



# **DID YOU KNOW?**



In each zoning district within the RM of Eden-

wold there is a list of land uses or land activities that are permitted uses and a list of those that are discretionary uses.

Any land uses or activities not listed in either list are prohibited within that zoning district.

Permitted use applications are reviewed and processed by the development officer and are approved or denied based on conformance with development standards and requirements. Permits may be subject to conditions to restrict potential nuisances and ensure compatibility.

Discretionary uses are allowed only if approved by the RM council. A public hearing is required, so council can hear feedback from the public on each specific proposal. For more on timing and process, visit: RMedenwold.ca/planning




