Town office Renovations.

The town office will be located in the old RM office during renovations. The entrance will be located on the outside of the building, (north of the current doors) watch for signage.

The Library will be relocating to the Heritage Place on Lewis Street during renovations. Times will remain the same.

Transfer Station:

A Loraas bin comes to the transfer station on the 1st and 3rd Friday of each month, for town residents. Please do not leave items if there is no bin. Our transfer station is equipped with security cameras as well as a card reader. Fines have been laid for illegal dumping, and will continue to be laid to people who violate these rules.

Reminder

Garbage, recycling and compost carts are to be put out on the street on or BEFORE 7:00 AM, and brought in after pick ups are complete. If carts are damaged outside of these hours, homeowners are responsible for these charges. As we are not the only town with this service, there is no specific time other than 7 AM. If you miss pick up because your bin was not out at 7 AM, it is your responsibility to dispose of the contents if required.


ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS:




