Plastiq Payments



How to pay with **Plastiq**:

POWERED BY plastiq

1. Go to www.townofbalgonie.ca
2. Scroll down to the right hand side of the screen.
3. Sign up—create a free account, add who you are paying, and enter your card info.
4. Plastiq will process your payment and the funds will be transferred to the Town of Balgonie.

The fees associated with Plastiq are as follows:

- Standard credit card rate 2.9%
- Debit cards are discounted to 1%

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except on weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie bylaws.



Please do not park campers or trailers on the street! This causes difficulties for other drivers, blocks sight lines and can be dangerous for pedestrians and cyclists.

Town Council Meetings

Town Council meetings are held on the 2nd and 4th Monday of each month (if the date falls on a stat or a day off in lieu, it is moved to the day afterwards).

Meetings are open to the public and requests to address Council as a delegation may be made in writing to the Town Administrator (townofbalgonie@sasktel.net). The meetings start at 6:15 p.m. and are held in Council Chambers at D-129 Railway Street East.

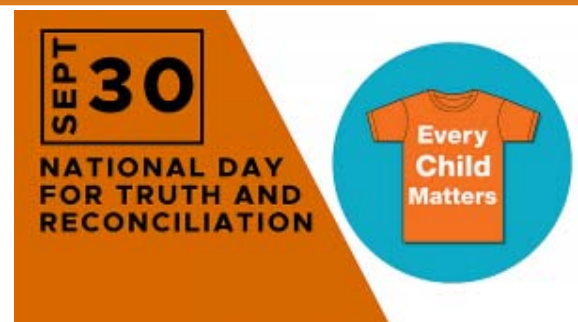
The Balgonie arena will be in full swing September 1st, 2023. The curling rink will be open near the third week of October.

September 30th - National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

This day honours the victims who never made it home and celebrates the survivors of residential schools, their families and communities. It is a day to commemorate the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools. A day to take part in services or ceremonies and to educate yourself on the history of residential schools.

The Town of Balgonie Council passed a resolution at their August 8th, 2022 Council Meeting to close the office to honour the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

The Town Office will be closed on Friday, September 29th in lieu. Should you require emergency assistance please contact this number 306-535-4235. Our regular office hours will resume on Monday, October 2nd.



You may have noticed there have been numerous trees removed around town. This is due to Dutch Elm Disease. To help prevent Dutch Elm Disease:

- Keep your elm trees healthy;
- Abide by the Provincial ban on pruning elm trees from April 1st to August 31st;
- If you see signs of the disease, report them to the Town Office;
- Don't buy, sell, store, transport or use elm firewood; and
- Remove and dispose of disease-infected trees promptly and properly.



It's illegal to transport, store or buy elm firewood. Firewood is one of the largest spreaders of Dutch Elm Disease; elm bark beetles on infected firewood hitch a free ride with unsuspecting campers and homeowners, spreading the disease.

- Don't transport firewood when camping;
- Avoid elm when cutting or buying firewood; and
- Don't store pruned elm wood to burn in a fireplace later.

If you have elm wood that needs disposing of, please take it to the Transfer Station and place it in the tree pile.

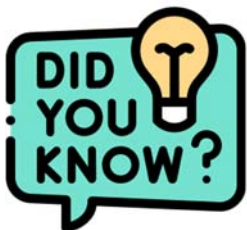

Back to School!

Kids are back to school on Tuesday, September 5th. This means our community and school zones will be busier. Please slow down to 30 km/hour, as indicated by the School Zone signs, and watch for kids crossing.



School Bus Safety

School bus drivers have a difficult job. There are plenty of distractions inside the bus. Knowing this, you should make extra allowances, and be aware of the possibility that the bus driver may not see you or your signals. Rear-end collisions are the most frequent type of crash involving school buses and are usually caused by another driver failing to stop while the bus is loading or unloading passengers.

When approaching a school bus, **if you see amber flashing lights, slow down and proceed with caution. If the red flashing lights are activated, you must come to a complete stop.** If you're approaching the bus from the opposite direction on an undivided highway, you must also stop. The single greatest threat to the safety of children who ride school buses is motorists who pass the bus when children are loading and unloading.

