- Debit cards are discounted to 1%.

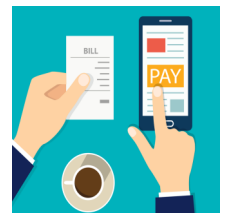


Electronic Payments

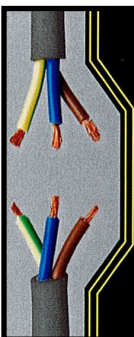
