OUTSTANDING TAXES AND UTILITIES

This is a friendly reminder that taxes and utilities are due December 31, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. If utilities remain unpaid, the balance of your utility bill (including interest charges and registered letter charges), will be added to your taxes.

All outstanding amounts will be subject to Tax Enforcement procedures. To remit a payment to the Town Office, you may do so through cheque, debit, or cash.


SNOW REMOVAL

We are very fortunate to have great staff to clear our streets and sidewalks for us! This time consuming job is made a lot easier when vehicles are moved off of the streets for the grader to come through. As well, the town boulevards (approximately the first 12-15 feet of each property) need to be free of vehicles, trailers and all other items as this is where the snow is placed. Main streets are done first, followed by side streets and then alleys. Depending on the severity of the storm and the amount of snow, it may take a while for all streets and alleys to be cleared. Please refrain from pushing your snow onto the streets/neighboring properties. Property owners are responsible for keeping the snow on their own property. If you would like the snow removed from your property, it is your responsibility to arrange this. Thank you for your co-operation and understanding!
