
Taxes and Utility bills may be paid electronically through your online banking website.

TENT WORMS

Got worms? Some residents have reported large clusters of caterpillar larvae nesting in threes around town. The caterpillars will not kill the trees they nest in, they eat the leaves until they cocoon in mid-June. The trees affected will re-leaf once the caterpillars become moths.

Out maintenance staff will be spraying the town the week of May 29th. If you have them on your property, a natural method to get rid of tent caterpillars is simply vegetable oil, or soap and water. Pour into a small spray bottle. Spray onto the caterpillar nest later in the evening when they have all come in to sleep for the night. It will kill them quickly because the insects breath through their skin. One they are coated in the oil or soap water, they can no longer breath.

Tent caterpillar larvae feed on the leaves of most deciduous threes and shrubs, but especially crab apples, ash, aspens and wild cherry trees.



A message from the RM of Edenwold

Fire agreements signed

At the May 9 council meeting, fire protection and emergency services agreements were signed with our urban neighbours the Town of Balgonie, Town of Pilot Butte, Town of White City and Village of Edenwold. "By signing these agreements we were able to move past the interim agreements and finalize things for 2017," says Chief Administrative Officer Kim McIvor. "We have been working



hard as a group to come up with a fair and equitable way to share the costs of providing fire and emergency services to all residents and business communities within the White Butte region." The Town of White City will receive: \$88,433, the Town's Balgonie and Pilot Butte have both been allocated \$55,000 and \$15,000 will be paid to the Village of Edenwold for 2017. The signed agreements represent many months of discussions and negotiations with the White Butte Fire Commission members and the fire chiefs. A long-term agreement is still in the works. "We are very pleased to work with and support the committed volunteers of the local fire departments and their members who are willing to help their communities in the times they need them the most," says McIvor.

Community engages in Official Community Plan

RM Planners Jana Jedlic and Paige Phillips gave council an overview of the findings from early community engagement meetings and the survey tool used to update the RM's Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw. "We heard a lot of different feedback, depending on the area of the RM the residents were from," says Jedlic. The key emerging themes are: ensure compatible land uses, protect and maintain of the character of residential subdivisions in Emerald Park and acreage developments, encourage and support the development of more recreational amenities, protect prime agricultural lands, improve signage for roadways and business districts and address drainage issues in some areas. "We are going to go back to the business community with a newly developed survey," explains Jedlic. "We want a deeper response base from that sector of the RM." Over 200 residents engaged in the survey process through attendance at meetings and filling out the survey.

Governments of Canada and Saskatchewan support \$6.4-million expansion of Balgonie wastewater system

Balgonie, Saskatchewan, May 23, 2017 — The governments of Canada and Saskatchewan are committed to investing in local infrastructure that provides Canadians and their families with access to modern, reliable water and wastewater services that meet their needs. These investments safeguard the health and well-being of residents, protect provincial waterways and preserve local ecosystems.

Today, the Honourable Ralph Goodale, Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness, on behalf of the Honourable Amarjeet Sohi, Minister of Infrastructure and Communities; and Don McMorris, Indian Head-Milestone MLA, on behalf of the Honourable Donna Harpauer, Minister of Government Relations; announced funding for an estimated \$6.4-million expansion for the Town of Balgonie's wastewater system to better serve the community and position it for growth.

The governments of Canada and Saskatchewan will each contribute up to \$1.5 million toward the project through the New Building Canada Fund's Provincial-Territorial Infrastructure Component – National and Regional Projects (PTIC-NRP). The Town of Balgonie will fund the remainder.

The project includes expanding the existing sewage lagoon and irrigation system, along with related works, that will improve the overall wastewater system and benefit the environment. Once completed, the project will support economic and population growth in the community, providing services for 6,000 potential residents. Construction is expected to begin as early as this summer.


