July Utility Bills

Utility notices will be mailed and uploaded to the Customer Portal the first week of July. For those that receive utility notices by e-notice (e-mail), please log into your Customer Portal account to view your utility notice.

Payments can be made through your online banking, in the office (cash, debit or cheque), or on the Town's website using Plastiq.

Plastiq Payments

How to pay with Plastiq:

1. Go to www.townofbalgonie.ca
2. Scroll down to the right hand side of the screen.
3. Sign up - create a free account, add who you are paying, and enter your card info.
4. Plastiq will process your payment and the funds will be transferred to the Town of Balgonie.

Fees associated with Plastiq are as follows:

- Standard credit card rate of 2.9%
- Debit cards are discounted to 1%

Paying Tax & Utility Bills Online

Utility and tax bills may be paid through your online banking service. Please use **Balgonie (Town of) Taxes** for your taxes and **Balgonie (Town of) Utilities** for your water/sewer bills. If you are unsure of your account number, please contact the Town Office to obtain your account number.

When making an online payment, allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is receipted prior to any penalties being applied to your account.



Sewer & Drain Tips

Here are some tips to keep your sewers and drains unclogged from costly sewer backups and pricey home repairs:

- Fats, oils and grease from cooking should be poured into a disposable cup to be discarded in the trash after it's cooled.
- Avoid flushing "flushable" wipes, baby wipes, feminine products, dental floss, cotton balls, paper towels and candle wax down the toilet.



A backed-up sewer system or clogged drain can be costly to repair. Inappropriate disposal of grease and other items may also cause damage to the municipal sewer system.

Reminder that the Town of Balgonie will NOT reimburse residents for sewer blockages which are blocked by anything other than tree roots, whether or not the blockage is on your property or town property. Items blocking the lines which will not be covered by reimbursement include sanitary products, grease, or other foreign objects in the lateral lines.

Please let the Town know when you have the sewer company scheduled at your home, as our maintenance personnel must be there to determine the problem. Please call 306-771-4343 or 306-771-2284.

Street Parking - Reminder

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except on weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie bylaws.

Please do not park trailers on the street - this causes difficulties for other drivers, blocks sight lines and can be dangerous for pedestrians and cyclists.

Loraas Disposal Bin at the Transfer Station

The red Loraas bin at the Transfer Station is delivered on the first and third Friday of every month. There is no specific time as to when the bin will arrive on these days.

If a red bin is NOT available or is full, do NOT leave any items where the bin is normally located or add more to it. Residents have been fined (up to \$500) and their cards have been suspended.

Be courteous of others! Large items and multiple loads take up the entirety of the bin, making it unusable for other residents. If you have multiple large items, please take them to the Regina Landfill.

Home builders/developers are not permitted to use the red Loraas bin.

Reminder to Pet Owners

To be a responsible pet owner, remember to:

1. Walk your pet on a leash.

2. If your pet is aggressive, walk on the other side of the street away from people.



1. Pick up after your pet. There are multiple garbage cans located throughout the town for you to use.

2. Spay/neuter your pet.

3. License your pet at the Town Office. Fines are \$40 if a dog is found "at large".

FIREPIT SAFETY

Town of
Balgonie

The Town of Balgonie has a Fire Pit Bylaw in place (Bylaw No. 294/2003). Below are some highlights:

- No burning barrels or outdoor burning devices with the exception of propane or briquet BBQ's, chemineas or approved fire pits can be used within Town limits.
- No other fuel other than seasoned wood, propane or natural gas may be burned.
- Fire pits should be covered with a wire mesh.
- Fire pits should be at least 3 meters from any property line, building or other combustible structure and 6 meters from any neighboring building.
- Fire pits should not be used on balconies, wooden decks or any combustible surface.

Remember to confirm there is no fire ban (check Voyent Alert or www.saskpublicsafety.ca).

