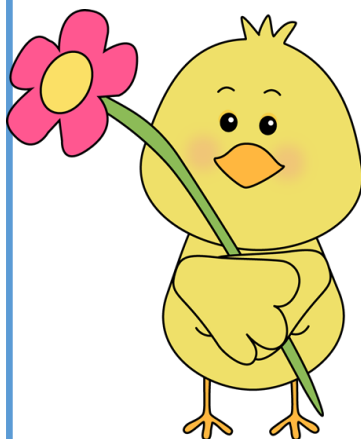

April 1, 2020

In an effort to contain the spread of COVID-19, the Town of Balgonie is taking measures to support the Province of Saskatchewan's health orders. The situation is changing rapidly and updates will be posted on the Town's website and the Town's Facebook page.

During the current COVID-19 pandemic and its impact on our local community of Balgonie, Town Council has made its response to the crisis in the following ways:

- Recreation and culture facilities are closed to the public until further notice.
- Playground structures are not open to use by the public until further notice.
- Town Council meetings will be held keeping with current social distancing recommendation and the orders pertaining to attendance at meetings. At this time, the public is asked to attend remotely if you wish to participate or attend a Council Meeting. Please call our office at 306-771-2284 or email townofbalgonie@sasktel.net. We will discuss your options for attending by telephone or video conference.
- The Town of Balgonie has made arrangements to ensure that the Town's essential services continue: Water, Sewer, Transportation Services, Sanitation, Protective Services and Administration. Staff and Council are practicing social distancing, rotating schedules, virtual access and separation of employees at work sites.
- The Town office while closed to public access is still operating daily, Monday to Friday. The telephone and emails will be answered by staff. Payments will be accepted via on-line banking, cheque, or credit card by using the Plastiq "Pay Now" option on the Town's website at www.townofbalgonie.ca. If you require your account number, please contact our office. The front lobby doors will be open during business hours for anyone wishing to drop off cheques under the office door.
- **The Town Council of Balgonie has implemented discontinuation of interest and penalties on outstanding taxes and utility accounts for a period of six months. No utility accounts will be disconnected during this time period.** The Town of Balgonie understands that at this time, households may be struggling to make full payments and this cancellation of interest penalties will help reduce the strain. Although utility account payments may be made for the amount and frequency which you decide, the Town appreciates the payments that are made by the due date. Interest will resume on accounts at the end of six months and will apply to the total overdue balances at that time. If you require further information on your accounts and interest penalties, please contact our office staff for assistance.

These are trying and uncertain times for our Community, Province and World. It is apparent that this crisis has impacted everyone and there will be difficult challenges ahead. The Town Council wants to commend all of the efforts that are being made in the community to protect our citizens. Your efforts to social distance and isolate from others, when required, is key to fighting the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Balgonie is continuing to show its strength and heart through the many efforts and good deeds of family, neighbours, community groups, and volunteers.

CONTAMINATION ALERT

February 2020

Dear Resident,

Crisis is perhaps too strong a word, but contamination of recycle material is, in general, a growing problem in North America. In 2018 China stopped accepting recycle materials from around the globe. The result is an oversupply of recyclables, driving values down and processing costs up. The need for maintaining and improving the quality of what is collected is greater than ever.

As you know, recycling processing relies, in part, on separating acceptable materials from garbage. Material Recovery Facilities (MRFs) are being vigilant in reducing the contamination levels in the materials they are marketing; however, this takes more time and expense.

In order to maintain a strong and effective recycling program, we need your cooperation. Any items listed as acceptable can go in the 'BLUE' recycle cart and any remaining items go in the garbage or an alternative recycling facility, e.g. light bulbs and metal parts. Contaminated recycle loads may result in additional fees being charged back to the municipalities.

If you have any doubt whether or not an item can be recycled, please contact Loraas or at a minimum, *when in doubt put it in the garbage.*

Attached is a helpful poster which outlines our recycling program. This poster details what can and cannot be put in the blue cart or bin.

Thank You, we appreciate your cooperation as we attempt to keep recycle material clean and costs to the municipalities low.

QUESTIONS FREQUENTLY ASKED REGARDING APPEALING YOUR PROPERTY ASSESSMENT

(The following questions and answers are taken from the pamphlet "Understanding the Property Assessment Appeal Process" from the Saskatchewan Government Relations, Provincial Municipal Relations and Advisory Services)

What is Property Assessment?

Property assessment is the process of determining a property's assessed value as of a specific date for property tax purposes. The assessment provides an estimate of the property's value that reflects typical market conditions.

Local governments use property assessments as a basis for the distribution of property taxes among property owners. Property assessment is not the same as property tax. The assessment of a property is the value assigned to it as the basis for allocating taxes among various classes of property.

