Recreational Vehicle Parking

There are now seasonal restrictions on the parking and storage of recreational vehicles such as campers and motor homes which are used for travelling and recreational activities.

No more than 2 recreational vehicles may be parked in the front, rear or side yards on a drive way on residential sites from April 1 to November 1 inclusive, and these vehicles can not be within 2 meters (6.57 feet) of the outside edge of the curb.

Council is concerned about the safety of other residents when these large recreational vehicles are parked on roads and driveways and could possibly be impeding on people's sight lines while walking, or driving.



Dear Resident:

Balgonie Town Council has amended the Traffic Bylaw 178/1990. The amendment changes the definition of "heavy vehicles" to be vehicles over 5000 kg. The Bylaw was passed on April 23rd, 2018.

<u>Vehicles over 5000 kg will not be permitted to travel on public streets within Town limits except in the</u> following circumstances:



- While such heavy vehicle is making collection or delivery, provided that the operator proceeds
 by the most direct route to or from the point of collection or delivery, as the case may be, to or
 from the nearest heavy vehicle route.
- While such heavy vehicle is being operated in the service of the Town—this includes municipally owned vehicles, emergency services or contracted services.
- A recreational vehicle, provided that the operator proceeds by the most direct route to
 or from a residence or business, to or from the nearest heavy vehicle route.
 Recreational vehicles are not permitted to be parked on residential streets. They may
 be parked in the front yards of private property from April 2 to October 31.
- School buses, provided that the operator drives along the acceptable bus route provided by the Municipality to the School board.
- Penalties for contravening the bylaw will be:

First offence \$100.00
 Second offence \$200.00
 Third offence \$300.00

These penalties will be enforced by the Community Safety Officers.

Property Tax Notices will be mailed out to property owners in the month of June. Last year property taxes were impacted significantly due to the revaluation of assessments as well as the increase to the Education Tax Mill rate.

In 2018, the Education Tax Mill rate will remain the same as 2017.

After being able to hold the Municipal Tax Mill rate steady in 2017, in 2018, there will be a modest rate increase of 0.25. The increase in taxation revenue to the Town will be a total of \$46,121.

The decision to increase the mill rate was made to replace operational revenues which were reduced to the Town for revenue sharing and grants in lieu of taxes. The 2017/18 and the 2018/19 Provincial budgets decreased the per capita amounts in revenue sharing to the Town. The Town will receive a reduction from the previous year in revenue sharing by \$ 25,670. Last year, grants in lieu of taxes that were removed from the Town in 2017/18 Provincial Budget were just under \$30,000. Total revenue lost to the Town has been over \$55,000.

Revenue sharing grants are based on the population recorded in the Census. Although, the Town's population has increased by 140 people in the 2016 Census, Revenue sharing has decreased on a per capita basis. The total to be received in 2018/19 will be less than the total received in 2013/14 while the population increased by 381 from 2011 census to 2016.

TRANSFER STATION

The Town Transfer Station will have spring clean up bins provided in the month of May. The TRANSFER STATION is electronically set up to provide our town residents with accessibility day or night. The Town of Balgonie offers these services on site at the TRANSFER STATION, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not disposing of things in the manner set forth by the Provincial Ministry of Environment and the Provincial Clean Air Act.

Recently, items have been left at the TRANSFER STATION which are not permitted. Please ensure that you read and understand what items are allowed and not allowed to be left at the TRANSFER STATION.

Individuals who leave items which are not allowed will be required to clean up the improper disposal, and/ or pay charges for the Town to remove the items. The transfer station cards can be cancelled at the discretion of the Council of the Town of Balgonie.

THE TRANSFER STATION IS NOT A GARBAGE DUMP!

The Transfer Station is a location where the following items can be left:

Scrap Metal

Tree Branches and Grass Clippings (removed from the plastic bags)

Compostable materials

Oil and Containers - There is now an oil recycling centre station where you are able to dump unused oils and their containers on the south side of the station.

The first Friday of every month, a Loraas bin is delivered to the transfer station. This is for town residents to use for the items which are too large for the household carts. Please note, this is only to be used by Balgonie residents. Larger loads due to fence removal, renovation etc, should be taken to the Regina landfill.

If the bins is full or not at the site, do not leave items, take them to the landfill.

Key cards, which are lost, should be reported to the Town Office. They will be removed from the computer system and a new card will be issued at a cost to you of \$25.00. If you are moving, please return the key card to the Town Office. Diabetes also have clothing bins to take donations.

THERE ARE CAMERAS AT THE TRANSFER STATION. ANY PERSON WHO MISUSES THIS SERVICE WILL BE FINED AND HAVE THEIR CARD PRIVLEDGES REVOKED.

REMINDER:

Garbage and Recycling Carts are to be put out on the street on or BEFORE 7am, and brought in after garbage or recycling collection is complete. If carts are damaged before or after these hours, homeowners are responsible for the charges. As we are not the only town with these services, there is no specific time other than by 7:00a.m. to be prepared for pick-up. If you miss pick-up because your container is NOT at the curb on time, it will be the owner's responsibility to dispose of the contents if required.

Loraas Bins

There will be Loraas bins available at the transfer station on the 1st and 3rd Friday of every month for town residents only. Our transfer station is equipped with security cameras, as well as a card reader. Fines have been laid for illegal dumping, and will continue to be laid to any person who violates these rules.

The TRANSFER STATION is electronically set up to provide our town residents with accessibility day or night. The Town of Balgonie offers these services on site at the TRANSFER STATION, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not disposing of things in the manner set forth by the Provincial Ministry of Environment and the Provincial Clean Air Act.

Recently, items have been left at the TRANSFER STATION which are not permitted. Please ensure that you read and understand what items are allowed and not allowed to be left at the TRANSFER STATION. Reminder to Balgonie Residents:

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours, except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property.

All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.




ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS:



RM responds to survey sent out to RM residents

We are aware that a survey has been distributed by the town of White City to gather information from the community. This survey was delivered door-to-door to residents of not only the town, but also Emerald Park, and the



surrounding residential subdivisions of Escott/Deneve, Park Meadows, and Meadow Ridge, all of which are within the jurisdiction of the RM of Edenwold. RM staff and council feel the survey was meant to direct members of the community to a specific conclusion. We are disappointed to have not been included in the survey design process to ensure RM viewpoints were represented accurately. The RM encourages any ratepayers who would like to, to feel free to contact our office at any time to discuss the survey or the topics being discussed. In spring 2017, the RM of Edenwold's Planning Department held five public meetings and distributed a comprehensive survey to get input from both residents and business operators. A follow-up survey was then hand-delivered to businesses in the summer of 2017. Your input —gathered in 2017— is invaluable and will help inform policy and our new Official Community Plan.

After public consultation and council discussion, divisional boundaries for divisions 2, 3, 4 and 6 have been altered. The last of three public meetings on the topic boundary realignment was held March 21 in Emerald Park with twelve residents attending.

"This year, elections for even numbered divisions will be held in October," says Kim McIvor, Chief Administrative Officer with the RM of Edenwold. "With changing demographics within the RM, the boundary realignment addresses changing population densities and the RM's geographical diversity."

"This change completes a two phase solution approach, which began in 2016 with the redrawing of divisional boundaries to create a fully changed Division 3," explains Reeve Mitchell Huber. "With phase two now completed, we thank our residents for participating in public meetings and engaging in discussions with staff and council members. The work done here shows we're listening as a council and that our community is engaged." Maps showing the revised boundaries can be found on the RM website. Nomination day is September 19 - the day candidates must announce they are running in municipal elections.


