A message from the RM of Edenwold



Updated RM of Edenwold/Emerald Park maps available now

Residents received a mail out with copies of the new Emerald Park/RM of Edenwold map and copies have been provided to Emerald Park businesses. "We are proud of our business community and preparing these maps is our effort to promote businesses while fulfilling a commitment we made at the launch of our business license program," says Reeve Mitchell



Newly updated maps of Emerald Park are available through the RM office and at local businesses.

Huber. "The maps are not only helpful for residents but also act as a promotional tool for businesses to help them direct traffic to their storefronts. With over 600 Enbridge employees and contractors expected in the area to work on the Line 3 Replacement Project, this was an ideal time to put our efforts toward promoting the local business community," explains Jana Jedlic, Senior Municipal Planner with the RM of Edenwold. The maps are available at local businesses and at the RM of Edenwold office. Businesses can request free quantities of the map through the RM office by calling 306-771-2522.

A new community safety officer

As of July 10 Lyle Heinemann has been hired as a new CSO. Heinemann comes to the RM after a successful career in Commercial Vehicle Enforcement. "I look forward to getting to know the people of the RM of Edenwold, in both the rural

and urban areas," says Heinemann. Heinemann will be working with CSO Rod Ash after CSO Ron Roteliuk retired at the end of July. The RM thanks Ron for his service and wishes him all the best in retirement!

Cannabis Growth and Distribution bylaw passes

The zoning bylaw amendment related to the growth and distribution of cannabis has been adopted by the RM of Edenwold and will be submitted to Community Planning for approval. "The role of the municipal government with respect to cannabis production and distribution is to determine where these types of operations can occur, where they should not be allowed and the appropriate development standards and conditions," says Jana Jedlic, Senior Municipal Planner with the RM of Edenwold. The RM staff and council have been working on the bylaw amendment since February using feedback from residents and information from federal and provincial government. Once the bylaw is approved by the province, the municipality will have parameters in place to manage cannabis-related developments into the future. **Fast FAQs:**

1. The RM of Edenwold has a 200 metre buffer zone around schools, places of worship, daycares, parks and playgrounds.
2. Retail operations are limited to three zoning districts: HPC – High Profile Commercial, COM1 – General Commercial and IND1 – General Industrial.
3. Cannabis production facilities are limited to two zoning districts: AR – Agricultural Resource and IND1 – General Industrial.
4. Personal residential plant growing will not be permitted anywhere in the RM unless the homeowner has a medical growing license.

Mid-year building permit update

An update from the RM of Edenwold Planning Department shows that permits totalling over \$22 million dollars in construction value have been issued since January. "A total of 67 development permits and 43 building permits have been issued as of June 30," Marcina Hodgins, Planner and Development Officer with the RM told council July 10. A break out of building permits shows 15 were issued for single family dwellings, seven for commercial/industrial construction or renovation, 12 for accessory buildings, seven for miscellaneous residential projects, and two for municipal projects. "The RM continues to attract builders to the area," says Chief Administrative Officer Kim McIvor. "It's a real feather in our cap."

2017 Waterworks Financial Overview

The following is information for the Town of Balgonie waterworks as required under *The Municipalities Regulations*.

- Total water and sewer **revenues** – \$ **1,049,560**
- Total waterworks and sewer **expenditures**—\$ **1,034,950**
- Total debt repayment on waterworks infrastructure – \$ **173,289**
- Comparison of waterworks revenues to expenditures plus debt payments (expressed as a ratio)

$$\frac{1,049,560}{1,034,950 + 134,361 + 38,926.94} = .86$$

For 2017, waterworks revenues covered 86 % percent of the waterworks expenditures.

- Amount transferred out of the utility reserve to cover the deficit – \$ **158,678**
- Amount of 2016 supplementary funding from general revenue required to cover expenditures \$ **0**
- Reserves available for waterworks capital infrastructure - \$ **52,668**

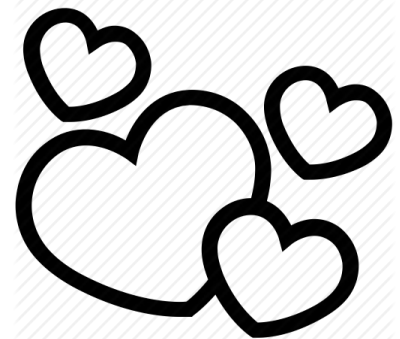
