Utility Bills Due

Utility bills that were sent out in July are due on August 12th. A reminder that utility bills are due, in full, 30 days after the notice is sent out. If they remain unpaid, a 2% interest penalty will be applied to your account monthly until paid in full.

Plastiq Payments

How to pay with Plastiq:

- 4. Plastiq will process your payment and the funds will be transferred to the Town of Balgonie.

Fees associated with Plastiq are as follows:

2024 Pet Tags

2024 pet tags are available for purchase at the Town Office. Please ensure to register your dog(s) with the Town Office. Pet licenses are required under Bylaw No. 377/2014. Purchasing a license helps ensure your pet is returned safely if it is lost or found running loose. Licenses need to be renewed each calendar year.

License Fees:

Female dog S20.00 Spayed female S10.00 Male dog S10.00

Street Parking - Reminder

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except on weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair.



Please do not park trailers or campers on the street - this causes difficulties for other drivers, blocks sight lines and can be dangerous for pedestrians and cyclists.

ATV Reminder

Vehicles that fall under the definition of All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) are not allowed on any street within town limits, except for the purpose of crossing to get to the closest point of exit.

Stunting and driving on walking paths is not permitted, as it is a major safety concern for those who

Make it look like someone is home - it is important for your home to look occupied even if you are not home. Leave a light on or get timers for your lights.

Report any and all suspicious activity, break-ins and erratic driving to the RCMP. Reporting these incidents lets the RCMP know where they need to have their staff monitoring. To report incidents:



The Town of Balgonie has a Fire Pit Bylaw in place (Bylaw No. 294/2003). Below are some highlights:

- No burning barrels or outdoor burning devices with the exception of propane or briquet BBQ's, chemineas or approved fire pits can be used within Town limits.
- No other fuel other than seasoned wood, propane or natural gas may be burned.
- Fire pits should be covered with a wire mesh.
- Fire pits should be at least 3 meters from any property line, building or other combustible structure and 6 meters from any neighboring building.
- Fire pits should not be used on balconies, wooden decks or any combustible surface.

Remember to always practice responsible fire safety and be a good neighbour!

2023 Financial Overview for Waterworks and Wastewater

The following is information for the Town of Balgonie waterworks as required under *The Municipalities Regulations*.

Introduction

The Water Security Agency and the Ministry of Environment requires that at least once each year waterworks owners provide notification to consumers of the quality of water produced and supplied as well as information on the performance of the waterworks in submitting samples as required by a Minister's Order or Permit to Operate a waterworks. The following is a summary of the Town of Balgonie's water quality and sample submission compliance record for the **June 2023 to May 2024** time period. This report was completed on **May 10, 2024**. Readers should refer to Water Security Agency's <u>Municipal Drinking Water Quality Monitoring Guidelines, June 2015, EPB 502</u> for more information on minimum sample submission requirements and the meaning of type of sample. Permit requirements for a specific waterworks may require more sampling than outlined in the department's monitoring guidelines. A minimum of 0.1 milligrams per litre (mg/L) free chlorine residual is required for water entering the distribution system. Tests are normally performed on a daily basis by the waterworks operator and are to be recorded in operation records. This data includes the number of free chlorine residual tests performed, the overall range of free chlorine residual (highest and lowest recorded values) and the number of tests and percentage of results not meeting the minimum requirement of 0.1 mg/L free chlorine residual.

All waterworks serving less than 5000 persons are required to submit water samples for SE's Chemical Health category once every 2 years. The Chemical Health category includes analysis for arsenic, barium, boron, cadmium, chromium, fluoride, lead, nitrate, selenium and uranium.



Interested in running as a member of Council? It is a great opportunity to help shape the future of our Town! Elected Officials serve a 4 year term. Time commitments of the term include:

You may run for Council if:

- You are 18 years of age on or before Election Day
- At the time you submit your nomination papers, you are a Canadian Citizen and have resided in Balgonie for at least 3 consecutive months immediately proceeding the date of your nomination papers and are in Saskatchewan for at least 6 months immediately proceeding the date the nomination papers are submitted.
- Are not disqualified by The Local Government Election Act, 2015 or any other Act from holding the office for which you are the candidate.

You may not run for Council if:

- You are a Judge of any Court;
- You are an Auditor or Solicitor of the Municipality.



Security cameras will be installed in the near future to help deter theft and vandalism.

WIRELESS WATER FILL STATION

The Town of Balgonie has a Wireless Water Fill Station that was installed in 2021. It is located on the corner of Railway Street and King Street in Balgonie.

What do you need? A prepaid fob (which can be set up at the Town Office) and a 2" female cam lock is required on your hose to connect to the Water Fill Station.

How does it work? The Town of Balgonie has set up a prepaid fob system with Text2Car/ConX Wireless. This system will only work with a prepaid fob and/or a prepaid online account, which the Town of Balgonie can provide for you.

Once you have your online account set up, you can:

- -Start and stop the pump with your FOB,
- -Make a payment via credit card to increase your prepaid account balance, and
- -View transaction reports

How to set up an account: The Town requires the following information to set up an account for you:

- -Name
- -Email Address
- -Cell Phone Number
- -Mailing Address

Did You Know?

The Town of Balgonie will provide official Charitable Receipts for personal donations made towards the new swimming pool!

Charitable donations tax deductions are what are known as non-refundable tax credits, which means the refund goes towards helping you lower your tax payable.

Saskatchewan's charitable donation tax deduction rates are 25.5% for donations in the amount of \$200 or less and 43.5% for donations over \$200.



For example, if you donated \$500 in total in this past calendar year, your first \$200 would be eligible for a 25.5% refund (\$200 x 25.5% = \$51), and your remaining \$300 would be eligible for a 43.5% refund (\$300 x 43.5% = \$130.50) for a total of \$181.50.

Tax receipts will be issued for donations over \$20



- TRANSFER STATION -

General Rules:

The Transfer Station is electronically set up and monitored to provide our Town residents with accessibility day and night. The Town of Balgonie offers on site services at the Transfer Station, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not properly disposing of items set forth by the Ministry of Environment and the *Clean Air Act*.

The card holder will be held accountable for all occurrences at the Transfer Station whether they accessed the Transfer Station themselves or provided their card to another individual. Lending the card out to anyone else is **not permitted**.

Transfer Station cards are initially provided to the "New" home owner at no charge. If a card is lost, it must be reported to the Town Office immediately to be disconnected. The card will be removed from the system and a new card, if requested, will be provided at a cost of \$40.00.

The red Loraas Disposal bin is currently delivered on the first (1st) and third (3rd) Friday of every month. There is no specific time as to when the bin will arrive on these days. IF A RED BIN IS UNAVAILABLE, DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS WHERE THE BIN IS NORMALLY PLACED. Individuals who leave items when the bin is unavailable/full and/or individuals who leave items that are not permitted will be fined up to \$500.00, and will have their Transfer Station card suspended. Additional fines may be levied by the Ministry for individuals dumping illegally.

Be courteous of others! Although the bin may be available, large items and multiple loads take up the entirety of the bin, making it unusable for other residents. If you have multiple large items, please take them to the Regina Landfill.

Home builders/developers are **not** permitted to use the red Loraas Disposal bin and are required to rent their own waste container bins.

If you are moving, please return the Transfer Station card to the Town Office.


