Vehicles that fall under the definition of All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) are not allowed on any street within town limits, except for the purpose of crossing to get to the closest point of exit. Stunting and



driving on walking paths is not permitted, as it is a major safety concern for those who are walking or biking on the path. Please keep our community safe by following ATV legislation.

## Did you know...

The speed limit in Balgonie is 40 km/hr. unless otherwise specified (School zones, Griffin Road, etc).



Please keep our children and pedestrians safe by slowing down!

## Reminders

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24



hours except on weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie bylaws.

**Please do not park trailers on the street!** This causes difficulties for other drivers, blocks sight lines and can be dangerous for pedestrians and cyclists.

It is with great sadness that we are sharing the news of the passing of the Town of Balgonie's Mayor, Frank Thauberger.

Mayor Thauberger was a lively and friendly man with a great love for people. He took great pleasure in speaking with community members, looking for solutions and making the community a better place. He was first elected as a Councillor in 1995 and then elected for 2 terms as Mayor from 1997-2000 and 2000 to 2003. He chose to return to local government and was elected for 3 consecutive terms as Mayor in 2012, 2016, and 2020. During his time on Council, Mayor Thauberger worked to improve the Town's major infrastructure for water, wastewater, recreation facilities and protective services. While serving on several committees, he was an ambassador for the community and promoted Balgonie's interests to the region and the Province with a straight forward, "no nonsense" attitude. One of his favourite duties as Mayor was promoting governance to Balgonie Elementary School students and explaining how important local government is to the people it serves. Every Town project--large and small,

prominent and behind the scenes--were met with his optimism and enthusiasm, as Mayor Thauberger believed that municipal projects and policy have a direct and lasting impact on the quality of life for residents.

Mayor Thauberger's mission was to leave the Town of Balgonie better when he left office, *and so he has.* 

Our sincere sympathies to Frank's wife, Ruth; sons Nicholas, Mathew (Jasmine), and their children, Daniel, Leonardo, and Miguel. Frank will be fondly remembered and sadly missed.

#### NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT BYLAW NO. 449/2023

Public notice is hereby given that the Council of the Town of Balgonie intends to adopt a Bylaw, under *The Planning* and Development Act, 2007, to amend Bylaw No. 374/2014, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

#### **INTENT:**

The proposed Bylaw will rezone the lane in Block 1, Plan 16950 from C1-Town Centre Commercial District and R1-Residential District to CS-Community Service District. The land to be rezoned is outlined in red on the map below.



#### **REASON FOR THE AMEDNMENT:**

The Bylaw amendment will accommodate the development of a public recreational facility.

#### **PUBLIC INSPECTION:**

Any person may inspect the bylaw at the Town of Balgonie Municipal Office Monday to Friday between 9:00 am to noon and 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm excluding statutory holidays. Copies are available at cost at the Municipal Office.

Council will hold a public hearing to receive submissions on the proposed bylaw on Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town of Balgonie Council Chambers. Council will also consider written submissions received at the hearing or delivered to the undersigned at the municipal office before the hearing. By now you should have received your 2023 Tax Notice.

Did you know?

- Tax Notices are sent in June, but the total amount owing is for the entire calendar year.
- You may make monthly payments towards your outstanding balance rather than paying the total in one lump sum. Since taxes are not levied until June, a good way to determine the total amount to start paying in January is to take last year's total and divide it by 12. Once you receive your current year's notice, you can then adjust your monthly payments as necessary.
- Taxes are due, in full, by December 31<sup>st</sup>. If they remain unpaid, a 1.5% interest penalty will be applied to your account.
- Any tax amounts paid before August 31<sup>st</sup> will receive a 5% discount.

There are a few different ways you can pay your 2023 taxes:

**Online:** Using your online banking service, use **Balgonie (Town of) Taxes**. If you are unsure of your account number, please contact the Town Office. A great option when using online is setting up monthly payments. This way you can pay smaller payments until the end of the year.

In Person: We accept debit, cheque or cash. Credit cards are not accepted in the office.

**Credit Cards:** Go to <u>www.townofbalgonie.ca</u> and pay with Plastiq on the bottom right hand side of the screen. Please note there are fees associated with this payment method.



## - TRANSFER STATION -

The Transfer Station is electronically set up and monitored to provide our Town residents with accessibility day and night. The Town of Balgonie offers on site services at the Transfer Station, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not properly disposing of items set forth by the Ministry of Environment and the *Clean Air Act*.

The card holder will be held accountable for all occurrences at the Transfer Station whether they accessed the Transfer Station themselves or provided their card to another individual in their household. Lending the card out to another residence in Town or anyone else is definitely NOT PERMITTED.

Transfer Station cards are initially provided to the "New" home owner at no charge. However, if a card is lost; it must be reported to the Town Office immediately to be disabled. The card will be removed from the system and a new card, if requested, will be provided at a cost of \$40.00.

The red Loraas Disposal bin is currently delivered on the first (1st) and third (3rd) Friday of every month. There is no specific time as to when the bin will arrive on these days. IF A RED BIN IS UNAVAILABLE, DO NOT LEAVE ANY ITEMS WHERE THE BIN IS NORMALLY LOCATED. Individuals who leave items which are not permitted will be fined up to \$500.00, and will have their Transfer Station card suspended. Additional fines may be levied by the Ministry for individuals dumping illegally.

Be courteous of others! Although the bin may be available, large items and multiple loads take up the entirety of the bin, making it unusable for other residents. If you have multiple large items, please take them to the Regina Landfill.

Home builders/developers are NOT permitted to use the red Loraas Disposal bin and are required to rent their own waste container bins.

#### Items that may be left at the Transfer Station in their designated areas:

- $\Rightarrow$  Scrap Metal
  - Propane tanks are accepted in the scrap metal pile
  - Please remove the Freon from fridges and freezers
- $\Rightarrow$  Tree Branch/Grass/Leaf Piles
  - Absolutely NO treated or painted wood
  - Grass and leaves must be UNBAGGED
- $\Rightarrow$  Compostable Materials
  - Bags or boxes containing compostable materials are NOT to be left in the compost area
- $\Rightarrow$  Oil Recycling Station
- $\Rightarrow$  Cement

#### Items that may NOT be left at the Transfer Station or in the red Loraas Disposal bin:

 $\Rightarrow$  Tires and Shingles

#### Items you are encouraged to recycle at SARCAN:

- $\Rightarrow~$  Beverage Containers, Batteries, Electronics, Household Paint and
- $\Rightarrow$  Non-Beverage Glass Containers (only accepted at Regina and Saskatoon SARCAN locations)

Items that are accepted or NOT accepted at the Transfer Station in Balgonie may be subject to change. Be sure to follow the current signage.

**IF YOU ARE MOVING** – You must **RETURN** the Transfer Station card back to the Town Office so we can provide it to the new home owners.


