## Utility Bills Reminder



Utility bills that were sent out in April are due May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026. If you did not receive your bill, please call the Town Office. A reminder that utility bills are due, in full, 30 days after the notice is sent out. Payments can be made through your online banking, in the office (cash, debit or cheque), or on the Town's website using PlastiQ.

## PlastiQ Payments

How to pay with PlastiQ:

1. Go to [www.townofbalgonie.ca](http://www.townofbalgonie.ca)
2. Scroll down to the right side of the screen.
3. Sign up - create a free account, add who you are paying, and enter your card info.
4. PlastiQ will process your payment and the funds will be transferred to the Town of Balgonie.

Fees associated with PlastiQ are as follows:

- Standard credit card rate of 2.9%
- Debit cards are discounted to 1%

## Hydrant Flushing

The Town will be flushing hydrants on **June 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>**. During this process, you may experience fluctuations in pressure and discoloured water. Although the water does not pose a health risk, it is recommended to avoid drinking the water until it runs clear. It is ok to use the water for showering, bathing and toilet flushing; however, do not use it for laundry during this time.



## Community Safety Reminders

We can help with local law enforcement! Report any all suspicious activity, break-ins and erratic driving to the RCMP by phone or fill in an incident report form. Reporting these incidents to the RMCP helps track where the RCMP need to have their staff monitoring. To report incidents:

- Fill out an Incident Report Form on-line at [www.townofbalgonie.ca](http://www.townofbalgonie.ca).
- Call the White Butte Detachment at 306-781-5050.
- If an incident involves a student's behaviour during the school day, the report should also be made to Greenall High School at 306-771-2566.

## Paying Tax & Utility Bills Online

Utility and tax bills may be paid through your online banking service. Please use **Balgonie (Town of) Taxes** for your taxes and **Balgonie (Town of) Utilities** for your water/sewer bills. If you are unsure of your account number, please contact the Town Office to obtain your account number.

When making an online payment, allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is receipted prior to any penalties being applied to your account.

## Street Sweeping

Street sweeping crews will be busy cleaning Town streets again this year. Street Sweeping will take place **May 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>**, weather dependent.



Please ensure all vehicles and obstacles are removed from the streets during these days.

## Street Parking Reminder

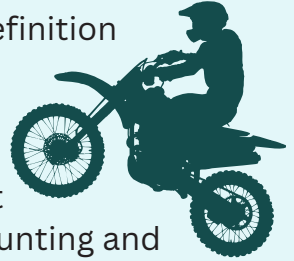
Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except on weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair.

Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a “nuisance” by Town of Balgonie bylaws.



## ATV Reminder

Vehicles that fall under the definition of All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) are not allowed on any street within town limits, except for the purpose of crossing to get to the closest point of exit. Stunting and driving on walking paths is not permitted, as it is a major safety concern for those who are walking on the path. Please keep our community safe by following ATV legislation.

## Reminder to Pet Owners

To be a responsible pet owner, follow these 5 easy steps!



1. Walk your pet on a leash.
2. If your pet is aggressive, walk on the other side of the street away from people.
3. Pick up after your pet. There are multiple garbage cans located throughout the town for you to use.
4. Spay/neuter your pet.
5. License your pet at the Town Office. Fines are \$40 if a dog is found “at large”.

## Gopher Control

The Town of Balgonie is committed to responsibly controlling pests. Spring is the best time for application as the gophers emerge from their burrows in search of food.



The Town uses Rozol RTU, which is approved by Health Canada. Town Maintenance staff put small amounts of Rozol RTU deep down in gopher holes where it is consumed by the gopher.

Areas with recently applied product will be marked with red signs. Signs will be removed once staff are satisfied that the site is clear of product.

Residents are encouraged to take precautions and avoid the marked areas, particularly those with children and pets. We urge residents to keep their pets on a leash or avoid these posted areas entirely.

## Transfer Station Terms & Conditions - Action Required

The Town of Balgonie provides residents with a Transfer Station that is licensed and compliant with environmental regulations set forth by the Ministry of Environment and the Clean Air Act. Illegal and improper dumping jeopardizes the service that benefits our community.

