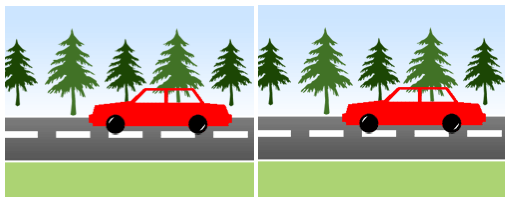

All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and/or junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" as per the Town of Balgonie's Bylaws.

After a snowfall, please refrain from parking your vehicles on the street. It is much easier for the Town Maintenance Personnel to properly remove snow when vehicles are moved!

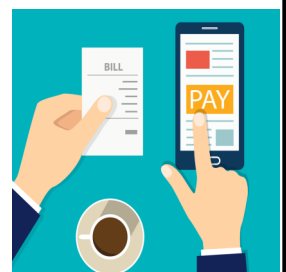


Electronic Payments

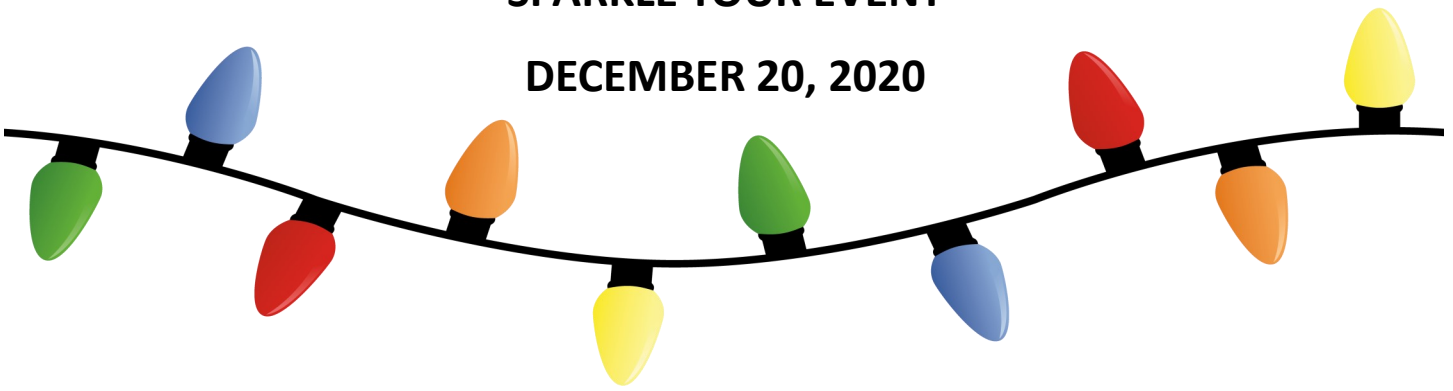

What is the Tune-Up Assistance Program?



The Tune-Up Assistance Program (TAP) is designed to help income qualified homeowners maintain their natural gas space heating equipment.

Completing a Home Heating Tune-Up and regularly replacing the furnace filter keeps warm air flowing throughout your home, reduces the workload on your furnace, improves indoor air quality and helps reduce the risk of carbon monoxide.

A participating SaskEnergy Network Member will complete the following Home Heating Tune-Up service, and provide a carbon monoxide alarm plus two furnace filters, for selected homeowners free-of-charge:

- Visually inspect chimney and remove debris
- Visually check heat exchanger
- Examine blower compartment
- Clean and lubricate motor and fan
- Examine operation of fan and high limit controls
- Clean and reset burners
- Test thermostat and furnace switch
- Inspect gas pilot system
- Examine and adjust drive system
- Check carbon monoxide levels
- Clean or replace filter

Program Terms and Conditions

- Applicants with household gross incomes of more than \$68,000 will not be accepted.
- SaskEnergy will select participants based on homeowner need, location, and such other criteria relevant to SaskEnergy. Not all applicants will be accepted into the Program.
- Selected participants shall ensure their property is a safe place for contractors and SaskEnergy employees to access and perform activities in relation to the Program.
- Only one application per household.
- Renters/rental properties are not eligible.
- Successful applicants from previous years are not eligible.
- Only those homeowners selected will be contacted.
- Homeowners must provide their authorization and waiver of liability as required by SaskEnergy to participate in the Program.
- Program terms and conditions are subject to change by SaskEnergy without notice.
- Program dates and communities are subject to change by SaskEnergy without notice.
- Funding for the Program is limited and applications will be reviewed on a "first come first served" basis.
- A person or entity applying under the Program must be the registered homeowner and be a SaskEnergy Residential Customer.
- In order to be eligible for the Program applicants must have a satisfactory credit score with SaskEnergy.
- Selected homeowners may receive all or some of the following: a SaskEnergy Network Home Heating Tune-Up valued at \$149.95; \$90 for a second furnace within the household; 2 furnace filters, one carbon monoxide alarm, up to \$100 for minor repairs (if required), and applicable taxes.
- Selected participants are responsible to pay for any repairs over and above what SaskEnergy will cover under this Program, which may include repairs that must be fixed for safety reasons.
- If additional repairs to the home heating system are required, SaskEnergy may, provided Program participants have satisfactory credit as determined by SaskEnergy, extend credit to a maximum of \$500 for such repairs (APR of 10.5% and fixed term of 12 months; may pay in full at any time). For example, if the repair to be financed was \$250 and the customer took twelve months to pay, the cost of credit would be \$14.48. SaskEnergy may delay or deny any extension of credit in its absolute discretion.
- Please note participants are selected for the 2020 edition of the Program only, and potential benefits are limited to the above.

3. Protect your property by marking it. Although we mark some potential hazards, it can be nearly impossible to see where the road edge meets your grass or rocks unless

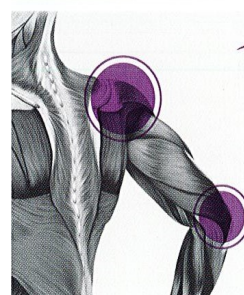

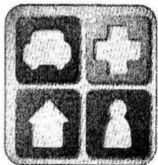

COVID-19 Update: New Measures in Effect November 27

Released by the Government of Saskatchewan on November 25, 2020

COVID-19 transmission rates in Saskatchewan continue to increase, resulting in serious illness and deaths, placing provincial health care resources under increasing strain. Additional public health measures are being introduced based on the transmission patterns observed in Saskatchewan, providing further guidance to help reduce COVID-19 case numbers over the coming weeks.

These additional health measures come into effect at 12:01 a.m., Friday, November 27 and, along with current health measures, remain in effect until December 17, 2020. At that time they will be reviewed by the provincial Chief Medical Health Officer.

Enforcement of public health orders is permitted under *The Public Health Act, 1994*.

Mandatory Masking Expanded

Mandatory, non-medical mask use will be required during all indoor fitness activities, with aquatic activities the only exception.

Mandatory, non-medical masking will be extended to:

- All students, employees and visitors in all schools and day cares (except while consuming food or beverage or engaging in aquatic fitness activities). Children ages 0-2 years are exempt from wearing masks. Children ages 3-12 should wear a mask if they are able to;
- All employees and visitors in all common areas in businesses and workplaces, even in those areas which the public does not have access (e.g. construction sites, manufacturing facilities); and
- All residents, employees and visitors in all common areas in provincial and municipal correctional facilities.

Note that masking continues to be required in indoor public areas that have installed barriers.
