Traffic Calming Policy

The Traffic Calming Policy provides a mechanism for the neighbourhood groups to collaborate with the Town of Balgonie to manage traffic in their neighbourhood. It provides an opportunity for all neighbourhood stakeholders to be involved so that the needs of the neighbourhood as a whole can be appropriate considered and proposed improvements do not create issues on adjacent streets.

These are some changes to traffic calming devices or traffic strategies that will be considered in this manner, though Council may add other situations as necessary.

- Speed bumps/humps
- Installing or removing stop signs
- Speed limits
- Parking restrictions
- Road closures
- 1. Request for Traffic Calming by citizen, or group.
- 2. Eligibility check:
 - 70% of the properties in the defined area effected are in favour of the alteration. The defined area is all land included in the area from the traffic calming strategy to the next intersection, in all directions.
 - Traffic calming change is proposed on a residential street.
- 3. Review by Town Council.
 - Review by any outside sources deemed necessary by Council.
 - Consultation with Emergency Services.
 - Determination of whether to recommend project for public consultation.
- 4. Public Consultation:
 - Open house.
 - Information sessions.
 - Public surveys.
- 5. Council decision on the proposed request.
