### Statement from the Town of Balgonie

Town Councillor Kelvin Solie submitted his resignation from Council on February 29, 2024. This will be formally recorded at the March 11, 2024, meeting of Council.

Councillor Solie has been a valuable member of Town Council during his terms of office from 2012-2016, 2016-2020 and 2020-2024. In each election, Kelvin Solie received a majority of the councillor-at-large votes.

His positive approach and good-hearted nature have made him a great advocate for the ratepayers and ambassador for the Town of Balgonie. As a Council member, Kelvin has demonstrated his commitment to the Town of Balgonie in preparing for meetings, asking questions, and offering practical solutions to meet the needs of the community.

He has served most recently as the Town's Deputy Mayor and has served on the following committees: Finance; Protective Services; Equipment, Maintenance and Engineering; Public Works & Utilities; and, Planning and Development.

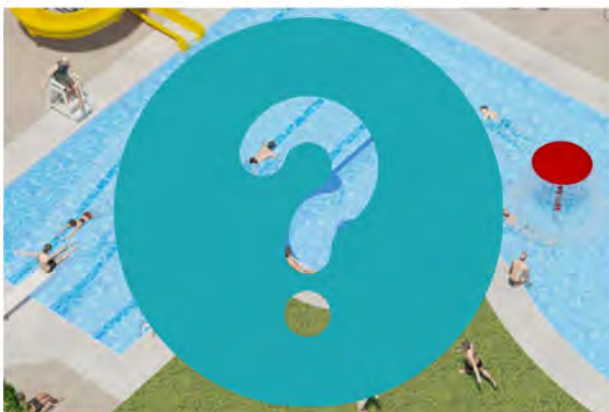

## Community Safety Reminders

We can help with local law enforcement! Report any and all suspicious activity, break-ins and erratic driving to the RCMP by phone or fill out an incident report form. Reporting these incidents to the RCMP helps track where the RCMP need to have their staff monitoring. To report incidents:

- Call the White Butte Detachment at 306-781-5050 with complaints regarding driving infractions and illegal activity with as much information as possible.
- If an incident involves a student's behaviour during the school day, the report should also be made to Greenall High School at 306-771-2566.

## How to be a Responsible Pet Owner in 4 Easy Steps!

**Step 2.** Pick up after your pet. There are multiple garbage cans located throughout the town for you to use.

**Step 3.** Spay/Neuter your pet.

**Step 4.** License your pet at the Town Office.

## Elm Tree Pruning Ban - Effective April 1



The annual ban on pruning elm trees in Saskatchewan begins April 1. The ban helps slow down the spread of Dutch Elm Disease (DED). DED is a fungus spread by elm bark beetles. The beetles are attracted to fresh cuts on elm trees. Pruning your trees before the ban keeps them healthy and better to resist all kinds of diseases.

If you see an elm tree showing signs of DED (wilting, yellowing leaves on one or several branches near the top, usually in late June), please call the Town Office.

**Remember:** It is illegal to use, transport, store or sell elm wood.

## 2024 Tax Information & Reminders

### Did you know?

- Tax notices are sent in June, but the total amount owing is for the entire calendar year.
- You may make monthly payments toward your outstanding balance rather than paying the total in one lump sum. Since taxes are not levied until June, a good way to determine the total amount to start paying in January is to take last year's total and divide it by 12. Once you receive your current year's notice, you can then adjust your monthly payments as necessary.
- Taxes are due, in full, by December 31st. If they remain unpaid, a 1.5% interest penalty will be applied to your account monthly until paid in full.
- Any tax amounts paid before August 31st will receive a 5% discount on the municipal portion.

## Plastiq Payments



How to pay with Plastiq:

1. Go to [www.townofbalgonie.ca](http://www.townofbalgonie.ca)
2. Scroll down to the right hand side of the screen.
3. Sign up - create a free account, add who you are paying, and enter your card info.
4. Plastiq will process your payment and the funds will be transferred to the Town of Balgonie.

Fees associated with Plastiq are as follows:

- Standard credit card rate of 2.9%
- Debit cards are discounted to 1%

## ATV Reminder

Vehicles that fall under the definition of All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) are not allowed on any street within town limits, except for the purpose of crossing to get to the closest point of exit.

Stunting and driving on walking paths is not permitted, as it is a major safety concern for those who are walking or biking on the path. Please keep our community safe by following ATV legislation.

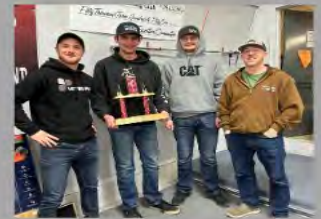

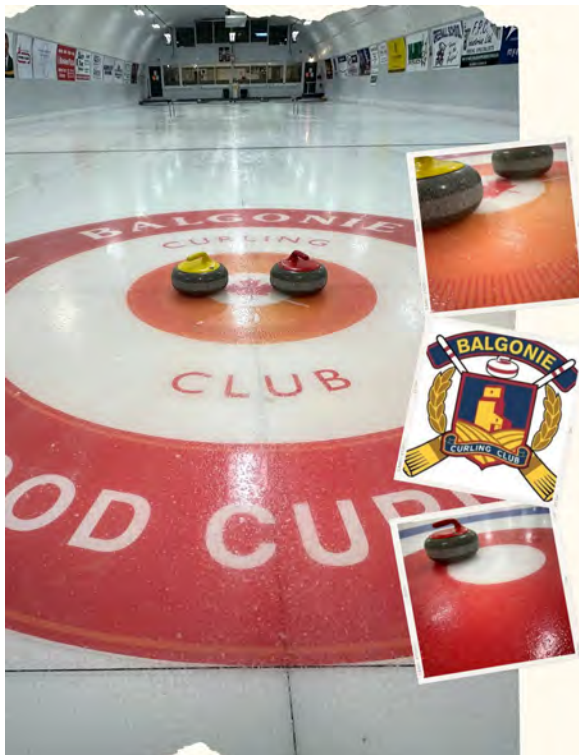

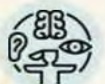

**PLEASE NOTE:** Children must be 5 years old by December 31, 2024 in order to be eligible for Kindergarten start-up in the fall of 2024.

