2019 Financial Overview for Waterworks and Sewer

The following is information for the Town of Balgonie waterworks as required under *The Municipalities Regulations*.

- Total water and sewer **revenues – \$ 1,186,717**
- Total waterworks and sewer **expenditures—\$ 1,725,660**
- Total debt repayment on waterworks and sewer infrastructure – **\$ 272,291**
- Comparison of waterworks and sewer revenues to expenditures plus debt payments (expressed as a ratio)
$$\frac{1,186,717}{1,725,660 + 272,291 = 1,997,951} = .60$$

For 2019 waterworks and sewer revenues covered 60 % percent of the waterworks and sewer expenditures.

- Amount transferred out of the utility reserve to cover the deficit – **\$ 280,000**
- Amount received in grants for capital wastewater project- **\$516,000**
- Amount of 2019 supplementary funding from general revenue required to cover expenditures **\$ 15,200**
- Reserves available for waterworks capital infrastructure - **\$345,700**

 - the Waterworks Rate Policy and capital investment strategy
 - 2018 financial overview of the waterworks
 - waterworks reserves
 - a copy of the 2004, 2011 and 2015 waterworks assessment reports

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT BYLAW NO. 417/2020

Public notice is hereby given that the Council of the Town of Balgonie intends to adopt a by-law, under *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, to amend Bylaw No. 374/2014, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

INTENT:

The proposed bylaw will amend the zoning bylaw to allow more than one building on a site in the High Profile Commercial-HPC and the Commercial/Light Industrial-C2 Districts.

REASON:

The reason for the bylaw amendment is to accommodate proposals for multiple building commercial developments in the Town of Balgonie.

Mail-in voting:

Town Council recently passed a Bylaw which will permit residents to mail in their ballots for the 2020 Municipal Elections. Eligible voters will have the option to register to vote by Mail-in Ballot rather than vote in person at the Advance Polls or Election Day Polls.

If you are eligible to vote in the Municipal Election and wish to vote by this method, you may fill out *Form 'R' and Form 'C'*, and return it to the Returning Officer at the Town of Balgonie at 129 - D Railway Street prior to October 9, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.

The forms may also be returned by e-mail to townofbalgonie@sasktel.net or faxed to 306-771-2899.

Forms are available on the Town of Balgonie website, newsletter and are also available to voters at the Town Office.

Voters who register to vote by Mail-In Ballot will not be eligible to vote at the Election Day Poll or the Advance Poll. Mail-In Ballot kits will be provided to the registered voters prior to Election Day.

Instructions for Witnesses for Mail-In Voter Registration and Declaration

As the person who witnesses the voter's signature on the Voter's Registration and Declaration of Person Requesting Mail-in Ballot Form, you will need to review the applicant's identification and confirm that you are satisfied that the voter's identity has been established. The voter applying for the mail-in ballot should produce:

- One piece of identification issued by the Government of Canada, the Government of Saskatchewan, a municipality or a government agency that contains a photograph of the applicant, the applicant's name and address and the applicant's signature; or
- One piece of identification issued by the Government of Canada, the Government of Saskatchewan, a municipality or a government agency that contains a photograph of the applicant voter and the applicant's name and signature, and a second piece of identification prescribed in the Regulations that contains the applicant's name and address.

As the Witness, you will need to provide your signature, first and last name, phone number and/or email address. Witnesses will be 18 years of age or older.

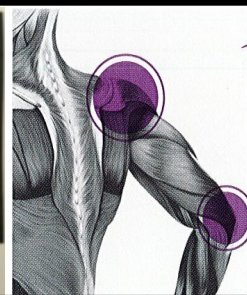

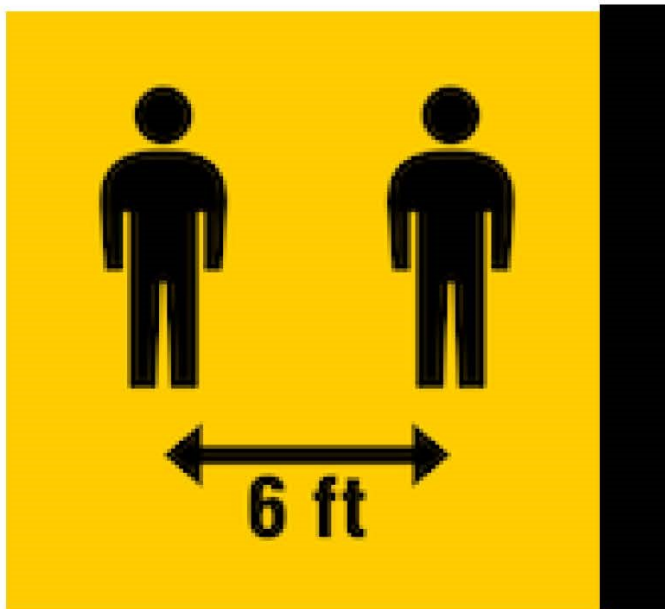
Recreation News

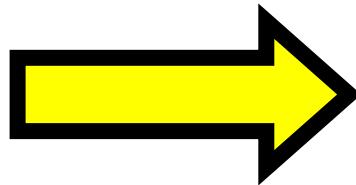

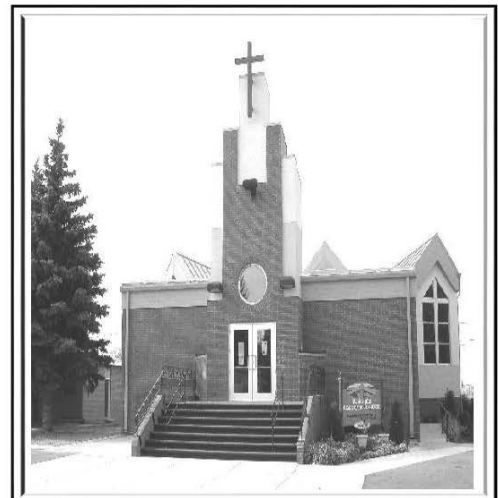

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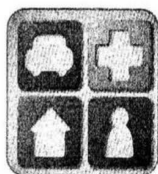
