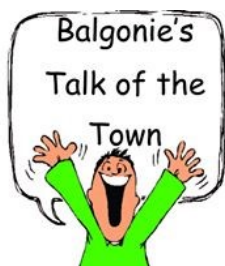

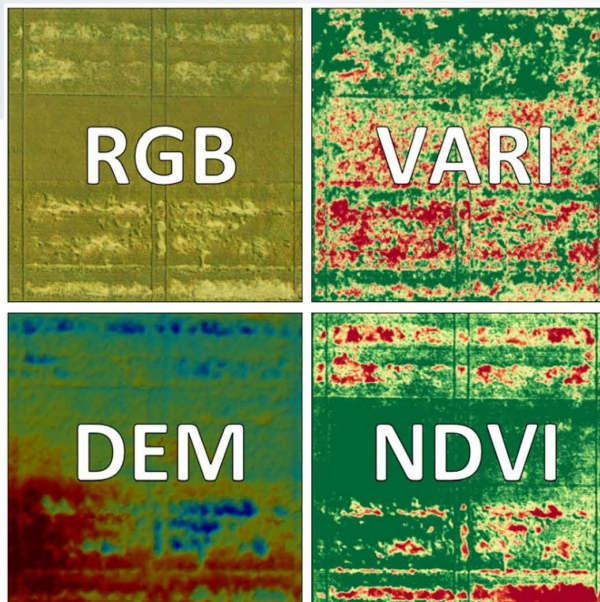

HOCKEY NEWS!

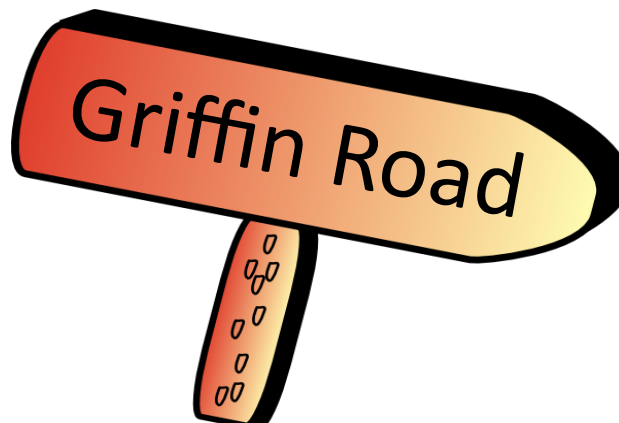