When approaching a bus that has its stop arm out and its red flashing lights activated, as a driver:

- You must stop no closer than 5 m (15 ft) from the front or back of the bus.
- You must not advance your vehicle until the bus driver turns off the flashing red stop lamps and deactivates the stop arm.
- Before moving, check to see that all children have safely crossed the roadway.

Passing a school bus with red flashing lights is a serious offence and will result in a minimum fine of \$360.



The Town of Balgonie will be holding a By-Election for Mayor on October 25, 2023. The successful candidate will complete the remainder of the term of the vacancy in the Office of Mayor until the next General Municipal Election to be held on November 13, 2024.

The local government makes decisions regarding local matters and services that the Town provides. The Town Council sets the budget for services such as administration, protective services, public works, development, environment, recreation, water and sewer, etc.

Candidate information packages are now available at the Town Office and on the Town's website. Nomination forms will need to be submitted no later than 4:00 p.m. on September 20, 2023.

You may run for the Office of Municipal Council if:

- You attain the full age of 18 years on or before Election Day;
- At the time you submit your nomination papers, you are a Canadian Citizen and have resided in Balgonie for at least three consecutive months immediately preceding the date on which nomination papers are submitted and are in Saskatchewan for at least six months immediately preceding the date on which nomination papers are submitted; and
- Are not disqualified by *The Local Government Election Act, 2015* or any other Act from holding the office for which you are a candidate.

You may not run for the office of Municipal Council if:

- You are a Judge of any Court;
- You are an Auditor or Solicitor of the Municipality.

If you or anyone you know is eligible to run for Town Council, please contact our staff at 306-771-2284 to obtain a candidate's package which obtains information about the role.

Mail-in Voting:

Bylaw 452/2023 permits residents to mail in their ballots. Anyone who is eligible to vote in the Town of Balgonie's Municipal Election may register to vote by mail in ballot. Form R and Form C are to be completed and sent to the Returning Officer at the Town of Balgonie Office (D-129 Railway Street East) prior to 4:00 p.m. on October 6, 2023. Eligible Voters in the Town of Balgonie are able to choose to register to vote in this manner. Mail-in Ballot kits will be provided prior to Election Day.

Mail-in Voting:

Town Council has passed a Bylaw which will permit residents to mail in their ballots for the 2023 By-Election. Eligible voters will have the option to register to vote by Mail-in Ballot rather than vote in person at the Advance Polls or Election Day Polls.

If you are eligible to vote in the Municipal Election and wish to vote by this method, you may fill out *Form 'R' and Form 'C'*, and return it to the Returning Officer at the Town of Balgonie at 129 Railway Street prior to October 6, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.

The forms may also be returned by e-mail to townofbalgonie@sasktel.net or faxed to 306-771-2899.

Forms are available on the Town of Balgonie website, newsletter and are also available to voters at the Town Office.

Voters who register to vote by Mail-in Ballot will not be eligible to vote at the Election Day Poll or the Advance Poll. Mail-in Ballot kits will be provided to the registered voters prior to Election Day.

Instructions for Witnesses for Mail-In Voter Registration and Declaration

As the person who witnesses the voter's signature on the Voter's Registration and Declaration of Person Requesting Mail-in Ballot Form, you will need to review the applicant's identification and confirm that you are satisfied that the voter's identity has been established.

The voter applying for the mail-in ballot should produce:

- One piece of identification issued by the Government of Canada, the Government of Saskatchewan, a municipality or a government agency that contains a photograph of the applicant, the applicant's name and address and the applicant's signature; or
- One piece of identification issued by the Government of Canada, the Government of Saskatchewan, a municipality or a government agency that contains a photograph of the applicant voter and the applicant's name and signature, and a second piece of identification prescribed in the Regulations that contains the applicant's name and address.

As the Witness, you will need to provide your signature, first and last name, phone number and/or email address. Witnesses shall be 18 years of age or older.

