




St Joseph's Annual Golf Classic and Dinner

BALGONIE WASTEWATER PROJECT



The Town of Balgonie Wastewater Project is underway for the 2017 Construction season. The Town has awarded the construction to Denny Forbes Incorporated to do the upgrades. Walker Projects, the Town's engineer, has been working with the Town through our grant application process, design of the expansion and project coordination.

Federal, provincial and municipal funds will be contributing to this project. The combined efforts of these three levels of government will ensure that the Town of Balgonie's infrastructure needs are met today and into the future.

The funding will be used to increase our sewage lagoon's capacity, decommission an older cell in the lagoon and to install an additional irrigation system.

New parking requirements for recreational vehicles

The RM of Edenwold has new parking regulations for recreational vehicles.

"The text amendment also allows the RM to establish a maximum permitted number of recreational vehicles in specific zones in the RM. If a property owner would like to store more recreational vehicles then the permitted maximum number, then a discretionary use permit is required and the public notification process would begin," said Paige Boha, Planner/Development Officer with the RM. For Emerald Park, subdivision and estate residents this means parking is prohibited of any motor home, travel trailer, fifth wheel trailer, boat or any similar vehicle in the front yard, including driveways and legal front yard parking stalls November 1 throughout April 1, inclusive. The TRANSFER STATION is electronically set up to provide our town residents with accessibility day or night. The Town of Balgonie offers these services on site at the TRANSFER STATION, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not disposing of things in the manner set forth by the Provincial Ministry of Environment and the Provincial Clean Air Act.

Recently, items have been left at the TRANSFER STATION which are not permitted. Please ensure that you read and understand what items are allowed and not allowed to be left at the TRANSFER STATION. Individuals who leave items which are not allowed will be required to clean up the improper disposal, and/or pay charges for the Town to remove the items. The transfer station cards can be cancelled at the discretion of the Council of the Town of Balgonie.

THE TRANSFER STATION IS NOT A GARBAGE DUMP!

The Transfer Station is a location where the following items can be left:

Scrap Metal

Tree Branches and Grass Clippings (removed from the plastic bags)

Compostable materials

Oil and Containers - There is now an oil recycling centre station where you are able to dump unused oils and their containers on the south side of the station.

The first Friday of every month, a Loraas bin is delivered to the transfer station. This is for town residents to use for the items which are too large for the household carts. Please note, this is only to be used by Balgonie residents. Larger loads due to fence removal, renovation etc, should be taken to the Regina landfill.

If the bins is full or not at the site, do not leave items, take them to the landfill.

Key cards, which are lost, should be reported to the Town Office. They will be removed from the computer system and a new card will be issued at a cost to you of \$25.00. If you are moving, please return the key card to the Town Office. Diabetes also have clothing bins to take donations.

THERE ARE NEW CAMERAS AT THE TRANSFER STATION. ANY PERSON WHO MISUSES THIS SERVICE WILL BE FINED AND HAVE THEIR CARD PRIVLEDGES REVOKED.
