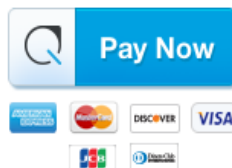

3. Sign up—create a free account, add who you're paying, and enter your card info;
4. Plastiq will process your payment and the funds will be transferred to the Town of Balgonie.



The fees associated with Plastiq are as follows:

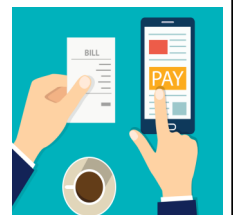
- Standard credit card rate 2.85%;

## **Clothing Drive a Success**

Balgonie Baptist Church says “thank-you” to the community for all the clothing and household donations made through November, December and January. The funds raised from this and the Steak Night, held at Colleen’s Diner in October, will be used to host a Syrian Refugee family when they arrive in Canada.

Mahmoud Issa, his wife Kadija and baby boy Kifa are currently living in Lebanon. An application has been made to the Federal Government to sponsor them. In preparation for their move, \$26,000 must be raised to help with settlement for their first year in Canada.

The plight of the Syrian refugees has moved the hearts of many Canadians. Can you imagine suffering the tragic loss of a child due to the continuous fighting in Syria and having another child permanently disabled due to bomb shrapnel embedded in his back? This has been the reality for the Issa family, Syrian refugees. Thankfully they were able to escape the deadly and ongoing Civil War and move to Regina. But two sons and their families were separated and left behind in the chaos.

7,590 pounds of donations and 36 furniture items were donated, raising \$986. Broken down it was 5,004 pounds of clothing, 2,243 pounds of miscellaneous goods and 143 pounds of books. Thank you for your generosity!

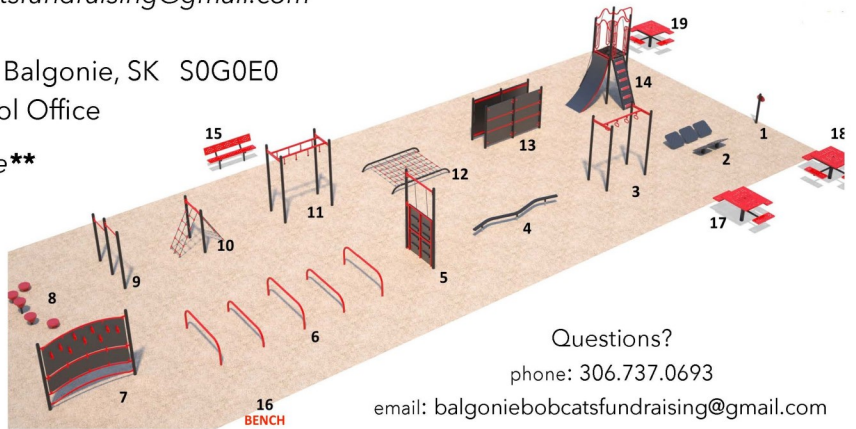

## *NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT BYLAW NO. 430/2022*

Public Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Town of Balgonie intends to adopt a Bylaw, under *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, to amend Bylaw 374/2014, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

### **INTENT:**

The intent of the proposed bylaw is to allow cannabis retail operations in the HPC-High Profile Commercial District. The amendment will provide minimum separation distances, minimum development standards, and define the land use.

### **REASON:**

The reason for the Bylaw amendment is to accommodate federally licensed cannabis retail operations in the Town.

### **PUBLIC INSPECTION:**

Any person may inspect the Bylaw at the Town of Balgonie Municipal Office Monday to Friday between 9:00 am to noon and 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm excluding statutory holidays. Copies are available at a cost at the Town Office.

### **PUBLIC HEARING:**

Council will hold a public hearing to receive submissions on the proposed Bylaw on February 14, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. at the Balgonie 50+ Club, 132 Queen Street. Council will also consider written submissions received at the hearing or delivered to the undersigned at the Town Office before the hearing. ## BES KINDERGARTEN FAQ'S

**1) How many students in the Kindergarten classrooms?**

This year we have two kindergarten classrooms, 23 and 24 students. Two teachers and one Educational Assistant make up our K-Team.

**2) Full Days or 1/2 Days?**

Our Kindergartners attend full days, alternating days on a six day cycle. We send the Kindergarten calendar out in June to help you schedule child care requirements.

**3) Are there other professionals who support Kindergartners?**

Besides the classroom teacher, and Educational Assistants (dependent on student needs), students are supported by a Speech Language Pathologist, a Psychologist and an Occupational Therapist as necessary.

**4) How do I know if my child is ready for Kindergarten?**

By helping your child be curious and independent, they will be ready for Kindergarten. If you have more questions, please contact Mrs. Moroz ([andrea.moroz@pvsd.ca](mailto:andrea.moroz@pvsd.ca)) about Kindergarten readiness screening questions. Remember, Play Based Learning is Kindergarten!

## TRANSFER STATION

The Transfer Station is electronically set up and monitored, to provide our town residents with accessibility day or night. The Town of Balgonie offers services on site at the Transfer Station, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not disposing of items in the manner set forth by the Provincial Ministry of Environment and the Provincial Clean Air Act.

Items are continually being left at the Transfer Station, which are not permitted, even though the areas are clearly marked. **IF THERE IS NO BIN, DO NOT LEAVE ANY ITEMS WHERE THE BIN IS NORMALLY LOCATED.** The red bins are available the first (1<sup>st</sup>) and third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Fridays of every month. There is no specific time as to when the bin will arrive on these days. Individuals who leave items which are not permitted will be fined up to \$500.00, and will have their Transfer Station card suspended. The card holder will be held accountable for all occurrences at the Transfer Station whether they accessed it or lent their card to another person.

### Items that may be left at the **TRANSFER STATION** in their designated areas:

- ⇒ Scrap metal – Freon removed from fridge/freezers.
- ⇒ Tree branches – Absolutely **NO** treated or painted wood.
- ⇒ Compostable materials – bags or boxes containing items not to be left in compostable area.
- ⇒ Oil recycling station.

### **YOU MAY NOT LEAVE THE FOLLOWING AT THE TRANSFER STATION:**

Microwaves	Propane tanks	Plastics	Televisions
Gyproc	Batteries	Shingles	Computer equipment
Tires	Cement	Toilets	Fiberglass insulation
Couches	Mattresses	Painted wood	Flat glass-window panes
Chairs	Windshields	Paint cans	Pressure treated wood

These items must be taken to the Regina Landfill site. Although a bin may be available, some of these items utilize the entirety of the bin, making it unusable for other residents.

Key cards that are lost should be reported to our office immediately. They will be removed from the system and a new card, if requested, will be provided to your residence at a cost of \$40.00.

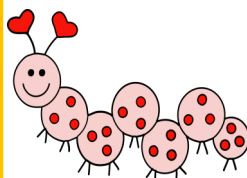
If you are moving, we request that the card be left in a visible place for the new residents. The card is associated with the physical address of your home.

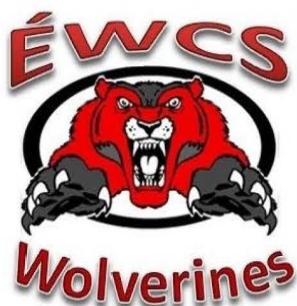
