A message from the RM of Edenwold

About the annexation proposal

The RM of Edenwold was informed May 15 that White City has put forward a proposal for the annexation of Emerald Park and other parcels of lands and estates including Park Meadows, Escott/Deneve, Meadow Ridge, Great Plains Industrial Park and Prairie View Business Park. RM staff and council will take time to review the proposal.

In the meantime, we have posted some information on our website about annexation and water/sewer and tax comparisons. A public engagement meeting is being hosted by the town June 6. Several businesses within the RM of Edenwold involve the service and sale of large and oversize equipment. With the new Highway 1 overpasses in place, the RM set up a meeting with the businesses involved in heavy or oversized hauling to talk about how roadways are being used. The meeting brought 20 business owners together with council members to talk and ask questions.

The object of the meeting was to gather feedback on the functionality of the road network and determine priorities for tweaks and changes to make everything work better for heavy truck traffic.

Among several concerns, the RM heard that, even with the overpasses in place at Pilot Butte and Balgonie, businesses are using the Highway 48 overpass and the RM of Edenwold roads from Highway 33 through to Viterra Road (aka Highway 624, Richardson Rd.) to South Plains Road and Great Plains Road to access businesses.

The RM will recommend that MOH and RBDB engage in a public awareness campaign to detail how the overpasses fit equipment and to let the driving public know how they can interact on those overpasses with oversized trucks and equipment.

Cannabis survey results

Council has reviewed the results of the recent cannabis survey sent out to ratepayers and business owners. A summary will soon be posted on the RM website. Here is a short overview of survey results:

EDENWOLD

DID YOU KNOW?....

The RM of Edenwold pays recreation fees to White City and other municipalities.


Grant money is paid to our municipal neighbours based on the number of facilities they have and the type of facilities

In 2018, those grant numbers break out as follows: Balgonie - \$25,600, Pilot Butte - \$15,000, White City - \$18,000, village of Edenwold - \$4,000 = total of: \$62,600

Over the last twenty years those grants represent hundreds of thousands of dollars.

The RM of Edenwold also pays library taxes to keep the local libraries (Southeast Regional Library branches) viable. In 2017, that amounted to \$46,000 for the White City, Balgonie and Pilot Butte libraries.

And, as good neighbours, the RM has also kicked in \$21,000 for the White City library renovation (2017), \$30,000 (2013) for the football field at White City School and in 2012, donated \$1,500 for fencing and \$3,000 for a security camera at the White City Skate Park.



- 63.8% of respondents felt it was very important to consider the impacts of cannabis use/sales on adjacent properties.
- 49.23% of respondents felt that a retail stores should be located in industrial areas set back from highways
- 41.54% of respondents felt that a retail store should be located in high profile commercial districts in Emerald Park.



Balgonie Volunteer Firefighters and First Responders

Did you know.....the Balgonie Volunteer Fire Department was first established sometime in the mid 1920's? In 1939 the first fire truck was purchased and in 1956 the first Fire Hall was built. We believe the first Fire Chief was Isaac Curry. In 1983 the Balgonie First Responders where formed and became another facet of the fire department. Over half of our members are dual trained, fire and medical. Our medical first responders take a 40 hour course, as a minimum to become a first responder, with most of our crew trained to a higher level.

Since the beginning of the fire department, we have responded to over 2000 calls for service. As volunteer firefighters, we take the same training that career firefighters take, it just takes us longer. We respond to structure fires, car fires, car accidents, diabetics, heart attacks, head injuries, sprains, broken hips, floods, wind storms, grass fires, plane accidents....well pretty much everything ③. When you call 911, your call is answered in Prince Albert by the Sask 911 operators. As they take your request for help, they are dispatching the appropriate help. The firefighters and medical first responders of your community receive activations via their cells phones by a text and phone call.
