

The designated snow dumping site for Balgonie properties is on the West side of Westview Dr. North. (West of Stage 7 subdivision).


#### Transfer Station:





Greenall would like to extend a huge THANK YOU to RON KONANZ of Cloverdale Paint for donating paint to our school's kindness initiative.


The SCC would like to send a THANK YOU to all 30 bakers who baked over 700 muffins for the students to eat for breakfast on the first day of their final exams.