In order to ensure that residents with Transfer Station cards fully understand the rules, residents are asked to return the Transfer Station Terms and Conditions form on page 25 of this newsletter. **Please read, initial, sign and return the form to our office no later than July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026.** Following this date, cards for properties that have not been returned will be deactivated until the form is returned.



Thank you for your assistance in keeping our Transfer Station a continued service in our community.



## Loraas Disposal Bin at the Transfer Station

**Spring Bins** - Loraas Disposal will be delivering five (5) consecutive red bins at the Transfer Station starting May 8<sup>th</sup>. Once all 5 bins have been filled, there will be no more red bins brought to the Transfer Station in May. There is no specific time as to when the bin will arrive on these days.

If a red bin is NOT available or is full, do NOT leave any items where the bin is normally located or add more to it. Residents have been fined (up to \$500) and their cards have been suspended.

Be courteous of others! Large items and multiple loads take up the entirety of the bin, making it unusable for other residents. If you have multiple large items, please take them to the Regina Landfill.

Home builders/developers are not permitted to use the red Loraas bin.

Town Councillor 2012-2024*



Sincere condolences are offered to the family of former Town Councillor, Kelvin Solie.

Councillor Solie was elected and served on the Town Council for four consecutive terms from 2012 up to 2024 when he submitted his resignation to focus on his health. In each election, Kelvin Solie received a majority of the councillor-at-large votes.

His positive approach and good-hearted nature made him a great advocate for ratepayers and a proud ambassador for the Town of Balgonie. As a Council member, Kelvin demonstrated his commitment to the Town of Balgonie through his preparation for meetings, asking questions and offering practical solutions to meet the needs of the community.

During his last term, he acted as the Town's Deputy Mayor and over the course of his terms served on the following committees: Finance; Protective Services; Equipment, Maintenance and Engineering; Public Works & Utilities; and, Planning and Development.

During his time on Council, he played an integral part in decision making for many large infrastructure projects such as the 2013 Water Project (supply line and reservoir), 2017 Lagoon Expansion, 2019 Administration Building Renovation and additional sanitary sewer improvements from 2020-2022. A strong advocate for emergency services and recreation, Kelvin was actively involved in making choices which improve our community and enhance its safety. As a resident of this community, he had the reputation of being a friendly, thoughtful and an all-around great guy.

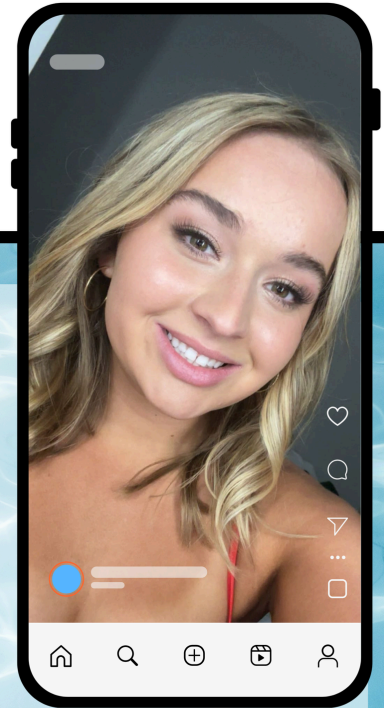
**SOCCER & MINOR BALL NEWS!** Outdoor soccer, baseball and softball will all be underway at the beginning of May!