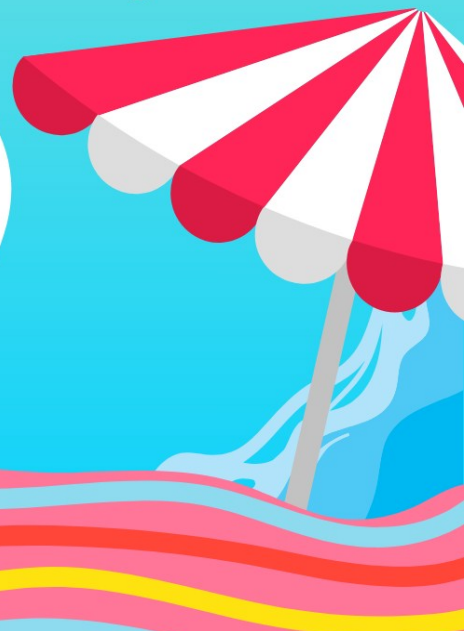

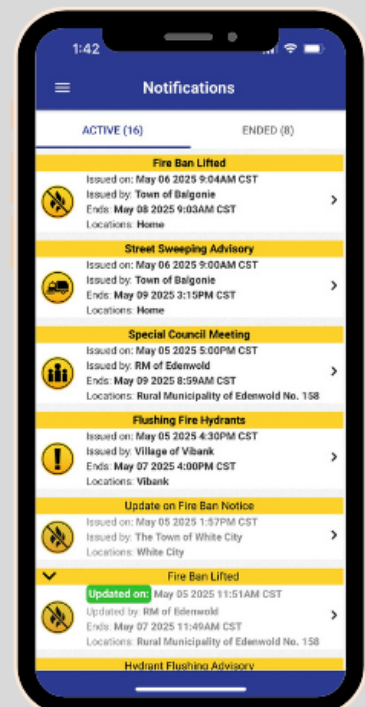

2025 Tax Notices are now available!

2025 Tax Notices have been uploaded to the Customer Portal and mailed out. If you have not received your notice, please contact the Town Office.

A few reminders:

- The total amount owing is for the entire calendar year.
- Any tax amounts paid before August 31st will receive a 5% discount on the municipal portion (indicated on the bottom of the tax notice).
- Current taxes are due, in full, by December 31st.
- The tax notice will show any arrears owing from prior years. It is important to contact the Town Office to discuss payment arrangements.
- The tax notice will show any pre-paid amounts.

Payment options:

Online - Through your on-line banking service, use **Balgonie (Town of) Taxes**. If you are unsure of your account number, contact the Town Office.

In Person - We accept debit, cheque or cash. We do not accept credit cards in the office.

Credit Cards - Go to www.townofbalgonie.ca and pay with PlastiQ. There are fees associated with this payment method.






VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT KRISTIN FROMBACH



What group(s) do you currently volunteer with?

I currently volunteer with the Balgonie Pool Board (BPB) and the Prairie Storm Minor Hockey Association (PSMHA) Board of Directors. In the past, I've also volunteered with the Alzheimer Society Gala Committee and the BELCI Fundraising Committee.

What attracted you to these groups?

I've always had a strong desire to give back to our community. I choose to volunteer with groups that hold personal meaning for our family and allow me to support local children and families by helping provide amenities close to home. I grew up in a small-town pool environment and had my first job as a lifeguard, so I know how valuable these facilities are - not just for recreation, but for offering local summer employment for youth. Our kids love being at the pool when we're not at the lake, and they've both been involved in hockey since they were three years old.

How long have you been volunteering?

I'm finishing my fourth year with the BPB and entering my third year with the PSMHA. I volunteered with the Alzheimer Society for six years and was involved with BELCI for five years.

What do you enjoy most about your volunteer work?

I love being able to help improve our community. One of the biggest rewards is meeting other amazing people who share the same passion and drive to make a difference.

What motivates you to stay involved?

It's the generosity of our community and the tangible impact we get to see. There's a real sense of accomplishment in knowing that all the behind-the-scenes work volunteers do is making a difference. Seeing positive outcomes in our community keeps me motivated and inspired.

What are some of your best moments in your capacity as a volunteer?

One standout moment was when our small BPB committee raised over \$25,000 through just two events! That kind of success wouldn't have been possible without the amazing women in our community and the support of local sponsors. The funds helped us purchase new equipment for the pool, including a storage shed, seating, umbrellas for shade, toys for kids of all ages, aqua-size gear, and more.

Another highlight was in 2018, when I was invited to share my mother's story at the Alzheimer Society Gala, where we raised \$250,000. That same year, I was incredibly honored to receive the "Outstanding Individual Volunteer" award from the Association of Fundraising Professionals for my contributions.