Who Can I Contact to Explain My Assessment?

You should start with your Administrator of your Municipality (Phone 306-771-2284). You can also call SAMA (Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency) (Phone 306-924-8080) as it is the agency that performs Balgonie's assessments; however, there may be a charge for this service.

Preparing the Notice of Appeal Form

When making an assessment appeal, the notice of appeal form must be fully completed. You must provide specific grounds supporting the appeal. You are required to provide as many details as possible and all facts and evidence that an error has been made in the:

- valuation of the property;
- classification of the property;
- preparation of the relevant assessment roll or assessment notice; and/or
- content of the relevant assessment roll or assessment notice.

The grounds for the appeal must be detailed. Phrases such as "assessment too high" or "assessment too low" are **NOT** sufficient.

It is your responsibility to make a case to the Board of Revision. It may be as simple as proving that dimensions or measurements are wrong or that a classification is not correct, or as complex as proving that the value of a property is not fairly assessed compared to another property that is similar in nature.

Regular Assessment Appeals or Simplified Assessment Appeals?

When making regular or simplified assessment appeals, the Notice of Appeal form must be fully completed. Regular appeal – the appellant must provide specific written grounds supporting the appeal when submitting it to the secretary before the hearing. Simplified appeal - the appellant is not required to submit detailed written grounds to the secretary before the hearing but must have detailed information ready to present to the appeal board.

Can I Base My Appeal on the Fact that I Feel my Taxes are Too High?

NO! Legislation outlines the valid grounds for an appeal. Only your property assessment can be appealed, not the property taxes or the mill rates.

Proposals will be evaluated by the Balgonie Elks based on:

1. Proposed menu selection and price point
2. Vendor home base location
3. Equipment requirements

1. Up to four food vendors may be selected to supply food services for the July 1 event.
2. A designated spot along Main St. in Balgonie will be assigned to each vendor. There are no utility provisions within the designated spot. All electrical/heat/sanitary functions must be supplied by the vendor in a safe manner.

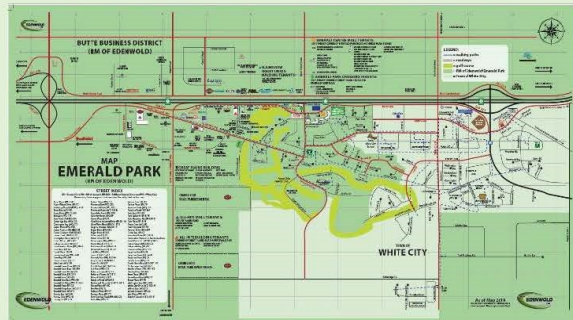
Members of both staff and council continue to be available by phone or by email. For after hour emergencies, please call 306-791-5089.

Emerald Park/Butte Business District Map

Each year, the RM prints and distributes a complimentary map of the Emerald Park & Butte Business District region to help people locate businesses and navigate residential areas, highway exits and service roads, parks spaces, recreational facilities and pedestrian walking trails. Copies of the map are available at the RM office and the map can also be viewed on the RM website under *Business*.

Dust Control Application Deadline – April 30th

The RM will cover 50% of the cost for approved residential dust control applications up to a distance of 200 meters. Landowners are responsible for 100% of the costs of for any distance beyond 200 meters. Approved residential landowners along the provincially-designated over-dimensional route will only be invoiced for 40% of the actual cost. Landowners are eligible for **one** subsidized dust control application per year – subsequent applications may be offered but will be fully at the landowner's expense.

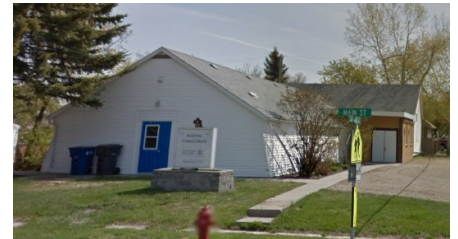

The air-conditioned facility may be rented by members and non-members for various functions such as coffee teas, anniversaries, birthdays, etc.





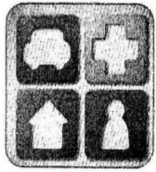

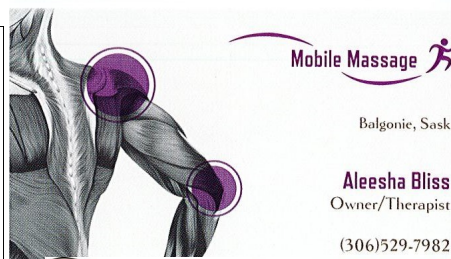