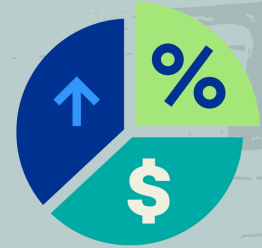


# 2026 BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

Approved April 20, 2026

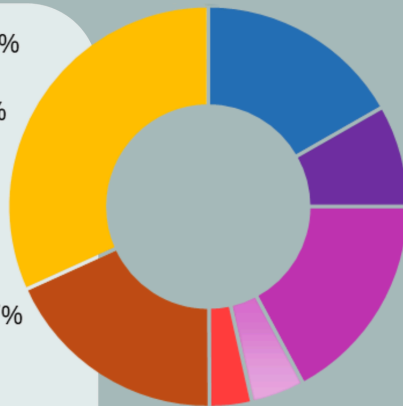
## Revenues

- ▶ Base Property Tax Increase remains the same at \$725
- ▶ 2026 Mill Rate is set at 5.972, which is an increase of 1.5% from 2025. This will offset some of the recent inflationary increases to costs for the Town.
- ▶ Transfer from Reserves/Surplus: \$525,775
- ▶ Ice rate rental increase 3% for 2026-2027 season
- ▶ Municipal Revenue Sharing Grant from the province has increased by \$46,361 for a total of \$566,024. The Municipal Revenue Sharing Grant is paid on a per capita based on 2021 Census for Balgonie of 1756 persons. The 2026 Census will impact future revenue sharing. **The Town encourages all residents to participate in the 2026 Census so future grants will be allocated correctly with an accurate population.**



## Operational Expense Budget

- Planning & Development - 4%
- Environmental Services - 4%
- Protective Services - 8%
- General Government - 17%
- Transportation Services - 17%
- Recreation & Culture - 18%
- Water & Sewer - 32%

- ✓ Your information is protected & kept strictly confidential
- ✓ Participation in the Census is mandatory, according to the Statistics Act



**Beginning in early May, the 2026 Census will start!** Census employees (enumerators) will be dropping off Census packages to Balgonie residents. Enumerators will have a Stats Canada ID card that includes their name, employment number and photo. Enumerators may visit in-person or call residents. Text messages will come from the short code "236732".

**Your voice matters!** Taking a few minutes to complete the Census helps ensure small towns, like Balgonie, are accurately counted, fairly represented and better positioned for sustainable growth for the years ahead. The Census influences decisions related to health care, education, transportation, housing, emergency services and infrastructure.

