

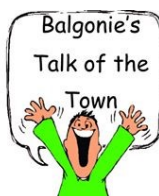

# Transfer Station

The TRANSFER STATION is electronically set up to provide our town residents with accessibility day or night. The Town of Balgonie offers these services on site at the TRANSFER STATION, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not disposing of things in the manner set forth by the Provincial Ministry of Environment and the Provincial Clean Air Act.

Recently, items have been left at the TRANSFER STATION which are not permitted. Please ensure that you read and understand what items are allowed and not allowed to be left at the TRANSFER STATION. Individuals who leave items which are not allowed will be required to clean up the improper disposal, and/or pay charges for the Town to remove the items. The transfer station cards can be cancelled at the discretion of the Council of the Town of Balgonie.

**THE TRANSFER STATION IS NOT A GARBAGE DUMP!**

The Transfer Station is a location where the following items can be left:

Scrap Metal.

Tree Branches and Grass Clippings (removed from the plastic bags).

Compostable materials.

The first and third Friday of every month, a Loraas bin is delivered to the transfer station. This is for town residents to use for the items which are too large for the household carts. Please note, this is only to be used by Balgonie residents. Larger loads due to fence removal, renovation etc., should be taken to the Regina landfill.

If the bins is full or not at the site, do not leave items, take them to the landfill.

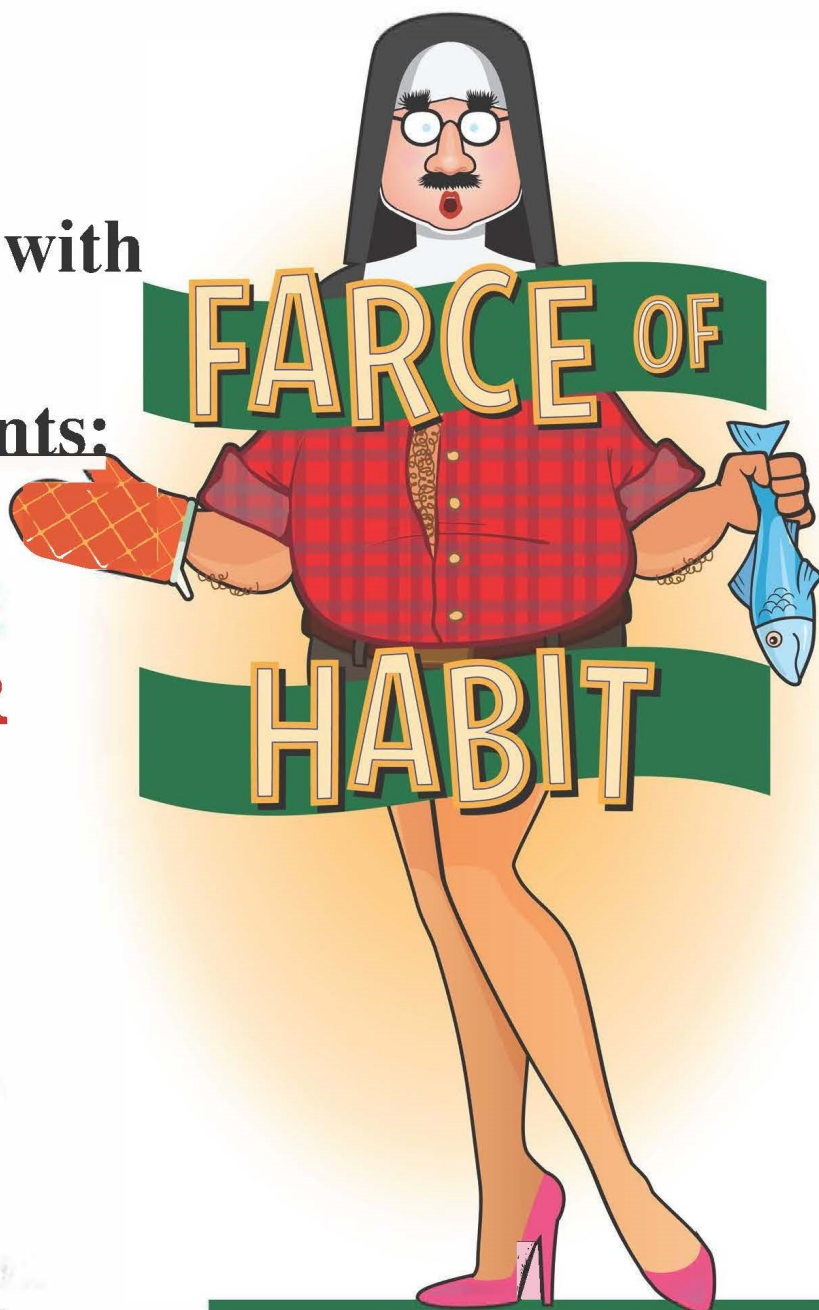



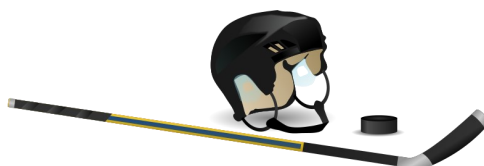

## **A message from the RM of Edenwold**



### **Bylaw court announced**

The RM of Edenwold is proud to announce that a bylaw enforcement court has been approved by the Provincial Court of Saskatchewan.

This closes the loop on enforcement of bylaw tickets issued by the Community

Safety Officers. "Our CSOs have been doing a great job with policing in the community protecting our residents and the RM infrastructure," says Kim McIvor, Chief Administrative Officer for the RM of Edenwold. "The bylaw court will ensure enforcement is maintained." Court will be in session the second Friday of each month at the provincial court house in Regina on Smith Street.

### **Gimme shelter - White Butte Trails news**

The RM of Edenwold has partnered with SaskParks at White Butte Trails to provide doors and windows for the new trail shelter. SaskParks maintains the trails during summer, with mowing and other maintenance and the Regina Ski Club maintains cross-country ski trails throughout the winter. "This is a huge asset to have in our community," says RM Senior Planner Jana Jedlic. "We are happy to partner

with SaskParks and

enhance an outdoor space that is used for recreation by so many of our residents."

### **Public town hall meetings wrap up**

October 4, the final of four public town hall meetings for RM residents concerning the town of White City's annexation proposal was held. "Hosting these meetings was about getting our residents feedback about the proposal and how they would like us to proceed," explains Reeve Mitchell Huber. Residents came with many questions about the town's proposal to the standing-room only events. White Butte Trails Shelter

The RM received a letter from the town (dated: September 14, 2018) requesting meetings re: the annexation. The RM declined, letting them know the RM was still meeting with residents at planned town hall events and that a municipal election was scheduled for the end of October. The RM looks forward to talking about a number of potential changes and options that benefit all residents of the region, now and into the future, and to discuss opportunities for strengthened municipal cooperation.



### **New neighbours**

Emerald Park will be welcoming new neighbours in the Fairway Road South residential areas. Great Plains Leaseholds is developing 79 residential lots that have recently received subdivision approval and are now for sale. ### **New name, same road**

The north-south portion of Industrial Drive West has been re-named to Innovation Drive. Why? Because the east-west Industrial Drive West connection is being extended to the west to accommodate new development in Great Plains Industrial Park and create an opportunity for a future direct connection to the South Service Road to provide convenient access to the Industrial Park.
