We have had many complaints of ATVs driving in and around town. Please refer to Bylaw #391/2016, for the usage of these vehicles in Town. The RCMP and CSOs are aware of the problem and will be monitoring our Town for infractions and underage drivers.

Please be respectful of others and their property when using these vehicles. ATVs/dirt bikes can be driven from your property to the nearest exit. No stunting allowed and children under the age of 16 are not permitted to drive these vehicles. Please see the next page for information from the ATV act.

Driver's licence

3(1) No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle unless he holds a subsisting driver's licence issued to him by the administrator.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to a person who:

(a) carries with him a licence to drive issued to him by the Government of Canada and is operating an all terrain vehicle in the service of and owned by the Government of Canada and produces the licence at the request of any peace officer; or

(b) subject to subsection 58(1) of *The Traffic Safety Act*, is a non-resident.

1988-89, c.A-18.02, s.3; 2004, c.T-18.1, s.298.

Age of operator

4 No person under the age of 16 years shall operate an all terrain vehicle.

1988-89, c.A-18.02, s.4.

Exceptions

5 Subsections 3(1) and section 4 do not apply to a person:

(a) while that person is operating an all terrain vehicle on private land owned or occupied by him or a member of his immediate family;

(b) of the age of 12 years or more but under the age of 16 years, while the person is operating an all terrain vehicle on:

(i) any public or private land;

(ii) a highway for the purpose of crossing the highway by the most direct and shortest route of travel available to him; or

(iii) the untravelled portion of a highway;

and the operator of the all terrain vehicle:

(iv) is accompanied on the all terrain vehicle, if it is designed for the transportation of one or more passengers, by a person who holds and has held continuously for the immediately preceding 365 days a licence that permits him to operate the vehicle;

(v) is supervised by a person who holds and has held continuously for the immediately preceding 365 days a licence that permits him to operate the all terrain vehicle; or

(vi) has successfully completed a training course, approved by the board, with respect to the operation of all terrain vehicles and provides evidence of having successfully completed the course to a peace officer making a request for that evidence; or

(i) that is equipped with not more than two wheels;

(ii) on an enclosed race track or trail on private land; and

(iii) during the course of an event carried out, promoted or sponsored by a person or organization approved by the board.

Fireworks are not to be set off in Town unless approved by Town Council. Our environment is very dry right now, please use extreme caution when using your backyard firepits.

Please be aware of Bylaw #198 Respecting Fire Prevention. During this very dry season please respect fires in your backyard and make sure that all fires are in a secure firepit. Do not burn leaves or grass in your yard, this can be very dangerous and can easily spread to other areas or buildings. We ask that you transport leaves and grass and any untreated wood to the proper area at the Transfer station. (Please be sure to put all items in the proper location).



A Bylaw To Amend Bylaw No. 198 Known As The Bylaw Respecting Fire Prevention in and for the Town of Balgonie

The Council of the Town of Balgonie in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Bylaw No. 198 is amended as herein set forth by inserting:

1. (3)a. No burning barrels or outdoor burning devices with the exception of propane or briquet barbecues, chimineas or approved and inspected firepits shall be used within town limits.
2. (3)c. No other fuel other than seasoned wood, propane, natural gas or other town approved material or fuel may be burned in a fire pit or cheminea.
3. (3)d. The burning shall be done in a properly constructed brick or metallic burner covered with a suitable wire mesh, in a chiminea with a non-combustible apron of .5 metres that encompasses the chiminea or in an incinerator of a design approved by the Fire Chief or some other person appointed by Council.

COVID-19 Update

- In recognition of the financial strain experienced by many as a result of COVID-19, Council has approved a 15% reduction to the municipal mill rate for all properties in the RM. As usual, taxes will be levied in August.
- No late fees will be charged on overdue utility bills through the end of 2020.
- The Division 4 by-election will take place this fall with the scheduled general elections for Reeve and divisions 1, 3, and 5. The three candidates previously nominated for Division 4 will stand – nominations will not be re-opened.
- Preparations are being made to re-open the municipal office, however the date has yet to be determined. Information will be posted on our website as it becomes available.

- The deadline to file an assessment appeal is **June 24th**. Assessment notices and information have been sent out to owners of property where a change on the assessment role has occurred from the previous year. More information related to appeals is included with the notice.

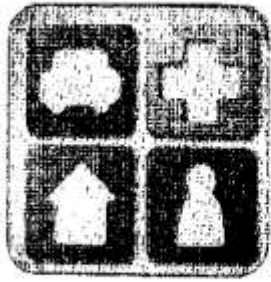

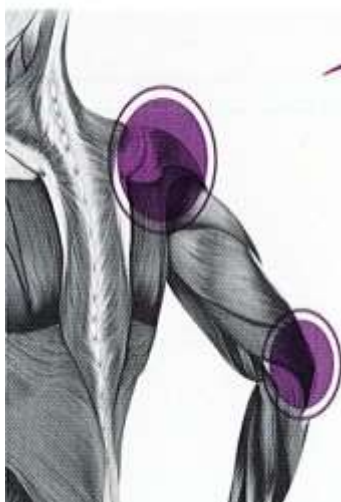