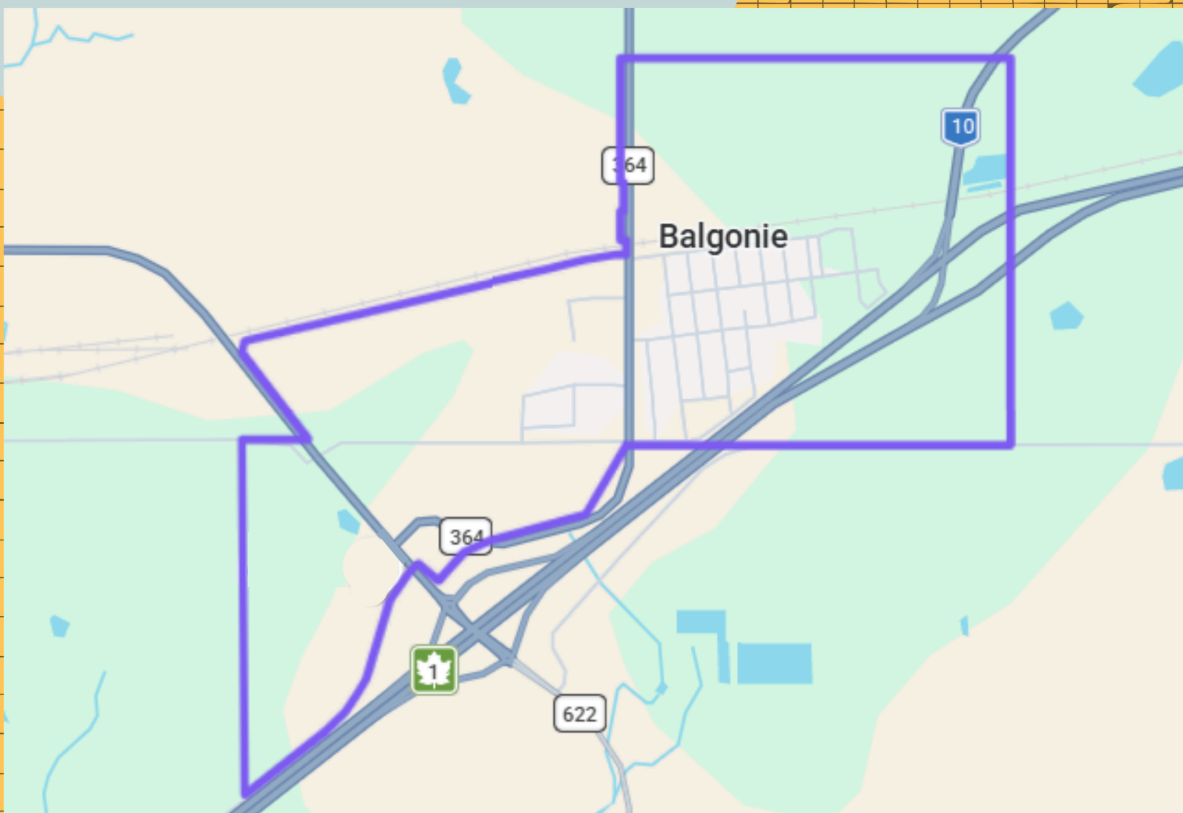

## Terms and Conditions of Access to the Town Transfer Station

**\*\*\*Please initial each point and sign at the bottom\*\*\***

\_\_\_\_\_ The Transfer Station is electronically set up and monitored to provide our Town residents with accessibility day and night. The Town of Balgonie offers on site services at the Transfer Station, but has the added responsibility to ensure that environmental regulations are followed. Municipalities can be fined for burning unapproved items and not properly disposing of items set forth by the Ministry of Environment and the *Clean Air Act*.

\_\_\_\_\_ The card holder will be held accountable for all occurrences at the Transfer Station whether they accessed the Transfer Station themselves or provided their card to another individual in their household. Lending the card out to another residence in Town or anyone else is definitely NOT PERMITTED.

\_\_\_\_\_ Transfer Station cards are initially provided to the "New" home owner at no charge. However, if a card is lost, it must be reported to the Town Office immediately to be disabled. The card will be removed from the system and a new card, if requested, will be provided at a cost of \$40.00.

\_\_\_\_\_ The red Loraas Disposal bin is currently delivered on the first (1<sup>st</sup>) and third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Friday of every month. There is no specific time as to when the bin will arrive on these days. **IF A RED BIN IS UNAVAILABLE, DO NOT LEAVE ANY ITEMS WHERE THE BIN IS NORMALLY LOCATED.** Individuals who leave items which are not permitted will be fined up to \$500.00, and will have their Transfer Station card suspended. Additional fines may be levied by the Ministry for individuals dumping illegally.

\_\_\_\_\_ Be courteous of others! Although the bin may be available, large items and multiple loads take up most of the bin, making it unusable for other residents. If you have multiple large items, please take them to the Regina Landfill.

\_\_\_\_\_ Home builders/developers are NOT permitted to use the red Loraas Disposal bin and are required to rent their own waste container bins.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Items that may be left at the Transfer Station in their designated areas:**

- Scrap Metal
  - Propane tanks are accepted in the scrap metal pile
  - Please remove the Freon from fridges and freezers
- Tree Branch/Grass/Leaf Piles
  - Absolutely NO treated or painted wood
  - Grass and leaves must be UNBAGGED
- Compostable Materials
  - Bags or boxes containing compostable materials are NOT to be left in the compost area
- Oil Recycling Station
- Cement

\_\_\_\_\_ **Items that can NOT be left at the Transfer Station or in the red Loraas Disposal bin:**

- Tires and Shingles

\_\_\_\_\_ **Items you are encouraged to recycle at SARCAN:**

- Beverage Containers, Batteries, Electronics, Household Paint and
- Non-Beverage Glass Containers (only accepted at Regina and Saskatoon SARCAN locations)

\_\_\_\_\_ Items that are accepted or NOT accepted at the Transfer Station in Balgonie may be subject to change. Be sure to follow the current signage.