How do you inspire others to give of themselves?

I truly believe it takes a village, and that village only thrives when people step up and get involved. I try to communicate the benefits of volunteering and encourage others to find ways they can contribute - no matter how big or small. There's always a need, and there's always a way to help.

DID YOU KNOW?

The Transfer Station is set up with an electronic card system which allows residents to access it 24/7.

On the 1st and 3rd Friday of each month, Loraas Disposal delivers a 40-yard bin to the Transfer Station. The purpose of the 40-yard bin is to allow residents to dispose of additional household waste that does not fit in their black roll-out bin.

Unaccepted items

- Shingles;
- Railway ties, telephone poles and creosote treated wood;
- Bulbs and Light Ballasts;
- Hazardous materials such as tires, propane tanks, car batteries, paint, oil and chemicals;
- Appliances containing Freon;
- Construction/renovation material;
- Waste from households outside of Balgonie.

Please note: the unaccepted items listed above pertain to the 40-yard bin only. There are designated areas at the transfer station where some items listed above are accepted.

Who can use your transfer station card?

- Members of your household can use it.
- Lending your card out to another person and/or disposing of waste from households outside of Balgonie is not permitted.
- The cardholder will be held accountable for all occurrences at the transfer station, such as illegal dumping.

Illegal dumping

The Town of Balgonie has the responsibility to ensure regulations are followed based on the Approval to Operate issued to the Town by the Ministry of Environment.

Public Works Staff inspect the Transfer Station every morning. If it is determined that an illegal dump has taken place and/or items are placed in the incorrect disposal area, an investigation will commence. The resident at fault will be fined and their access card will be suspended for up to 6 months.

Disposing of large items

When residents dispose of large items such as couches, mattresses, and box springs in the 40-yard bin:

- it limits another resident's ability to dispose of their items in the bin;
- the bin is removed from the Transfer Station quicker, creating a longer waiting period for when it is scheduled to return.

In addition to the inconvenience it causes others by placing large items in the bin, the Town of Balgonie is required to pay a burial surcharge to Loraas Disposal if there are more than 4 pieces of bedding per load (mattresses and box springs), wood or metal longer than 7' or coils of wire or banding.

Designated disposal areas

Cement Pile

- Cement free of other debris may be disposed of.

Metal Pile

- All appliances and metal are permitted. Ensure the Freon is removed from fridges/freezers.
- Propane tanks are permitted.

Grass/Leaves

- Bags and boxes are not permitted in this pile.

Trees, Branches and Untreated Wood Pile

- Treated wood, painted wood, cardboard, drywall etc. are not permitted in this pile.

Oil Recycling Centre

- Empty oil into the oil recycling bin.
- Place the oil containers and filters in the bin next to the oil recycling bin.

Diabetes Canada Clothing Bin

- Do not leave bags beside the bin if it is full.

What should I recycle at SARCAN?

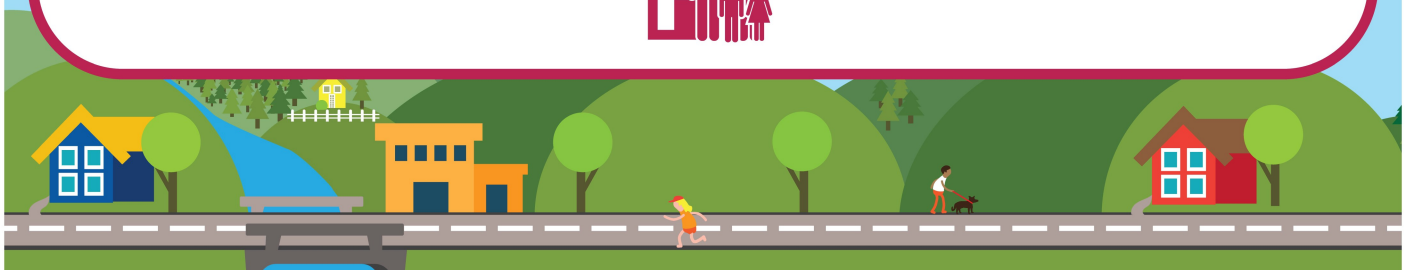
