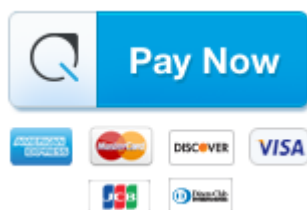

Credit Card are now accepted. All fees are paid by the cardholder. Payments may take 3-5 business days to process. The Town of Balgonie is avoiding passing on the cost of card payments to all residents, so those wishing to pay by credit card or debit card will be charged a fee. This fee is charged by Plastiq, not the Town of Balgonie. (2.5% for credit cards, 1% for debit cards.)

Transfer Station:

A Loraas bin comes to the transfer station on the 1st and 3rd Friday of each month, for town residents. Please do not leave items if there is no bin. Our transfer station is equipped with security cameras as well as a card reader. Fines have been laid for illegal dumping, and will continue to be laid to people who violate these rules.

Reminder

Garbage, recycling and compost carts are to be put out on the street on or BEFORE 7:00 AM, and brought in after pick ups are complete. If carts are damaged outside of these hours, homeowners are responsible for these charges. As we are not the only town with this service, there is no specific time other than 7 AM. If you miss pick up because your bin was not out at 7 AM, it is your responsibility to dispose of the contents if required.

With the nice weather upon us, please keep in mind the ATV Bylaw # 391/2016 for the Town of Balgonie. Please be respectful of others and their property when using these vehicles. ATVs/ dirt bikes can be driven from your property to the nearest exit, no stunting allowed and children under the age of 16 are not permitted to drive these vehicles.

Town of Balgonie

Update from the Council Chambers:

2019 Budget was passed on April 8, 2019.

Municipal Mill rate increase from 5.25 to 5.37

Base tax remains at \$550 per property

Utility rates unchanged for 2019

Reserve funding transfers for the Administration Building renovation and the new flooring in the Arena

Balgonie Administration Building:

The Town of Balgonie purchased 50% of the building from the R.M. of Edenwold as they have moved to a new location in Emerald Park. The co-ownership of the building had been a successful partnership since 1983. The Town of Balgonie will miss the close proximity to the R.M. of Edenwold, but wishes them well in their new location.

Through the appraisal process and inspections of the building, Council reviewed the current condition of the building. The building has an original mechanical system, roof, windows, doors and layout. The Balgonie Branch Library and the Balgonie Agencies have both indicated a need to have increased space for their operations. While the Town office has adequate room for operations currently, Council has decided to plan for future growth and increase the office space for the Town as well.

The Town of Balgonie has engaged the services of CCR Construction Ltd. to manage a renovation project for the building. Throughout the review, Council has decided to rejuvenate and expand the building to meet all of the needs of the current occupants and accommodate another retail space. The vacant space currently in the building will assist with managing the work sites while the project moves forward. The construction will be completed throughout 2019 and 2020.

The total cost of the improvements are budgeted at \$954,500 and the Town will be funding this project out of reserve funds.

Arena Flooring:

The Arena is receiving a much needed upgrade to its flooring--the concrete lobby and mezzanine have been refinished. This project will help keep our facility looking top notch. This project has been funded through the revenues received in our facility rental fees. Feel free to take a look one evening while ball hockey is on.

Balgonie Wastewater Improvement Project:

The final phases of the project will be constructed this summer. The new lagoon irrigation system will be tested this spring and summer.

A sewage pumping station will be constructed and built on Griffin Road, near the Baptist Church. A new forced sewer main will be constructed from this pumping station to the lagoon located south of the Town of Balgonie.

Current financial breakdown of the project:

Phase 1: Lagoon Expansion -complete	3,143,799
Phase 1: Septage Receiving Station-complete	37,586
Phase 2: Irrigation pump and pivot – 97% complete	447,422
Phase 3: Sewage Pump Station and Forced Main	183,592
Total expenses to date:	3,812,399
2019 Budgeted completion costs	1,440,986
Total expected cost of project:	5,253,385

The Balgonie Wastewater Improvement Project is receiving funding from Infrastructure Canada and the Province of Saskatchewan under the New Building Canada Fund- Provincial and Territorial Infrastructure Component. The Federal Government and the Provincial Government have agreed to contribute up to \$1.5 M each for the completion of the project. The Town of Balgonie will be responsible for the remaining expenses projected at \$2.54 M.

Green Organic Waste Disposal Carts:

This exciting new program was initiated this spring. Each residence and business with waste and recycling carts have been issued a green cart. The green carts will help to divert waste which would otherwise end up at the City of Regina Landfill. Each participating property will be assisting the Town of Balgonie in being a good steward of the environment. Additionally, the carts will reduce the costs to the Town associated with the green pile at the Town's transfer site.

The minimal cost to the Town for providing these bins is \$22.00 per year/cart. These costs have been included as part to the Town's annual budget for waste removal. Individual residents will not have to pay Loraas for the provision of the service.



Mental Health Capacity Building is at Greenall High School

Greenall High School is part of an exciting initiative that has been recently launched by the Government of Saskatchewan. The Mental Health Capacity Building Initiative is being piloted in five schools across the province. This initiative focuses on positive mental health and wellness through prevention and mental health promotion, early identification and intervention and works with students to help them build coping and resiliency skills as well as increasing awareness on how and where to access supports. MHCB is a collaborative effort with the Saskatchewan Health Authority and is based on a model that has been running successfully in Alberta for the past 12 years. It aims to build capacity and resiliency through a variety of school-wide and community opportunities including presentations, groups, programs, resources, information nights and activities. Currently we are launching Wellness Wednesdays and will have opportunities for students to learn about different wellness strategies and supports through lunch and learns and social media posts. Stay tuned to hear more about what MHCB is doing at Greenall High School.

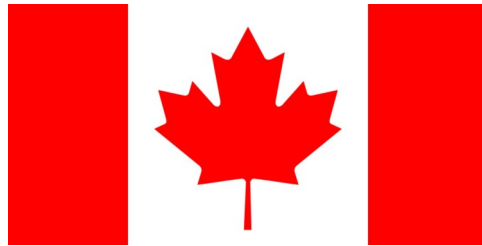

Spring celebration at William Albert House





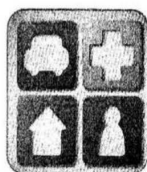
