The Town of Balgonie is excited to announce that the Wireless Water Fill Station is up and running!

The Water Fill Station is located at the Water Treatment Plant (201 South Railway Street W). Water rates are \$3.75 per cubic meter (220 Imperial Gallons or 1,000 L). Payment can be made at the station by credit card or you can set up a pre-paid account through the Town Office.

If you choose to set up an account, you will have access to your own User Account which will allow you to start the pump from the push of a button, view your usage reports, and increase your account balance with your credit card.

#### 2021 Revaluation Information Sheet

#### SAMA and the 2021 Revaluation?

The Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA) is the recognized leader of property assessments in Saskatchewan. The Agency is responsible for a \$242 Billion property assessment base, which is used by local governments to levy a \$2.1 Billion property tax base.

SAMA conducts revaluations based on a four-year cycle. 2017 was the year of the last revaluation, and the 2021 Revaluation will see assessed values updated to reflect a new base date of January 1, 2019.

The legislated base date means that 2021 values reflect a property's value as of January 1, 2019, not January 1, 2021.


How are Revaluations different from maintenance or reinspections?

Revaluations update the market value of a property to a new base date, they are not a physical reinspection of a property. As opposed to maintenance or reinspections, which often seek to update physical changes a property, revaluations are centred on updating the value of a property to the new market base date.

What does 2021 mean to you?

Preliminary trend information for the 2021 Revaluation shows smaller shifts for most property types as compared with the 2017 Revaluation.

This chart uses provincial averages to show the preliminary trend information for various property types. It should be noted these are preliminary trends for the entire province, and the local changes for a specific municipality may vary once the revaluation is implemented in January 2021.

## RECYCLING GUIDELINES

(What is allowed in the single-stream recycling carts)

## **CARDBOARD**& BOXBOARD

Ex: Flattened cardboard, cereal boxes, paper egg cartons, milk & juice cartons



#### PLASTICS #1 to #7

Ex: Pop bottles, milk jugs, soap bottles, rinsed food & drink containers (juice, yogurt, etc.)



## MIXED PAPER

Ex: Newspapers, office paper, fliers, & shredded paper (in clear plastic bag)



## HOUSEHOLD TIN & ALUMINUM

Ex: Aluminum containers & foil, tin cans, & aluminum beverage cans



# HELPFUL RECYCLING TIPS:

- \* Rinse out all food & drink items
- \* Flatten cardboard boxes
- \* Remove lids/caps from bottles
- \* No plastic bags of any kind, including "crinkly" or "stretchy" plastics
- \* Place all items loose in the cart; except shredded paper
- \* Plastics must have a #1 to #7 recycle symbol on the bottom

## KEEP THESE ITEMS OUT

(Not allowed in single-stream recycling)

#### HOUSEHOLD WASTE

Ex: Diapers, coffee cups, feminine hygiene items, used tissues, dirty clothes, dishes, food bags, & garbage bags



## NON-RECYCLABLE PLASTICS

Ex: Black plastic, Styrofoam, toys, garden pots, bottle caps, & plastic bags



#### **ORGANICS**

Ex: Food waste, leaves & branches, grass, egg shells, coffee grounds & tea bags



## DIVERTABLE WASTE

Ex: Electronics, tires, mirrors, power cords, all tools, clothing, car parts, lawn furniture, clothes hangers, scrap metal, & glass



## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Ex: Batteries, aerosol containers, paint cans, cleaning products, propane tanks, & lightbulbs



#### **BIO HAZARDS**

Ex: Needles, human and pet waste/feces, Band-aids, bodily fluids, & animal carcasses



#### TRANSFER STATION

The Transfer Station is electronically set up and monitored, to provide our town residents with accessibility day or night. The Town of Balgonie offers services on site at the Transfer Station, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not disposing of items in the manner set forth by the Provincial Ministry of Environment and the Provincial Clean Air Act.

Items are continually being left at the Transfer Station, which are not permitted, even though the areas are clearly marked. **IF THERE IS NO BIN, DO NOT LEAVE <u>ANY</u> ITEMS WHERE THE BIN IS NORMALLY LOCATED**. The red bins are available the first (1<sup>st</sup>) and third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Fridays of every month. There is no specific time as to when the bin will arrive on these days. Individuals who leave items which are not permitted will be fined up to \$500.00, and will have their Transfer Station card suspended. <u>The card holder will be held accountable for all occurrences</u> at the Transfer Station whether they accessed it or lent their card to another person.

#### Items that may be left at the TRANSFER STATION in their designated areas:

- Scrap metal Freon removed from fridge/freezers.
- Tree branches Absolutely <u>NO</u> treated or painted wood.
- Compostable materials bags or boxes containing items not to be left in compostable area.
- Oil recycling station.

#### YOU <u>MAY NOT</u> LEAVE THE FOLLOWING AT THE TRANSFER STATION:

Microwaves	Propane tanks	Plastics	Televisions
Gyproc	Batteries	Shingles	Computer equipment
Tires	Cement	Toilets	Fiberglass insulation
Couches	Mattresses	Painted wood	Flat glass-window panes
Chairs	Windshields	Paint cans	Pressure treated wood

These items must be taken to the Regina Landfill site. Although a bin may be available, some of these items utilize the entirety of the bin, making it unusable for other residents.

Key cards that are lost should be reported to our office immediately. They will be removed from the system and a new card, if requested, will be provided to your residence at a cost of \$40.00.

If you are moving, we request that the card be left in a visible place for the new residents. The card is associated with the physical address of your home.
