
School is back! This means the community and school zones will be busier. Please slow down to 30 km/hour, as indicated by the School Zone signs, and watch for people crossing.

School Bus Safety

When approaching a bus that has its stop arm out and its red flashing lights activated, as a driver:

- You must stop no closer than 5 m (15 ft) from the front or back of the bus.
- You must not advance your vehicle until the bus driver turns off the flashing red stop lamps and deactivates the stop arm.
- Before moving, check to see that all children have safely crossed the roadway.

Passing a school bus with red flashing lights is a serious offence and will result in a minimum fine of \$360.



E-BILLING...

WHAT IS E-BILLING?

E-billing—or electronic billing—is the process of receiving bills online. The electronic billing system enables the Town of Balgonie to digitally send invoices to ratepayers.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

Electronic billing improves efficiency and saves time! Historically, bills have been delivered through the mail. The process of data entry and invoice-generation, putting bills into envelopes, mailing those envelopes, and then waiting for them to be received is a very time-consuming process. While time-saving is a major benefit, the reduction of manual labour on repetitious tasks allows employees to focus their time on other important duties!

Traditional billing and payment methods relied heavily on paper. E-bills reduce the amount of paper, ink, and postage used, which, in turn, is more cost effective and better for our environment.


