REMINDER:

Garbage and Recycling Carts are to be put out on the street on or BEFORE 7am, and brought in after garbage or recycling collection is complete. If carts are damaged before or after these hours, homeowners are responsible for the charges. As we are not the only town with these services, there is no specific time other than by 7:00a.m. to be prepared for pick-up. If you miss pick-up because your container is NOT at the curb on time, it will be the owner's responsibility to dispose of the contents if required.

Loraas Bins

There will be Loraas bins available at the transfer station on the 1st and 3rd Friday of every month for town residents only. Our transfer station is equipped with security cameras, as well as a card reader. Fines have been laid for illegal dumping, and will continue to be laid to any person who violates these rules.

The TRANSFER STATION is electronically set up to provide our town residents with accessibility day or night. The Town of Balgonie offers these services on site at the TRANSFER STATION, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not disposing of things in the manner set forth by the Provincial Ministry of Environment and the Provincial Clean Air Act.

Recently, items have been left at the TRANSFER STATION which are not permitted. Please ensure that you read and understand what items are allowed and not allowed to be left at the TRANSFER STATION. Individuals who leave items which are not allowed will be required to clean up the improper disposal, and/or pay charges for the Town to remove the items. There is also a \$500 penalty for illegal dumping at the site. The transfer station cards can be cancelled at the discretion of the Council of the Town of Balgonie.

THE TRANSFER STATION IS NOT A GARBAGE DUMP!

The Transfer Station is a location where the following items can be left: Scrap Metal, Tree Branches and Grass Clippings (removed from the plastic bags) Compostable materials, Oil and Containers - There is an oil recycling center station where you are able to dump unused oils and their containers on the south side of the station.

The 1st & 3rd Friday of every month, a Loraas bin is delivered to the transfer station. This is for town residents to use for the items which are too large for the household carts. Please note, this is only to be used by Balgonie residents. Larger loads due to fence removal, renovation etc, should be taken to the Regina landfill.

If the bin is full or not at the site, do not leave items, take them to the Regina landfill.

Key cards, which are lost, should be reported to the Town Office. They will be removed from the computer system and a new card will be issued at a cost to you of \$25.00. If you are moving, please return the key card to the Town Office. Diabetes also have clothing bins to take donations.

Eyes on the Community

Summer months see an increase in crime and vandalism. If you see property that has been vandalized or have had things stolen, it is very important to report the crime.

"Take pictures of vandalism as soon as you can and provide those to us or to the RCMP," says RM Community Safety Officer Rod Ash.

RM Community Safety Officers enforce municipal bylaws and also have authority under 10 provincial statutes including *The Traffic Safety Act* they can be reached at 306-771-1501. For medical emergencies or other serious crime, call 911 or the White Butte RCMP detachment at 306-781-5050. Rural Crime Watch 158 uses the WhatsApp to track events in the rural areas and you can join via Facebook searching: Rural Crime Watch 158. In order for the RM to process bylaw infraction complaints, a written report needs to be sent to the RM office. Email: rm158@sasktel.net.

Take to the trails

The RM of Edenwold has been selected to receive funding from Trans Canada Trail through the 2018-2019 Capital Improvement Plan, with a maximum funding of \$65,000. The RM is home to a portion of the TCT connecting to the City of Regina, the RM of Sherwood and the RM of North Qu'Appelle. This summer the trail signage in the RM of Edenwold will be replaced with signs featuring the new name: "The Great Trail."

Construction is now underway on the walkway planned adjacent to Great Plains Road, starting at Shoppers Drug Mart and connecting to the Emerald Park Soccer Facility. Work on the pathway is to be completed by the end of July. "The RM wants to extend the Emerald Park pathways to connect in front of our new office on Hutchence Road next year as well," says RM Senior Planner Jana Jedlic.