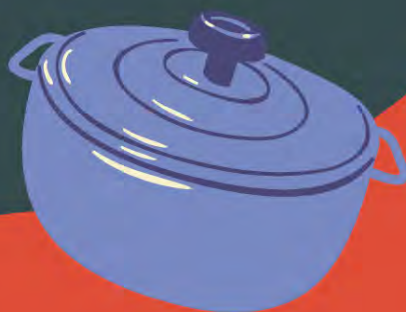

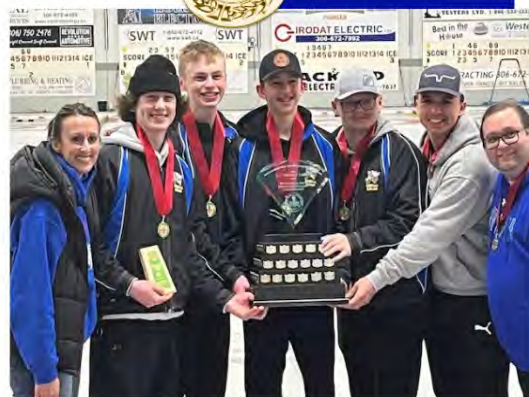

# Building Permits Required

Always apply for a Building Permit before proceeding with a building project. **Here is why:**

The Construction Codes Act outlines the **responsibilities** of the building owners, municipalities, building officials and construction industry regarding construction standards in Saskatchewan.

Applying for a Building Permit initiates a **Plan Review**, assessing your design against the requirements under The Construction Codes Act.

This can result in significant **time and money savings** for the building owner, compared to having to go back and make changes after construction has started.

If your project is **exempt** from requiring a Building Permit, it will be determined during the review process.

## How to apply for a permit:

First, apply for a Development permit from the **Town of Balgonie**.

After that is approved, apply for a Building Permit from the **Town of Balgonie**.

The **Town of Balgonie** collects permit fee and issues the Building Permit and Plan Review.

Call your building official for inspections as outlined in Permit's Plan Review.

## Is a Building Permit Required?

### Permits are required for:

- New construction
- Garages, carports, and boat houses
- Decks and platforms more than 300 mm (12") above ground level
- RTM, modular and manufactured homes
- Renovations and alterations affecting structural members or safety features (e.g. bedroom windows)
- Additions to existing buildings
- Basement development
- Secondary suites
- Accessory buildings greater than 10 m<sup>2</sup>
- Fireplaces, wood stoves and heaters
- Retaining walls that could affect a structure or are near a property
- Foundation repairs or replacements
- Roof replacements
- Solar panels that are roof mount
- Change to the use of the building
- Temporary buildings or structures
- Relocating an existing building
- Remedying an unsafe condition or fire inspection order
- Demolishing a building

### Permits not typically required for:

- Fences
- Driveways, sidewalks, and parking lots
- Replacement of materials like shingles or siding, or cosmetic upgrades not affecting structural members or safety features
- Accessory buildings less than 10 m<sup>2</sup> (e.g. garden sheds or tool sheds); but maximum of one per lot.

**Please check your local building bylaws, and if in doubt, contact **PBI**.**

## Building Permits

According to the Construction Codes Act, the **owner** is responsible to ensure their building is designed and constructed to standard.

To save **time and money**, apply for a Building Permit before starting. It initiates a Plan Review, to assess your design against the standards. If your project is exempt for requiring a Permit, it will be determined at that time.

### Process:

1. Apply for Development Permit from municipality.
2. If approved, apply for Building Permit from municipality.
3. PBI conducts the Plan Review.
4. If approved, municipality issues a Building Permit.
5. Owner requests inspections at the steps outlined in the Plan Review.

## **– TRANSFER STATION –**

### **General Rules:**

The Transfer Station is electronically set up and monitored to provide our Town residents with accessibility day and night. The Town of Balgonie offers on site services at the Transfer Station, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not properly disposing of items set forth by the Ministry of Environment and the *Clean Air Act*.

The card holder will be held accountable for all occurrences at the Transfer Station whether they accessed the Transfer Station themselves or provided their card to another individual. Lending the card out to anyone else is **not permitted**.

Transfer Station cards are initially provided to the “New” home owner at no charge. If a card is lost, it must be reported to the Town Office immediately to be disconnected. The card will be removed from the system and a new card, if requested, will be provided at a cost of \$40.00.

The red Loraas Disposal bin is currently delivered on the first (1st) and third (3rd) Friday of every month. There is no specific time as to when the bin will arrive on these days. IF A RED BIN IS UNAVAILABLE, DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS WHERE THE BIN IS NORMALLY PLACED. Individuals who leave items when the bin is unavailable/full and/or individuals who leave items that are not permitted will be fined up to \$500.00, and will have their Transfer Station card suspended. Additional fines may be levied by the Ministry for individuals dumping illegally.

Be courteous of others! Although the bin may be available, large items and multiple loads take up the entirety of the bin, making it unusable for other residents. If you have multiple large items, please take them to the Regina Landfill.

Home builders/developers are **not** permitted to use the red Loraas Disposal bin and are required to rent their own waste container bins.

**If you are moving, please return the Transfer Station card to the Town Office.**
