The event saw a mock disaster scene created; that of an impaired driver colliding with a school bus full of children. Resulting from the "crash" were seven injured and one deceased person. The "impaired driver" was "arrested." Councillors Stan Capnerhurst and Tim Brodt of the RM of Edenwold and the RM's Community Safety Officers were involved in the planning and execution of the event. The Injury Awareness Event wrapped up over lunch with the Greenall Students.





## ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS:

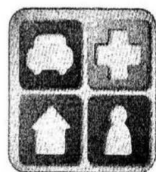
