


As of December 31, 2017, any outstanding utility invoices will be transferred to taxes, which are considered arrears and will have an extra interest penalty of 1.5% added to them as of January 1, 2018.

IF YOU HAVE NOT ALREADY DONE SO, AND WOULD LIKE TO SET UP ONLINE/TELEPHONE BANKING, JUST CALL THE OFFICE TO OBTAIN YOUR ACCOUNT INFORMATION.









ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS:

Taxes and utility bills may be paid electronically through your online banking website. The payments would be under Town of Balgonie Taxes and Town of Balgonie Utilities.

(Do not choose Balgonie Water—this payee is a previous business and is not connected with the Town of Balgonie.)

Please contact the Town office to obtain your account numbers.

Electronic payments for utilities and taxes are a convenient way to pay your bills, but they are not

instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is receipted by our office before any penalties apply. The bank requires time to process the payment and advise the Town.

The receipts for electronic payments will be available for pickup, mailed or emailed upon request.



It is important that our graders have access to the entire street after a snow fall. Vehicles can only be parked on the street for 24 hours. It is also illegal to park an unlicensed vehicle on the street.

After a snowfall, please remove your vehicle from the street, until your street has been cleared. Letters will be sent to residences who are not removing vehicles in a timely fashion.

Your co-operation in this matter is appreciated by the Town and the neighbours on your street.

Please remind youngsters to stay clear of Town snow equipment—It's hard to see and hear while operating this large and noisy equipment. We do not want to see anyone get injured.

Our Town Staff work especially hard to keep Balgonie streets clear after a snowfall. At times, snow ridges will be left at the end of your driveway by the grader. During heavier snowfalls, these may be larger than other times. Your help in clearing these ridges is appreciated. We are also giving some of our newer employees opportunities to learn all of the equipment in town. It will take some practice for them to master the routes and equipment. Your patience is appreciated while these operators are learning.

Most often the snow will be cleared within 2 days of a snowfall, however weather conditions and garbage/recycling pickup days may delay this. That being said, residential streets and bays will be cleared as soon as possible. Our town is very fortunate to have such prompt snow service!!! Some residential areas in other municipalities may only see a grader once or twice during the winter season.

A BIG THANK YOU to those people who help out their neighbours with their snow removal and assist those who need an extra bit of help. It is wonderful to see so many helpful citizens.

Our transfer station is equipped with security cameras, as well as a card reader. Fines have been laid for illegal dumping, and will continue to be laid to any person who violates these rules.

REMINDER:

Garbage and Recycling Carts are to be put out on the street on or BEFORE 7am, and brought in after garbage or recycling collection is complete. If carts are damaged before or after these hours, homeowners are responsible for the charges.

As we are not the only town with these services, there is no specific time other than by **7:00a.m.** to be prepared for pick-up.

If you miss pick-up because your container is **NOT** at the curb on time, it will be the owner's responsibility to dispose of the contents if required.

Weather Safety - Town Students

The cold weather brings winter fun as well as some cold weather concerns. We would ask that town students that go home for lunch during the winter season please stay at home for lunch and return when the lunch hour ends. If students rush home and back, and it is an indoor recess due to cold weather, it is dangerous for them as the exterior doors are locked and they might not get inside in time to avoid frostbite. Thanks for helping us best ensure that students are not out for prolonged periods in extreme temperatures.

Students Need Billets

Please update your student(s) billet information at Balgonie Elementary so that they have a safe place to go in the event of inclement weather events. Thanks!



Inclement Weather Plan

If the weather becomes inclement during or at the end of the school day, our billet plan will go into effect. It is imperative that all students have a billet that can be contacted as an alternate "after school home". Not only may buses be cancelled, but we have had situations where parents of town students are not able to return home at the end of their work day. In an effort to ensure safety for all students in the event of a major "weather event", we are asking parents to review and become familiar with the following school plan:

1) If bus runs are cancelled for the end of the day, we will use School Messenger to call the primary phone number on file and e-mail all parents as soon as we receive notice. We ask that you check your e-mail regularly on bad weather days. NOTE: School Messenger can only call your primary number – this should be the number you have most regular access to at all times.

- 2) Parents should contact billets, if necessary, to ensure they are available to pick up the children. If alternate arrangements are made, please call or e-mail the school to inform us of the new billet picking up your child/ren. This information will be recorded for the teacher and office personnel.
- 3) Children will be held in their classrooms or in the commons until they are picked up. Billets picking up children will be asked to sign children out in the billet book with classroom teachers prior to taking the children from the school. This process will enable us to provide all parents with the location (billet) of their child/ren.
- 4) In the event of a severe "weather event", town students from Kindergarten to Grade 8 will not be dismissed until we have assurance that there is someone at home or picking the student up. Parents are asked to contact the school and/or teachers via email, text or phone call and provide verbal permission that their students can be dismissed. Again, your assistance in providing a billet name or contacting us with alternative arrangements is important.

Please understand that we will do our best to disperse students as quickly and calmly as possible should this type of situation arise. However, we do ask that you wait in line (if necessary) to sign out students and that you are patient if waiting for us to answer the phone. Our lines will/may become jammed as we attempt to take and deliver your messages.
