Drinking Water Quality and Compliance Town of Balgonie - Annual Notice to Consumers

Introduction

Saskatchewan Ministry of Environment requires that at least once each year waterworks owners provide notification to consumers on the quality of water produced and supplied as well as information on the performance of the waterworks in submitting samples as required by a Minister's Order or Permit to Operate a waterworks. The following is a summary of the Town of Balgonie water quality and sample submission compliance record for the January 1 – December 31, 2014 time period. This report was completed on June 15, 2015 and must be completed before June 30 each year on a calendar year based reporting frequency. A minimum of 0.1 milligrams per litre (mg/L) free chlorine residual is required for water entering the distribution system. NOTICE TO RESIDENTS IN THE TOWN OF BALGONIE

3.4 Development Requiring A Permit And Not Requiring A Fee

The following developments shall require a Development Permit and shall conform to all other Bylaw requirements (e.g., building permits, setbacks, environmental and development standards):

3.4.1 Residential Zoning Districts

- a) Buildings and structures under 14.0 m² (150.70 ft²) in area, which are accessory to a principal, residential use except where such dwelling is a discretionary use.
- b) The erection of any fence, wall, gate, television antennae, or radio antennae under 5 metres (16.41 feet).
- c) Relocation of any residential or accessory building provided development standards are still met on the site.
- d) A portable storage unit, the sole purpose of which is incidental to the erection or alteration of a building for which a building permit has been granted.

3.4.2 Commercial Zoning Districts

- a) Buildings and structures under 14.0 m² (150.70 ft²) in area, that are accessory to a permitted, principal, com mercial use, except where such use is discretionary.
- b) The erection of any fence or gate.
- c) A temporary building, the sole purpose of which is incidental to the erection or alteration of a building for which a building permit has been granted.

3.4.3 Accessory Uses

All accessory uses, unless otherwise specified in this Bylaw.

3.4.4 Official Uses

Uses and buildings undertaken, erected, or operated by the Town of Balgonie.

3.4.5 Internal Alterations

a) Residential Buildings

Internal alterations to a residential building, provided that such alterations do not result in a change of use or an increase in the number of dwelling units within the building or on the site.

b) All Other Buildings

Internal alterations and maintenance to other buildings, including mechanical or electrical work, provided that the use, or intensity of use of the building, does not change.

c) Landscaping

Landscaped areas, driveways and parking lots, provided the natural or designed drainage pattern of the site and adjacent sites are not adversely impacted.

"Please note that although development permits are required but no building permits for accessory buildings under 14.0m², all buildings/structures under 10m² will be assessed according to Sasatchewan Assessment Management Agency."


The Town of Balgonie will be implementing a pick up program for grass and branches for the months of *May, June, July and August 2015*.



NOTICE OF INTENTION TO AMEND ZONING BYLAW NO. 374/2015

Notice is hereby given by the Town of Balgonie, pursuant to *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, that Council intends to amend Bylaw No. 374/2015, the Zoning Bylaw.

Purpose:

- A. To add special provisions for lots within the Canadian Pacific Railway Right-Of-Way. Section 5.11.11 will be added to the Commercial/Light industrial District, where development for these lots will be subject to discretionary usages and additional site regulations.
- B. To change the language of parking regulations of Future Urban Development 5.5.7 a, Residential 5.6.8 b, Residential Multiple Dwelling 5.7.5 b and Residential Mobile Home 5.8.7 b districts, to permit side yard parking of a recreational vehicle from November 1 to April 1 inclusive.

Inspection: The Proposed Bylaw Amendment may be inspected at the Town office between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to Noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. from Monday through Friday excluding statutory holidays. Copies are available, at cost, at the Town office.



Permits

The Town of Balgonie requires building permits for anyone building houses, accessory buildings, renovations and decks. Please ensure that you have completed the paperwork with the Town before starting construction.

Permits are also required if you will be moving a structure or demolishing a structure on your property.

Applications can be obtained at the Town Office and permits will be issued once they have been reviewed and approved by the Town and the Building Inspector. Please speak to staff at the Town Office to ensure that you have the information BEFORE moving, demolishing or constructing. The planned construction needs to comply with our Zoning Bylaw and be authorized for development. Please ensure that you have submitted these forms in advance of your project. There may be 2–3 weeks after submission until a decision has been reached regarding your application.

(non—insulated)

Addition: \$800

Deck: \$200

Garage attached: \$600.00

Garage detatched: \$200.00

(non-insulated)

Garage detached: \$400.00

(insulated)

Demolition: \$200.00

(\$500 refundable clean— up fee)

Moving a building: \$250.00

(\$500.00 refundable clean up fee)

These costs may change dependent on fees charged to the Town by Professional Building Inspections.

Flood Maintenance and Prevention-

Maintaining Home Drainage System

Regular maintenance of your home drainage system can often be the difference between staying dry or being flooded. Once a year, it's a good idea to evaluate the condition of your system – inside and out. If you find a problem, make fixing it a priority.

Remember: Most flooding on private property is caused by the failure of one or more home drainage elements.

The following provides a maintenance checklist you should review each year. If you are unsure of what to do, call a professional.

Outside

Eavestroughs & Downspouts

- Clean leaves and debris from inside the
- trough and downspouts.
- Tighten elbows and other connections.
- Caulk and seal any leaks.
- Repair or replace sagging, badly dented or cracked sections.

Splash Pads & Extensions

- Reconnect any loose pads or extensions.
- Replace badly dented extensions.
- Check soft plastic, roll out extensions for leaks and to determine if they work properly.

Lot Grading

- Check the slope from the basement wall.
- Check for settling, particularly under stairs and decks.
- Raise any low spots.
- Look for cracks or spaces on driveways, sidewalks and patios that are next to the foundation wall.
 Caulk or waterproof where needed.



Inside

Foundation Walls

- Check for moisture along the walls and the floor.
- Fill and seal any visible cracks.

Sump Pump

- Check for power.
- Test the pump by pouring water into the pump well.
- Check the outside pipe to confirm water is flowing towards the street or back lane.
- Check and repair any leaks in the sump pump pipe.
- Disconnect sump pump discharge hose in winter conditions to avoid freezing in the line.

Sewer backup:

- Sewer caps should be on to prevent sewer backup.
- Install a backflow prevention valve

Plumbing Fixtures

 Maintain proper water levels in traps in floor drains and toilets to minimize odours.
