

Introduction

The Water Security Agency and the Ministry of Environment requires that at least once each year waterworks owners provide notification to consumers of the quality of water produced and supplied as well as information on the performance of the waterworks in submitting samples as required by a Minister's Order or Permit to Operate a waterworks. The following is a summary of the Town of Balgonie's water quality and sample submission compliance record for the **June 2022 to June 2023** time period. This report was completed on **June 30, 2023**. Readers should refer to Water Security Agency's <u>Municipal Drinking Water Quality Monitoring Guidelines, June 2015, EPB 502</u> for more information on minimum sample submission requirements and the meaning of type of sample. Permit requirements for a specific waterworks may require more sampling than outlined in the department's monitoring guidelines. A minimum of 0.1 milligrams per litre (mg/L) free chlorine residual is required for water entering the distribution system. Tests are normally performed on a daily basis by the waterworks operator and are to be recorded in operation records. This data includes the number of free chlorine residual tests performed, the overall range of free chlorine residual (highest and lowest recorded values) and the number of tests and percentage of results not meeting the minimum requirement of 0.1 mg/L free chlorine residual.

Chemical - Health Category

All waterworks serving less than 5000 persons are required to submit water samples for SE's Chemical Health category once every 2 years. The Chemical Health category includes analysis for arsenic, barium, boron, cadmium, chromium, fluoride, lead, nitrate, selenium and uranium.







2022 Financial Overview for Waterworks and Wastewater

The following is information for the Town of Balgonie waterworks as required under *The Municipalities Regulations*.

- Total water and sewer revenues \$ 1,406,495
- > Total waterworks and sewer expenditures—\$1,471,485
- > Total debt repayment on waterworks and sewer infrastructure \$301,879
- Comparison of waterworks and sewer revenues to expenditures plus debt payments (expressed as a ratio)

For 2022 waterworks and sewer revenues covered **79%** percent of the waterworks and sewer expenditures.

- Amount transferred out of the utility reserve to cover the deficit \$288,750
- Amount of 2022 supplementary funding from general revenue required to cover expenditures \$78,119
- Reserves available for waterworks and wastewater capital infrastructure -\$159,189





2023 Tax Information & Reminders

Did you know?

- Tax notices are sent in June, but the total amount owing is for the entire calendar year.
- You may make monthly payments towards your outstanding balance rather than paying the total in one lump sum. Since taxes are not levied until June, a good way to determine the total amount to start paying in January is to take last year's total and divide it by 12. Once you receive your current year's notice, you can then adjust your monthly payments as necessary.
- Taxes are due, in full, by December 31st. If they remain unpaid, a 1.5% interest penalty will be applied to your account monthly until paid in full.
- Any tax amounts paid before August 31st will receive a 5% discount of the municipal portion.

There are a few different ways you can pay your 2023 taxes:

Online: Using your online banking service, use **Balgonie (Town of) Taxes**. If you are unsure of your account number, please contact the Town Office. A great option when using online is setting up monthly payments. This way you can pay smaller payments until the end of the year.

In Person: We accept debit, cheque or cash. Credit cards are not accepted in the office.

Credit Cards: Go to <u>www.townofbalgonie.ca</u> and pay with Plastiq on the bottom right hand side of the screen. Please note there are fees associated with this payment method.

- TRANSFER STATION -

The Transfer Station is electronically set up and monitored to provide our Town residents with accessibility day and night. The Town of Balgonie offers on site services at the Transfer Station, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not properly disposing of items set forth by the Ministry of Environment and the *Clean Air Act*.

The card holder will be held accountable for all occurrences at the Transfer Station whether they accessed the Transfer Station themselves or provided their card to another individual in their household. Lending the card out to another residence in Town or anyone else is definitely NOT PERMITTED.

Transfer Station cards are initially provided to the "New" home owner at no charge. However, if a card is lost; it must be reported to the Town Office immediately to be disabled. The card will be removed from the system and a new card, if requested, will be provided at a cost of \$40.00.

The red Loraas Disposal bin is currently delivered on the first (1st) and third (3rd) Friday of every month. There is no specific time as to when the bin will arrive on these days. IF A RED BIN IS UNAVAILABLE, DO NOT LEAVE ANY ITEMS WHERE THE BIN IS NORMALLY LOCATED. Individuals who leave items which are not permitted will be fined up to \$500.00, and will have their Transfer Station card suspended. Additional fines may be levied by the Ministry for individuals dumping illegally.

Be courteous of others! Although the bin may be available, large items and multiple loads take up the entirety of the bin, making it unusable for other residents. If you have multiple large items, please take them to the Regina Landfill.

Home builders/developers are NOT permitted to use the red Loraas Disposal bin and are required to rent their own waste container bins.

Items that may be left at the Transfer Station in their designated areas:

- ⇒ Scrap Metal
 - Propane tanks are accepted in the scrap metal pile
 - Please remove the Freon from fridges and freezers
- ⇒ Tree Branch/Grass/Leaf Piles
 - · Absolutely NO treated or painted wood
 - Grass and leaves must be UNBAGGED
- ⇒ Compostable Materials
 - Bags or boxes containing compostable materials are NOT to be left in the compost area
- ⇒ Oil Recycling Station
- ⇒ Cement

Items that may NOT be left at the Transfer Station or in the red Loraas Disposal bin:

⇒ Tires and Shingles

Items you are encouraged to recycle at SARCAN:

- ⇒ Beverage Containers, Batteries, Electronics, Household Paint and
- ⇒ Non-Beverage Glass Containers (only accepted at Regina and Saskatoon SARCAN locations)

Items that are accepted or NOT accepted at the Transfer Station in Balgonie may be subject to change. Be sure to follow the current signage.

IF YOU ARE MOVING – You must **RETURN** the Transfer Station card back to the Town Office so we can provide it to the new home owners.


