Please contact the Town office to obtain your account numbers.

Electronic payments for utilities and taxes are a convenient way to pay your bills, but they are not instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is received by our office before any penalties apply. The bank requires time to process the payment and advise the Town.

The receipts for electronic payments will be available for pickup or mailed or emailed upon request.

UPDATING WEBSITE

Reminder to Balgonie Residents:

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a “nuisance” by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.

DANDELIONS OUT OF CONTROL

Please be aware that there are a lot of dandelions around town. Control the dandelions in your lawns. Be respectful of other residents that are taking the time to spray and pick out the dandelions. Those yellow flowers are pretty, but they are a weed and need to be controlled. Town personnel are also spraying areas around town.



Bike Safety

Balgonie Transfer Station

The TRANSFER STATION is electronically set up to provide our town residents with accessibility day or night. The Town of Balgonie offers these services on site at the TRANSFER STATION, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not disposing of things in the manner set forth by the Provincial Ministry of Environment and the Provincial Clean Air Act.

Recently, items have been left at the TRANSFER STATION which are not permitted. Please ensure that you read and understand what items are allowed and not allowed to be left at the TRANSFER STATION. Individuals who leave items which are not allowed will be required to clean up the improper disposal, and/or pay charges for the Town to remove the items . The transfer station cards can be cancelled at the discretion of the Council of the Town of Balgonie.

THE TRANSFER STATION IS NOT A GARBAGE DUMP!

The Transfer Station is a location where the following items can be left:

Scrap Metal

Tree Branches and Grass Clippings

Compostable materials (removed from the plastic bags)

The first Friday of every month, a Loraas bin is delivered to the transfer station. This is for town residents to use for the items which are too large for the household carts. Please note, this is only to be used by Balgonie residents. Larger loads due to fence removal, renovation etc, should be taken to the Regina landfill.

If the bins is full or not at the site, do not leave items , take them to the landfill.

Key cards, which are lost, should be reported to the Town Office. They will be removed from the computer system and a new card will be issued at a cost to you of \$25.00. If you are moving, please return the key card to the Town Office.

Diabetes also have clothing bins to take donations.

Recreational Vehicle Parking

there are now seasonal restrictions on the parking and storage of recreational vehicles such as campers and motor homes which are used for travelling and recreational activities.

No more than 2 recreational vehicles may be parked in the front, rear or side yards on a drive way on residential sites from April 1 to November 1 inclusive.: and these vehicles can not be within 2 metres (6.57 feet) of the outside edge of the curb.

Council is concerned about the safety of other residents when these large recreational vehicles are parked on roads and driveways and could possibly be impeding on people's sight lines while walking, or driving.



Crime Prevention

LOCK YOUR VEHICLE DOORS: Recently, there have been some thefts from vehicles in neighbouring communities. Items that are often left out in cars include cash, sunglasses, garage door openers, keys, etc. Please don't leave items in your vehicle which are in plain view and tempting to steal!

REPORT CRIMES: It is important to report all crimes to the White Butte R.C.M.P detachment. Although, you may feel that it is unnecessary to report, the R.C.M.P. use the information received to monitor crime trends. As well, patrols and staffing are allocated based on the statistics of crime. If incidents are not reported, the R.C.M.P. are not getting accurate information about crime in our community.

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS IN THE TOWN OF BALGONIE

3.4 Development Requiring A Permit And Not Requiring A Fee

The following developments shall require a Development Permit and shall conform to all other Bylaw requirements (e.g., building permits, setbacks, environmental and development standards):

3.4.1 Residential Zoning Districts

- a) Buildings and structures under 14.0 m² (150.70 ft²) in area, which are accessory to a principal, residential use except where such dwelling is a discretionary use.
- b) The erection of any fence, wall, gate, television antennae, or radio antennae under 5 metres (16.41 feet).
- c) Relocation of any residential or accessory building provided development standards are still met on the site.
- d) A portable storage unit, the sole purpose of which is incidental to the erection or alteration of a building for which a building permit has been granted.

3.4.2 Commercial Zoning Districts

- a) Buildings and structures under 14.0 m² (150.70 ft²) in area, that are accessory to a permitted, principal, commercial use, except where such use is discretionary.
- b) The erection of any fence or gate.
- c) A temporary building, the sole purpose of which is incidental to the erection or alteration of a building for which a building permit has been granted.

3.4.3 Accessory Uses

All accessory uses, unless otherwise specified in this Bylaw.

3.4.4 Official Uses

Uses and buildings undertaken, erected, or operated by the Town of Balgonie.

3.4.5 Internal Alterations

a) Residential Buildings

Internal alterations to a residential building, provided that such alterations do not result in a change of use or an increase in the number of dwelling units within the building or on the site.

b) All Other Buildings

Internal alterations and maintenance to other buildings, including mechanical or electrical work, provided that the use, or intensity of use of the building, does not change.

c) Landscaping

Landscaped areas, driveways and parking lots, provided the natural or designed drainage pattern of the site and adjacent sites are not adversely impacted.

“Please note that although development permits are required but no building permits for accessory buildings under 14.0m², all buildings/structures under 10m² will be assessed according to Sasatchewan Assessment Management Agency. “

STOP AND CHECK THE RECYCLING LIST!!!



Many residents are recycling and reducing the amount of household waste that goes to the landfill. We can even do better by making sure everyone in the household is checking labels before tossing items into the trash.

Please post this information near your garbage can!!

Things that can go into your blue curbside recycling carts in Balgonie.

- **Cardboard and Paper:** Cardboard and paperboard such as empty laundry detergent boxes, cereal boxes, tissue boxes, shoe boxes, chocolate boxes, paper and cardboard packaging from Christmas gifts, newspapers, flyers, inserts, junk mail and envelopes, magazines, catalogues, telephone books, paperback books, hardcover books with spines removed, paper bags, toilet paper and paper towel cores, gift and packing paper, paper egg cartons, copier paper, and NCR paper (No carbon required)
- **Aluminum & Tin:** Soft drink and beer cans, foil trays and pie plates, and household tin cans. These items should be rinsed before placing in recycling bin.
- **Plastic:** Containers with logo 1-7, plastic bags, plastic drink bottles and plastic wrap. This would include things like: packaging from toys and electronics, lids from milk jugs and soda bottles, shampoo bottles, hairspray, lotion, cleaning bottles, empty salad dressing bottles, mayonnaise bottles.
- **Aseptic Packaging and Cartons:** Juice and milk cartons, milk jugs, tetrapak containers, pouches

Sorry, we do not accept the following in the Loraas Single Stream Recycling carts.

- Glass
- Household garbage, organics, or hazardous waste
- Waxed, plasticized or food contaminated paper, cardboard cups or plastic plates
- Soiled tissues, napkins and paper towels
- Confetti shredded paper
- Styrofoam or other foam packing materials
- Auto parts or batteries

How should you prepare recyclables before putting them in the bin?

Flatten all cardboard boxes. Wash and rinse all food and beverage containers. Remove all lids and caps from containers.

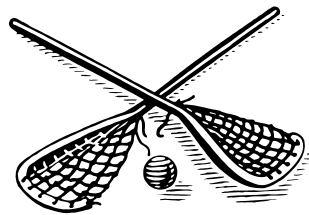
Ball hockey is taking place in our arena almost every night. Check out a few games of this sport if you wish.
