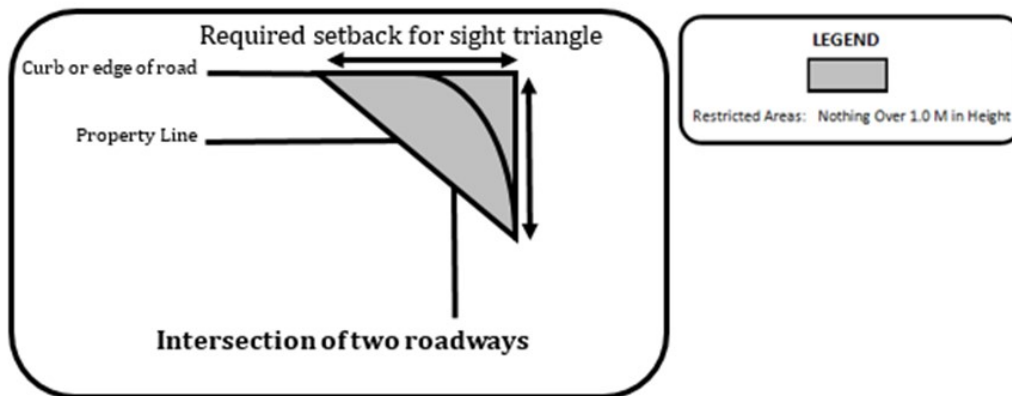
Bylaw No. 424/2021

The Town of Balgonie passed Bylaw No. 424/2021 which discusses Intersection Sight Triangles.

4.15.5 of Bylaw No. 424/2021 states the following:

In all zoning districts, no building, structure, earth pile, vegetation, etc. shall obstruct the view of pedestrians or drivers within a required sight line triangle as follows:

- a) Where a tree is located in a required sight triangle, the foliage and branches shall be trimmed to a height of 1.6 metres (5.25 feet) from ground level.
- b) Hedges, shrubs and fences shall not exceed 1.0 metre (3.28 feet) in height from ground level.
- c) If, in Council's opinion, an object or vegetation within a required sight triangle could obstruct the view of traffic, Council may require the landowner to remove, relocate or trim the obstruction at the landowner's expense.
- d) Signs, neighbourhood mailboxes, or other objects administered by the local, provincial, or federal government may be exempt from requirements, provided they do not pose a threat to public safety.



As you can see in the diagram, the sight triangle area shall be measured by connecting straight lines, which are measured from the intersection of the top of the curb adjacent to the two roadways to points established along these lines in accordance with the following distances. Where a road does not have a curb, the edge of the road shall be used to measure the sight triangle.

Unless greater distances are required by the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure, a railway company, or as a result of topographical constraints, sight triangle setbacks shall be as follows:

- Provincial/public highways—90 metres (295.27 feet).
- Municipal grid roads and/or railways—46 metres (150.92 feet).
- Local streets—10 metres (32.81 feet).

2020 Financial Overview for Waterworks and Wastewater

The following is information for the Town of Balgonie waterworks as required under *The Municipalities Regulations*.

- Total water and sewer **revenues – \$ 1,263,385**
- Total waterworks and sewer **expenditures—\$ 1,302,317**
- Total debt repayment on waterworks and sewer infrastructure – **\$ 281,642**
- Comparison of waterworks and sewer revenues to expenditures plus debt payments (expressed as a ratio)

$$\frac{1,263,385}{1,583,959} = .80$$

For 2020 waterworks and sewer revenues covered 80 % percent of the waterworks and sewer expenditures.

- Amount transferred out of the utility reserve to cover the deficit – **\$ 306,741**
- Amount of 2020 supplementary funding from general revenue required to cover expenditures **\$ 13,833**
- Reserves available for waterworks and wastewater capital infrastructure - **\$54,546**

 - 2019 financial overview of the waterworks

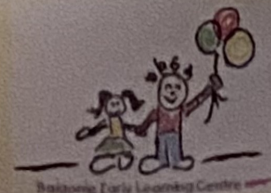

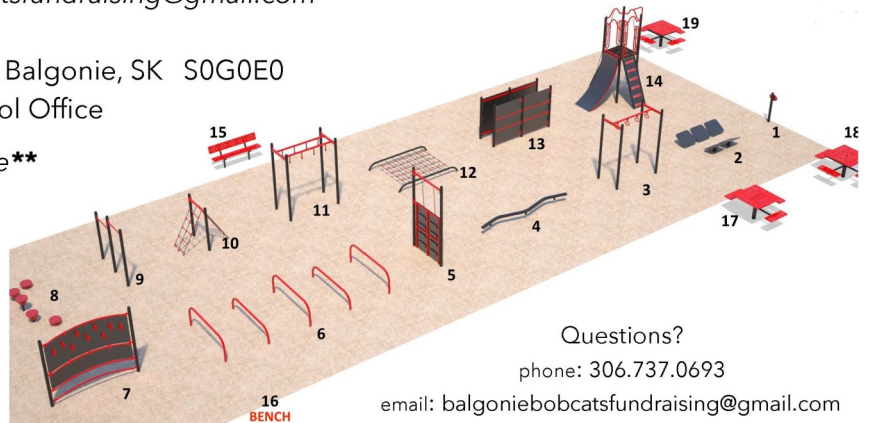

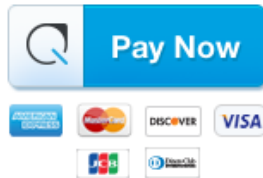
Plastiq Payments

3. Sign up—create a free account, add who you're paying, and enter your card info;
4. Plastiq will process your payment and the funds will be transferred to the Town of Balgonie.

The fees associated with Plastiq are as follows:

- Standard credit card rate 2.85%;
- Debit cards are discounted to 1%.

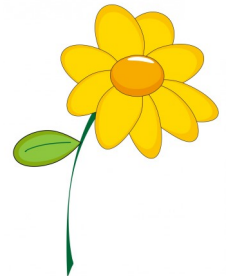
