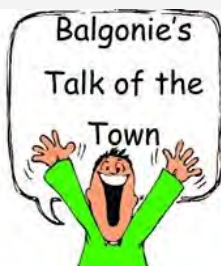

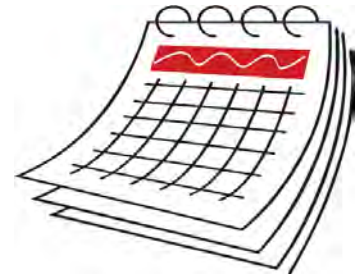
Reminder

Garbage and Recycling carts are to be put out on the street on or BEFORE 7 AM, and brought in after garbage or recycling are complete. If carts are damaged outside of these hours, homeowners are responsible for these charges. As we are not the only town with this service, there is no specific time other than 7 AM. If you miss pick up because your bin was not out at 7 AM, it is your responsibility to dispose of the contents if required.

Transfer Station:

A Loraas bin comes to the transfer station on the 1st and 3rd Friday of each month, for town residents. Please do not leave items if there is no bin. Our transfer station is equipped with security cameras as well as a card reader. Fines have been laid for illegal dumping, and will continue to be laid to people who violate these rules.

Reminder to Balgonie Residents:

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours, except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property.

All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.

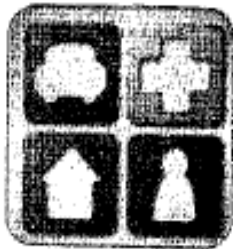

### **Now, about that Christmas tree....**

Christmas tree pick up service for Emerald Park residents will be available the week of January 15. Place your tree at the end of the property, but please do not stick them in the ground (snow) as they may end up looking like part of the landscaping at your home!

### **Snow removal**

After heavy snowfalls in rural areas, the RM of Edenwold maintenance team first clears bus routes/high traffic main roads, paved roads and country residential subdivisions. Then, the focus shifts to grid roads and farm access roads. For Emerald Park, bus routes and South Plains Road, Kingsmere Avenue, Sapphire Drive and Emerald Drive are prioritized. Once those are cleared, the focus shifts to remaining streets, roads, crescents and bays followed by the walkways.

### **A request when taking snow from your property**

Please don't pile snow from your property on to roads, onto your neighbour's property, or into drainage ditches. Snow from your property needs to stay on your property. If you hire private snow removal companies let them know they are not permitted to pile snow on municipal property.

### **Snow dump sites for local businesses**

RM businesses who require a snow dump site to clear their parking lots can visit the RM office (100 Hutchence Road in Emerald Park) for snow dump site approval and a printed agreement.

### **Reminder to lock vehicles and remove keys**

A reminder to lock up your cars and keep keys indoors in a safe place (not next to doors, or in garages). Members of the White Butte RCMP informed RM staff back in November that some thefts occurring in the area have been preventable.

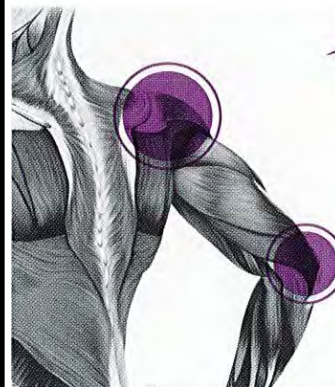

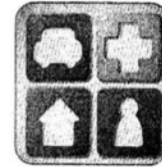