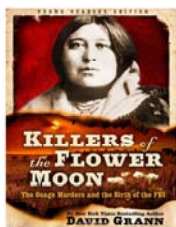

INTENT:

The proposed bylaw will:

- Rezone the lane in Block 38, Plan 01RA26200 from R1-Residential District to CS-Community Service District. The land to be rezoned is identified as Lane No. 1 on the following map.
- Rezone the lane in Block 39, Plan 01RA26200 from R1-residential District to R2-Residential Multiple Dwelling District. The land to be rezoned is identified as Lane No. 2 on the following map.
- Add site development regulations for single-detached dwellings in the R2-Residential Multiple Dwelling District.



REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT:

The bylaw amendment will accommodate two proposed subdivisions. The subdivision of Block 38 will increase the site area for the existing fire hall. Block 39 will be subdivided into residential lots.

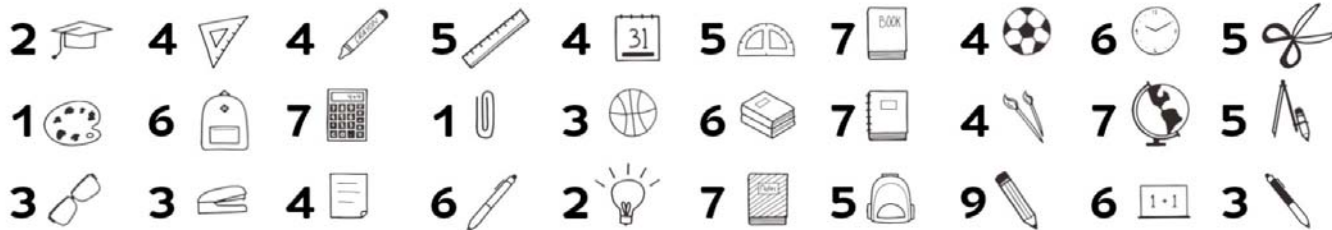

– TRANSFER STATION –

The Transfer Station is electronically set up and monitored to provide our Town residents with accessibility day and night. The Town of Balgonie offers on site services at the Transfer Station, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not properly disposing of items set forth by the Ministry of Environment and the *Clean Air Act*.

The card holder will be held accountable for all occurrences at the Transfer Station whether they accessed the Transfer Station themselves or provided their card to another individual in their household. Lending the card out to another residence in Town or anyone else is definitely NOT PERMITTED.

Transfer Station cards are initially provided to the “New” home owner at no charge. However, if a card is lost; it must be reported to the Town Office immediately to be disabled. The card will be removed from the system and a new card, if requested, will be provided at a cost of \$40.00.

The red Loraas Disposal bin is currently delivered on the first (1st) and third (3rd) Friday of every month. There is no specific time as to when the bin will arrive on these days. IF A RED BIN IS UNAVAILABLE, DO NOT LEAVE ANY ITEMS WHERE THE BIN IS NORMALLY LOCATED. Individuals who leave items which are not permitted will be fined up to \$500.00, and will have their Transfer Station card suspended. Additional fines may be levied by the Ministry for individuals dumping illegally.

Be courteous of others! Although the bin may be available, large items and multiple loads take up the entirety of the bin, making it unusable for other residents. If you have multiple large items, please take them to the Regina Landfill.

Home builders/developers are NOT permitted to use the red Loraas Disposal bin and are required to rent their own waste container bins.

Items that may be left at the Transfer Station in their designated areas:

- Scrap Metal
 - Propane tanks are accepted in the scrap metal pile
 - Please remove the Freon from fridges and freezers
- Tree Branch/Grass/Leaf Piles
 - Absolutely NO treated or painted wood
 - Grass and leaves must be UNBAGGED
- Compostable Materials
 - Bags or boxes containing compostable materials are NOT to be left in the compost area
- Oil Recycling Station
- Cement

Items that may NOT be left at the Transfer Station or in the red Loraas Disposal bin:

- Tires and Shingles

Items you are encouraged to recycle at SARCAN:

- Beverage Containers, Batteries, Electronics, Household Paint and
- Non-Beverage Glass Containers (only accepted at Regina and Saskatoon SARCAN locations)

Items that are accepted or NOT accepted at the Transfer Station in Balgonie may be subject to change. Be sure to follow the current signage.

IF YOU ARE MOVING – You must **RETURN** the Transfer Station card back to the Town Office so we can provide it to the new home owners.
