Reminder

The designated snow dumping site for Balgonie properties is on the West side of Westview Dr. North. (West of Stage 7 subdivision).

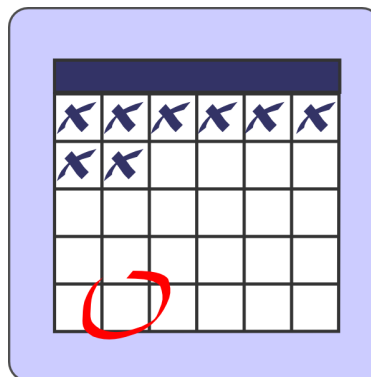
Transfer Station:

Signs in the RM of Edenwold require a permit. As of January 1, 2019, permits for temporary or portable signs are \$25. Permanent signs require a Development Permit at the cost of \$125. The application forms for both temporary and permanent signs are posted on the RM website under 'Forms' on the Administration and Bylaws tab.

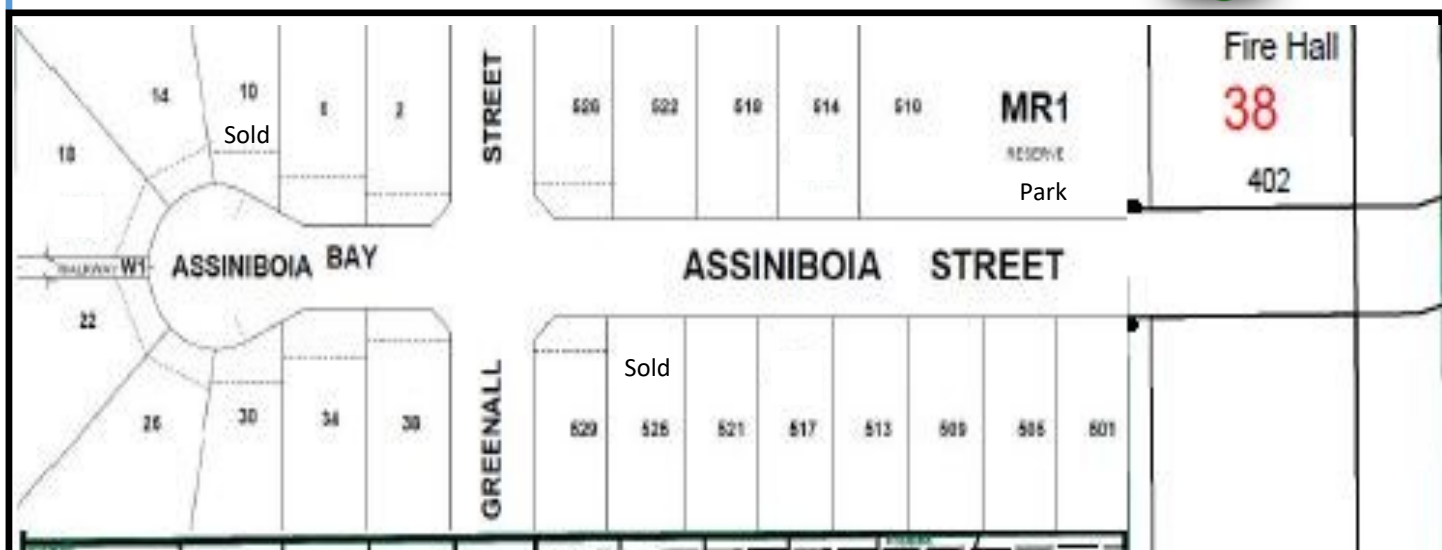

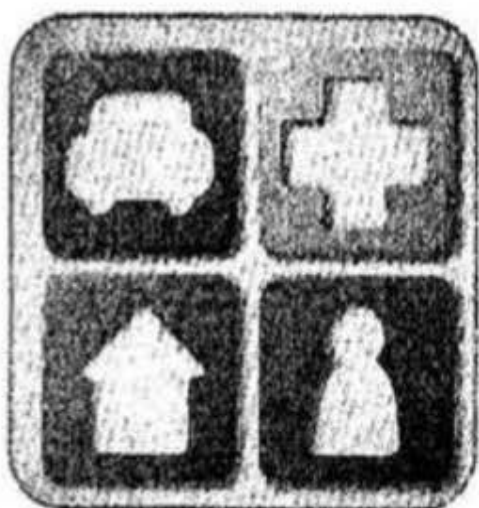
