Items blocking the lines which will not be covered by reimbursement include sanitary products, grease, or other

foreign objects in the lateral lines.

Please let the Town know when you have the sewer company scheduled at your home, as our maintenance personnel must be there to determine the problem.

ATV OWNERS

Vehicles that fall under the definition of All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV), may only use roads and walking paths as their most direct route, from point A to point B. Stunting and driving on walking






