bins are to be placed on the curb by 7:00 a.m. and retrieved by 5:00 p.m. If bins are damaged outside of these hours, homeowners are responsible for the cost to replace them.

Transfer Station:

The Town of Balgonie has a Transfer Station that is located on the north side of the train tracks. THIS IS STRICTLY A TRANSFER STATION, NOT A DUMP.

The Transfer Station is for Town Residents only and is accessible by a Transfer Station card. Each card is registered to an address; however, if you have recently purchased a home, please contact the Town Office to pick up a card.

Year round, the Transfer Station accepts trees, untreated wood, grass clippings (not in bags), metal and recycled oil. All items listed have a designated area and are clearly marked. Please place items in the appropriate places.

On the first and third Friday of every month, a 40-yard Loraas bin is placed at the site for all other items.

DO NOT leave items if the bin is too full and/or unavailable. The Transfer Station is monitored. Fines have been, and will be issued for illegal dumping.

WIRELESS WATER FILL STATION

The Town of Balgonie has a Wireless Water Fill Station, located on the corner of King Street and Railway Street. It is a prepaid system that is available 24/7 to residents and non-residents.

What do you need? A 2” female cam lock is required on your hose to connect to the Water Fill Station (WFS).

How does it work? This system will only work with a prepaid fob and online account, which the Town Office can provide to you. Once you have your account set up, you can start and stop the pump, make a payment online via credit card to increase your prepaid account balance and view transaction reports.

Ensure your hose is connected to the WFS and is placed in your tank prior to starting the pump. When ready, use your fob to start and stop the system once you are satisfied with the amount of water. The system is set up to automatically shut off after 10 minutes. If this happens, simply start the pump again!

COMMUNITY SAFETY OFFICERS

Balgonie has Community Safety Officers (CSO’s) who patrol our community and help to keep us safe with bylaw enforcement and traffic control. A listing of the Town’s Bylaws can be found on our website.

The RCMP Detachment is located in Emerald Park and they patrol Balgonie and area regularly.

TOWN OF BALGONIE COUNCIL MEETINGS

The Town of Balgonie Council meetings are regularly scheduled for the 2nd and 4th Monday of every month. They are held in the Council Chambers of the Administration Building at 129 Railway St. E. in Balgonie, SK. These meetings are open for the public to attend. Although Council members usually attend in person, occasionally they will appear via electronic means. Delegations may be scheduled to speak to Council directly by requesting an appointment with the Town Office.

MAJOR COMMUNITY EVENTS

Tumbleweed Theatre Annual Dinner Theatre

Balgonie is very proud of the Annual Dinner Theatre that is put on every year! The performances take place at the Multiplex the first two weekends in November. Tumbleweed Theatre, which is a 100% volunteer-run group, organizes the production and the 3-course meal. The evening starts with a salad bar followed by the main course, which is a delicious roast beef dinner and all of the fixings. After the first act of the play, a huge dessert selection is available to enjoy, and is then followed by the second act.

The community is canvassed in October for food donations and volunteers to help serve and prepare the food. The entire meal is prepared in the Multiplex by volunteers and community group serve a variety of drinks from the bar.

All of the money raised from the Dinner Theatre stays right here in Balgonie! It takes many volunteer hours, dedication and heart for this event to take place, but it is a wonderful way to meet people from our community!

Balgonie Elks July 1st Family Fun Day

The Balgonie Elks proudly puts on a July 1st Family Fun Day every year! It often includes a parade, food/ice cream trucks, petting zoos, bouncy castles, sand searches, family games, an antique tractor pull, pool activities and beer gardens!

DID YOU KNOW?

The Transfer Station is set up with an electronic card system which allows residents to access it 24/7.

On the 1st and 3rd Friday of each month, Loraas Disposal delivers a 40-yard bin to the Transfer Station. The purpose of the 40-yard bin is to allow residents to dispose of additional household waste that does not fit in their black roll-out bin.

Unaccepted items

- Shingles;
- Railway ties, telephone poles and creosote treated wood;
- Bulbs and Light Ballasts;
- Hazardous materials such as tires, propane tanks, car batteries, paint, oil and chemicals;
- Appliances containing Freon;
- Construction/renovation material;
- Waste from households outside of Balgonie.

