Waterworks Rate Policy

On July 24, 2023 Council motion required to adopt the current Waterworks Rate Policy.

Rates and Fees

Bylaw No. 428/2021

- Adopted by resolution of Council of the Town of Balgonie on November 22, 2021.
- Bylaw 428/2021 was in effect January 1, 2022 and approval was received on December 2, 2021 by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board, Local Government Committee.
- Under the waterworks rate policy resolution, the following schedule from the water and sewer bylaw set the water rates as follows:

- The Town of Balgonie purchases water from the Town of Pilot Butte Water Treatment Plant. The initial 2013 agreement was renegotiated in 2016.
 - The calculation for the purchase price of water from Pilot Butte is based on 2 components:
 - A constant capital cost of \$202,881 per year for 30 years based on the capital cost to provide water to Balgonie within the water treatment plant.
 - An operational consumption rate which is based on the yearly operational costs which are attributable to treated water provide for Balgonie. This fee is determined on an annual basis and calculated as a percentage of the total operational costs of the Pilot Butte water treatment plant. These costs include wages, utilities, maintenance and direct costs for water and waste water treatment for the Pilot Butte water treatment plant.
 - The Town of Balgonie enhanced the Pilot Butte Water Treatment Plant with the installation of 2 reverse osmosis units, membranes and pumps for a total cost of \$2,270,780. The agreement recognizes that the Town of Balgonie will be credited 2/3 of this capital cost contribution when the need arises for further capital upgrades directly related to the production of water for the Town of Balgonie.
- In December 2020, the Town of Balgonie installed a bulk water supply fill station at the Water Treatment Plant located at 205 Railway Street West. The consumers obtain a Key Fob and account in order to access the water provided in the station. The water is prepaid by the consumer at the rate listed in Schedule D of Bylaw 428/2021.
- The Town of Balgonie completed a water supply connection and agreement to sell water to the Village of Edenwold in November 2021. The Village is billed monthly for the water provided the month prior at the rate included in Schedule D of Bylaw 428/2021. As part of the Agreement, the Town and the Village have reviewed the utility consumption and changed the rates as per the calculation terms of the Agreement. As of July 1, 2023, the rate increased from 2.5657/m3 to 2.8764/m3.
- No current capital water projects are planned for the Town of Balgonie. The Town completed a capital water infrastructure project in 2015. A transmission line from Pilot Butte, a new water reservoir and reverse osmosis infrastructure were completed as part of the Building Canada Fund.
- An extensive review of the water and sewer rates in 2021 resulted in changes to the rate structures.
 - The base water and sewer rates were reduced.
 - The overage rates are scheduled to be increase over 3 years. The increases will eventually recoup the expenses for provision of the excess water.

- Infrastructure fees were increased to designate specific funds to be placed into reserves for the water and sewer capital infrastructure replacement and repairs.
- The changes to the rate structure over three years will move the utility from being subsidized by the General Levy to a fully funded model.
- Waterworks operating costs include staff salaries, benefits and training; power, gas and telephone; water purchase; insurance; chemicals; repairs; maintenance; supplies; etc.
- The rates for the Town of Balgonie from the Town of Pilot Butte have continued to rise to match inflationary operating costs. The Town of Balgonie will review the water rates and in 2023 to determine how to best adjust to the increased costs.

Objectives

- The Town of Balgonie will evaluate the water and sewer costs annually. Currently, the costs to provide this service will be higher than the revenues due to the debts incurred for the recent water project. The mill rate will be used to subsidize the water works until the planned increases to the utility bills can match the expenses.
- The infrastructure fees obtained from Schedule C of Bylaw 428/2021 will be placed into a utility reserve and used for future water and sewer capital infrastructure projects.
- > The Town of Balgonie will contribute additional funds towards future capital infrastructure.

Waterworks Capital Investment Strategy

- An extension of the waterline from the west of Highway 46 to Highway 364 was completed in 2022 to service new development. Future developers will pay additional fees to the Town of Balgonie for connecting to this service. The connection rates will be calculated by an engineer following the completion of the project.
- In 2024, the water pumps are due to be replaced in the Water Treatment Plant at a projected cost of \$40,000.
