

SWIMMING POOLS

Have you been thinking about putting a private swimming pool in your back yard? Please contact the Town Office prior to placing a swimming pool in your yard to confirm that you are following the rules and regulations set out in the Zoning Bylaw. The rules are in place to keep yourself and our community safe.

- The pool must meet the minimum distance required from any lot or street line (please contact the Town Office to confirm the distance required depending on the area you are inquiring about);
- The maximum height of the pool is 1.2 metres (3.94 feet) above the average finished grade level of the ground adjoining the pool and within 4.5 metres (14.77 feet) of such pool;
- Every swimming pool shall be enclosed by a non-climbable fence of at least 1.8 metres (5.91 feet) in height and not more than 10 cm (3.94 inches) from the ground, and located at a distance of not less than 1.5 metres (4.92 feet) from the pool with a lockable gate, equal in height to the fence; and
- Any deck attached to or abutting a swimming pool shall be considered as part of the swimming pool and shall:
 - i. have a minimum side yard of .75 metres (2.46 feet) if detached from the principal building and have a minimum distance of 1.2 metres (3.94 feet) from the principal building.
 - ii. have a minimum side yard of 1.5 metres (4.92 feet) if attached to or abutting the principal building.

Introduction

The Water Security Agency and the Ministry of Environment requires that at least once each year waterworks owners provide notification to consumers of the quality of water produced and supplied as well as information on the performance of the waterworks in submitting samples as required by a Minister's Order or Permit to Operate a waterworks. A minimum of 0.1 milligrams per litre (mg/L) free chlorine residual is required for water entering the distribution system. Tests are normally performed on a daily basis by the waterworks operator and are to be recorded in operation records. This data includes the number of free chlorine residual tests performed, the overall range of free chlorine residual (highest and lowest recorded values) and the number of tests and percentage of results not meeting the minimum requirement of 0.1 mg/L free chlorine residual.

Chemical - Health Category

All waterworks serving less than 5000 persons are required to submit water samples for SE's Chemical Health category once every 2 years. The Chemical Health category includes analysis for arsenic, barium, boron, cadmium, chromium, fluoride, lead, nitrate, selenium and uranium.

The last sample for Chemical Health analysis was submitted on **January 19**, **2021**. Sample results indicated that the provincial drinking water quality standards were not exceeded.




Balgonie Elementary School & Community Council