Please note: the unaccepted items listed above pertain to the 40-yard bin only. There are designated areas at the transfer station where some items listed above are accepted.

Who can use your transfer station card?

- Members of your household can use it.
- Lending your card out to another person and/or disposing of waste from households outside of Balgonie is not permitted.
- The cardholder will be held accountable for all occurrences at the transfer station, such as illegal dumping.

Illegal dumping

The Town of Balgonie has the responsibility to ensure regulations are followed based on the Approval to Operate issued to the Town by the Ministry of Environment.

Public Works Staff inspect the Transfer Station every morning. If it is determined that an illegal dump has taken place and/or items are placed in the incorrect disposal area, an investigation will commence. The resident at fault will be fined and their access card will be suspended for up to 6 months.

Disposing of large items

When residents dispose of large items such as couches, mattresses, and box springs in the 40-yard bin:

- it limits another resident's ability to dispose of their items in the bin;
- the bin is removed from the Transfer Station quicker, creating a longer waiting period for when it is scheduled to return.

In addition to the inconvenience it causes others by placing large items in the bin, the Town of Balgonie is required to pay a burial surcharge to Loraas Disposal if there are more than 4 pieces of bedding per load (mattresses and box springs), wood or metal longer than 7' or coils of wire or banding.

Designated disposal areas

Cement Pile

- Cement free of other debris may be disposed of.

Metal Pile

- All appliances and metal are permitted. Ensure the Freon is removed from fridges/freezers.
- Propane tanks are permitted.

Grass/Leaves

- Bags and boxes are not permitted in this pile.

Trees, Branches and Untreated Wood Pile

- Treated wood, painted wood, cardboard, drywall etc. are not permitted in this pile.

Oil Recycling Centre

- Empty oil into the oil recycling bin.
- Place the oil containers and filters in the bin next to the oil recycling bin.

Diabetes Canada Clothing Bin

- Do not leave bags beside the bin if it is full.

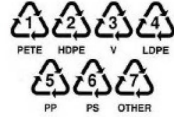

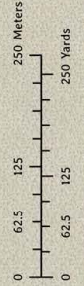

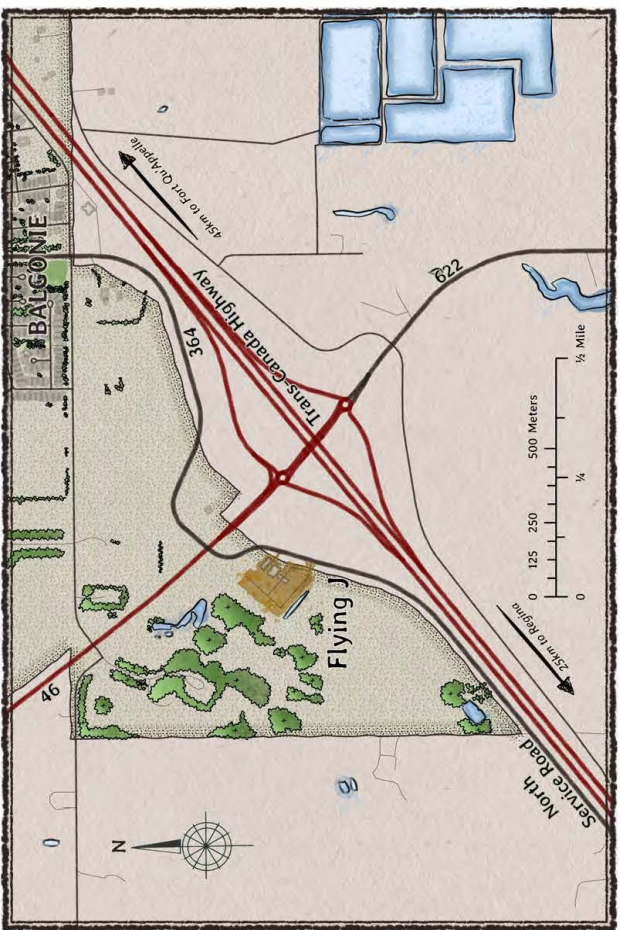
