#### **Update from the Town of Balgonie**

The **Administration Building** renovations are close to completion. CCR Construction has been working hard to complete the work in this town facility. Major improvements have included:

- New heating and air conditioning.
- Installation of new windows and most doors.
- Building expansion for added retail space.
- Library expansion of 300 ft<sup>2</sup>.
- Town office expansion of 400 ft<sup>2</sup>.
- Relocation and expansion of Balgonie Agencies.
- New sidewalks.
- Replacement of shingles.
- Council chambers expansion.
- Reconfiguration of the lobby and creation of public washrooms.
- Paint and flooring.

The total cost of the work for the building rejuvenation is \$ 1,040,000. Final touches will be worked on over the next month. A future notice will advertise an open house to celebrate our new spaces.

The **Balgonie Wastewater Improvement Project** is expected to be complete by end of May 2020. The final stage of this \$5.3 M project will commission the new forced main and lift station on Griffin Road. The project has been funded through the New Building Canada Fund – Provincial Territorial Infrastructure – National -Regional Projects. An update will follow in later publications with total project costs and grants received.

**2020** is Election year for the Town of Balgonie Council. The local government election will be held in Saskatchewan on November 9, 2020. The local Council consists of a Mayor and six Councillors. Meetings are held on the <u>2ND</u> and <u>4TH</u> Monday of every month starting at 6:15 p.m.

The local Council makes decisions regarding local matters regarding services that the Town provides, local budgets, bylaws and policies for local operations. ### YOUR CIVIC ADDRESS AND WHY IT'S IMPORTANT TO HAVE IT DISPLAYED

With the new Provincial-wide 911 emergency system now in place, it is important that you have the correct address displayed on your home. In an emergency situation, time is of the essence, and we want emergency personnel to find you in a timely manner.

You may receive a letter from the Town office, clarifying the address that both the Town and the 911 system has on record for your home.

If you receive a letter, and you are currently displaying the correct address, you do not need to do anything further.

If you live on a corner lot, it may be of interest to you to have both your house number and street name displayed. This may be especially important if your home does not face the street that you are associated with. If you would like to clarify your address, please feel free to call the office and we can help you out.

### **CONTAMINATION ALERT**

February 2020

Dear Resident,

Crisis is perhaps too strong a word, but contamination of recycle material is, in general, a growing problem in North America. In 2018 China stopped accepting recycle materials from around the globe. The result is an oversupply of recyclables, driving values down and processing costs up. The need for maintaining and improving the quality of what is collected is greater than ever.

As you know, recycling processing relies, in part, on separating acceptable materials from garbage. Material Recovery Facilities (MRFs) are being vigilant in reducing the contamination levels in the materials they are marketing; however, this takes more time and expense.

In order to maintain a strong and effective recycling program, we need your cooperation. Any items listed as acceptable can go in the 'BLUE' recycle cart and any remaining items go in the garbage or an alternative recycling facility, e.g. light bulbs and metal parts. Contaminated recycle loads may result in additional fees being charged back to the municipalities.

If you have any doubt whether or not an item can be recycled, please contact Loraas or at a minimum, when in doubt put it in the garbage.

Attached is a helpful poster which outlines our recycling program. This poster details what can and cannot be put in the blue cart or bin.

Thank You, we appreciate your cooperation as we attempt to keep recycle material clean and costs to the municipalities low.



On February  $11^{\rm th}$ , Council adopted the Yard Maintenance Policy with minor revisions for 2020. To view the policy, visit the *Bylaws and Policies* page on the RM's website.

Any property in the RM found to have grass or weeds taller than 40 cms will be issued an Order to Remedy. If the grass has not been mowed by the deadline given in the Order, the RM will mow the lot and the landowner will be invoiced at a rate of \$500 per vacant lot or \$750 per developed lot.




