Hydrant Flushing - May 3rd & 4th

It is ok to use the water for showering, bathing and toilet flushing; however, do not use it for laundry.

Getting to know Miss Sam Dech

- 1. Where did you take your dance lessons growing up? I started dancing at the age of 3 with Balgonie Dance and Twirl and grew up dancing with our studio until the age of 18. Throughout my dance career I also took Canadian Dance Teacher Association classes in McLean and dance exams in Regina.
- **2.** What is your favorite dance type/genre to perform? My favourite types of dance to perform are tap and song and dance. It is the rhythm, musicality and overall performance that draws me to these styles most!
- **3. What is your favorite type/genre of dance to teach?** My favourite dance styles to teach are tap, musical theatre and jazz.
- **4.** How many years have you taught dance? I started assisting at the age of 12 and have been teaching my own dance classes for 7 years now with Balgonie Dance and Twirl.
- **5. What is the most important item you pack in your bag during competition season?** If I had to pick one item to be the most important when packing my bag during competition season, it would have to be my mini screwdriver set that comes in handy to tighten any loose tap shoe screws!
- **6. What is a** <u>funny</u> **dance memory?** A funny memory that comes to mind is one year my senior jazz group had one song between another dance number at the Wolseley dance competition. We were not allowed to change backstage, so we ended up changing practically out in the open, in a corner of the lobby with all the dance mom's trying their best to block us from the crowd lining up to enter the auditorium. It was quite a memorable experience because we didn't account for the people who might come strolling out of the washroom doors (both male and female) that were located behind us. I think they were more startled than us girls!
- **7.** What is your advice for our Senior dancers graduating this year? My advice for Senior dancers graduating this year would be to always make time for people and things that you love.
- **8.** What is your advice for our dancers just starting out? My advice for our dancers just starting out would be to persevere and push through! You are capable of more than you know.
- **9. What is your funniest teaching moment?** It is hard to pick just one funny teaching moment! If I had to pick one to share it would have to be the reoccurring potty trains that happen when teaching 3 & 4 year olds. As soon as one dancer says they need to use the washroom, everyone else needs to as well (even if they really don't).
- **10.** Why do you teach for the Balgonie Dance and Twirl Club? Balgonie Dance and Twirl is close to my heart! It is more than my dance studio; it is a second family. I teach for Balgonie Dance and Twirl because we value sportsmanship, teach kindness, and know how to have fun! Being a dance teacher within our community also gives me the opportunity to build lasting relationships with generations of great kids.
