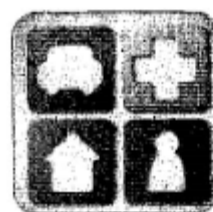

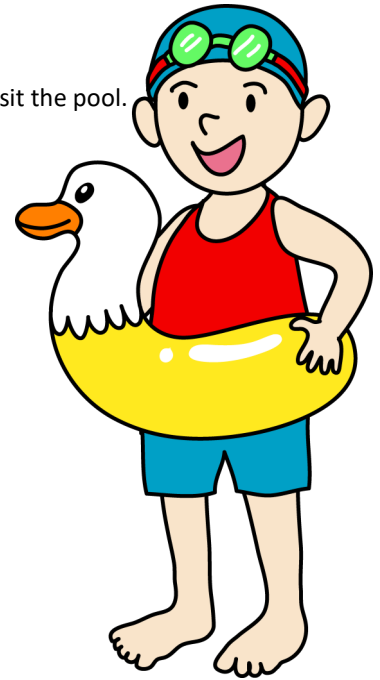

A minimum of 0.1 milligrams per litre (mg/L) free chlorine residual is required for water entering the distribution system. Chemical – Health Category

All waterworks serving less than 5000 persons are required to submit water samples for SE's Chemical Health category once every 2 years. The Chemical Health category includes analysis for arsenic, barium, boron, cadmium, chromium, fluoride, lead, nitrate, selenium and uranium.

The last sample for Chemical Health analysis was submitted on 5/10/13. Sample results indicated that the provincial drinking water quality standards were not exceeded. This means that construction related noise-generating activities are restricted to the hours of 7 a.m. through to 10 p.m. weekdays and 8 a.m. through 10 p.m. weekends and holidays. DID YOU KNOW?



In each zoning district within the RM of Edenwold there is a list of land uses or land activities that are permitted uses and a list of those that are discretionary uses.

Any land uses or activities not listed in either list are prohibited within that zoning district.

Permitted use applications are reviewed and processed by the development officer and are approved or denied based on conformance with development standards and requirements. Permits may be subject to conditions to restrict potential nuisances and ensure compatibility.

Discretionary uses are allowed only if approved by the RM council. A public hearing is required, so council can hear feedback from the public on each specific proposal. For more on timing and process, visit: RMedenwold.ca/planning

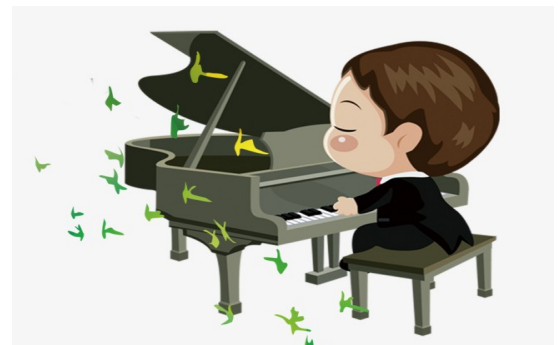