\_\_\_\_\_ **IF YOU ARE MOVING** – You must **RETURN** the Transfer Station card back to the Town Office so we can provide it to the new home owners.

# DID YOU KNOW?

The Transfer Station is set up with an electronic card system which allows residents to access it 24/7.

On the 1st and 3rd Friday of each month, Loraas Disposal delivers a 40-yard bin to the Transfer Station. The purpose of the 40-yard bin is to allow residents to dispose of additional household waste that does not fit in their black roll-out bin.

## Unaccepted items

- Shingles;
- Railway ties, telephone poles and creosote treated wood;
- Bulbs and Light Ballasts;
- Hazardous materials such as tires, propane tanks, car batteries, paint, oil and chemicals;
- Appliances containing Freon;
- Construction/renovation material;
- Waste from households outside of Balgonie.

Please note: the unaccepted items listed above pertain to the 40-yard bin only. There are designated areas at the transfer station where some items listed above are accepted.

## Who can use your transfer station card?

- Members of your household can use it.
- Lending your card out to another person and/or disposing of waste from households outside of Balgonie is not permitted.
- The cardholder will be held accountable for all occurrences at the transfer station, such as illegal dumping.

## Illegal dumping

The Town of Balgonie has the responsibility to ensure regulations are followed based on the Approval to Operate issued to the Town by the Ministry of Environment.

Public Works Staff inspect the Transfer Station every morning. If it is determined that an illegal dump has taken place and/or items are placed in the incorrect disposal area, an investigation will commence. The resident at fault will be fined and their access card will be suspended for up to 6 months.

## Disposing of large items

When residents dispose of large items such as couches, mattresses, and box springs in the 40-yard bin:

- it limits another resident's ability to dispose of their items in the bin;
- the bin is removed from the Transfer Station quicker, creating a longer waiting period for when it is scheduled to return.

In addition to the inconvenience it causes others by placing large items in the bin, the Town of Balgonie is required to pay a burial surcharge to Loraas Disposal if there are more than 4 pieces of bedding per load (mattresses and box springs), wood or metal longer than 7' or coils of wire or banding.

## Designated disposal areas

### Cement Pile

- Cement free of other debris may be disposed of.

### Metal Pile

- All appliances and metal are permitted. Ensure the Freon is removed from fridges/freezers.
- Propane tanks are permitted.

### Grass/Leaves

- Bags and boxes are not permitted in this pile.

### Trees, Branches and Untreated Wood Pile

- Treated wood, painted wood, cardboard, drywall etc. are not permitted in this pile.

### Oil Recycling Centre

- Empty oil into the oil recycling bin.
- Place the oil containers and filters in the bin next to the oil recycling bin.

### Diabetes Canada Clothing Bin

- Do not leave bags beside the bin if it is full.

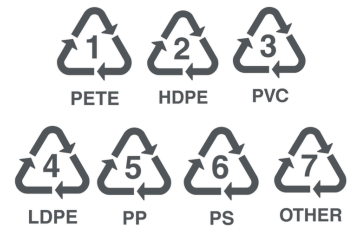

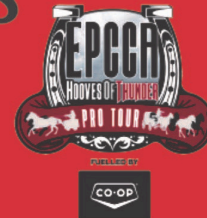

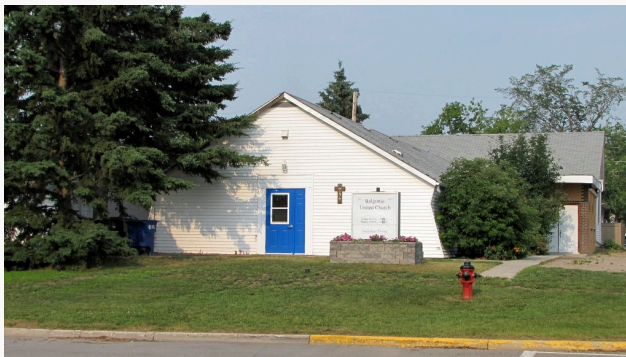
