Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours, except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property.

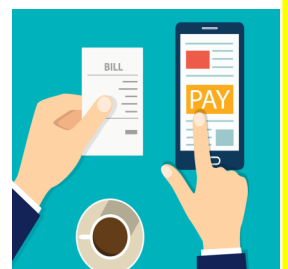


### Electronic Payments

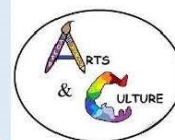

December in Review | 2020

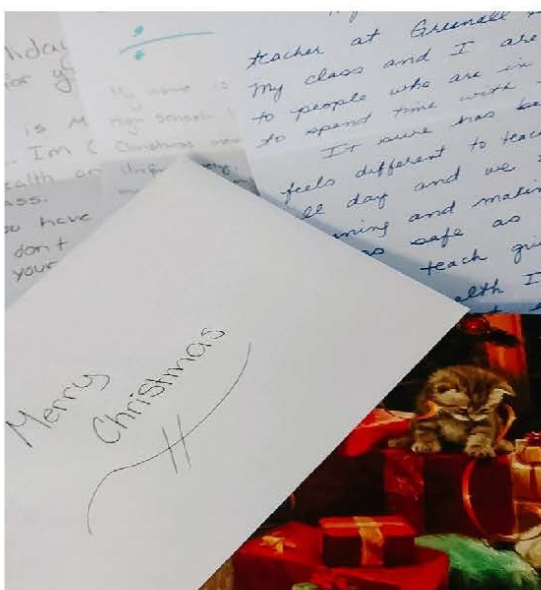


Greenall students continue to celebrate School Spirit days. Students and staff can be seen in their toques, plaid, and holiday sweaters!

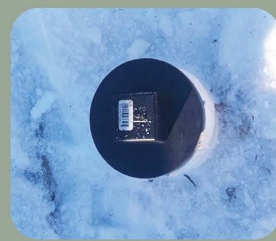

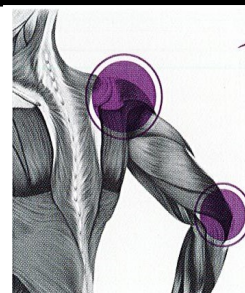

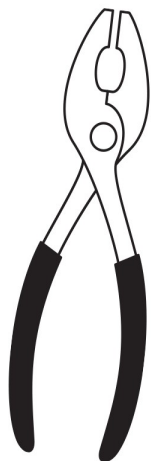
