# QUESTIONS FREQUENTLY ASKED REGARDING APPEALING YOUR PROPERTY ASSESSMENT

(The following questions and answers are taken from the pamphlet "Understanding the Property Assessment Appeal Process" from the Saskatchewan Government Relations, Provincial Municipal Relations and Advisory Services)

#### What is Property Assessment?

Property assessment is the process of determining a property's assessed value as of a specific date for property tax purposes. The assessment provides an estimate of the property's value that reflects typical market conditions.

Local governments use property assessments as a basis for the distribution of property taxes among property owners.

<u>Assessment is not the same as property tax.</u>

The assessment of a property is the value assigned to it as the basis for allocating taxes among various classes of property.

#### Who Can I Contact to Explain My Assessment?

You should start with your administrator of your municipality (Phone 306-771-2284). You can also call SAMA (Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency) at 306-537-7295 as it is the agency that performs Balgonie's assessments.

#### **Preparing the Notice of Appeal Form**

When making an assessment appeal, the notice of appeal form must be fully completed. You must provide specific grounds supporting the appeal. You are required to provide as many details as possible and all facts and evidence that an error has been made in the:

- valuation of the property;
- → classification of the property;
- preparation of the relevant assessment roll or assessment notice; and/or

content of the relevant assessment roll or assessment notice.

The grounds for the appeal must be detailed. Phrases such as "assessment too high" or "assessment too low" are **NOT** sufficient.

It is your responsibility to make a case to the board of revision. It may be as simple as proving that dimensions or measurements are wrong or that a classification is not correct, or as complex as proving that the value of a property is not fairly assessed compared to another property that is similar in nature.

#### **Regular Assessment Appeals or Simplified Assessment Appeals?**

When making regular or simplified assessment appeals, the notice of appeal form must be fully completed. Regular appeal – the appellant must provide specific written grounds supporting the appeal when submitting it to the secretary before the hearing. Simplified appeal - the appellant is not required to submit detailed written grounds to the secretary before the hearing but must have detailed information ready to present to the appeal board.

#### Can I Base My Appeal on the Fact that I Feel my <u>Taxes</u> are Too High?

NO! Legislation outlines the valid grounds of appeal. Only your property assessment can be appealed, not taxes or mill rates.

Notice is hereby given that the Assessment Roll for the Town of Balgonie for the year of **2015** has been prepared and is open to inspection in the Office of the Assessor during normal business hours from 9 a.m. to noon and 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. on Monday to Friday, March **27** to April **27**, **2015**, exclusive of holidays.

A bylaw pursuant to section 214 of *The Municipalities Act* has been passed and the assessment notices have been sent as required.

Any person who wishes to appeal against his or her assessment is required to file his or her notice of appeal accompanied by a \$50.00 fee for each assessment being appealed, which will be returned if the appeal is successful, with: The Secretary of the Board of Revision, c/o Town of Balgonie, Box 310, Balgonie, SK SOG 0E0, by the 27th day of April, 2015.

2015 property taxes will be set as part of the budget process for the Town Council.

#### Property taxes have not yet been determined for the 2015 year.

#### PROPERTY ASSESSMENT DOES NOT EQUAL PROPERTY TAX

SAMA's role in determining assessed value for properties is just the first part of a process established by provincial legislation. The second part is application of provincial government established tax policy, such as property classes and percentage of value, and statutory exemptions. The third and final part of the process involves municipalities determining the local mill rate annually based on local budget needs. The province also sets the mill rate for the education sector. Municipalities then multiply the taxable assessment by the local mill rate\* to produce property tax levies, also known as your property tax bill.

\*Municipalities have the authority to use a series of tax tools ranging from mill rate factors to minimum taxes. For more information on tax tools and exemptions see the Ministry of Government Relations website (www.municipal.gov.sk.ca).

## **Do Your Renovations Require a Permit?**

There is often confusion about what types of renovations require a building permit and what do not. A simple rule of thumb is to ask:

1. Are there any structural changes?

(i.e. If replacing windows, are you simply removing one and inserting another of same size without the need to add or remove any studs or supports? If no supporting headers or lintels are affected and if the size meets NBC requirements for bedrooms, then a permit is likely not required. If however, the new windows are a different size than the existing ones, then the structural frame is affected and may require a building permit.) Painting, replacing flooring, and most cosmetic upgrades that do not affect the structure of the building generally do not require a building permit.

2. Is there a change in occupancy use?

(i.e. is the renovation converting a garage from a storage space to a living space?) Change of use may have NBC/life safety implications that require a building permit or may effect municipal bylaws due to different setback requirements.

3. Are there any life safety implications?

(i.e. installing new windows in bedrooms that do not meet NBC requirements for fire safety, or replacing kitchen cabinets with ones that are now too close to the cook stove.)

When in doubt, please have your ratepayers email our office to describe their renovation project. These emails will be forwarded to the proper Building Official and the municipality will be CC:ed with the response.



## STOP AND CHECK THE RECYCLING LIST!!!

Many residents are recycling and reducing the amount of household waste that goes to the landfill. We can even do better by making sure everyone in the household is checking labels before tossing items into the trash.



Please post this information near your garbage can!!

Things that can go into your blue curbside recycling carts in Balgonie.

- **Cardboard and Paper:** Cardboard and paperboard such as empty laundry detergent boxes, cereal boxes, tissue boxes, shoe boxes, chocolate boxes, paper and cardboard packaging from Christmas gifts, newspapers, flyers, inserts, junk mail and envelopes, magazines, catalogues, telephone books, paperback books, hardcover books with spines removed, paper bags, toilet paper and paper towel cores, gift and packing paper, paper egg cartons, copier paper, and NCR paper (No carbon required)
- **Aluminum & Tin:** Soft drink and beer cans, foil trays and pie plates, and household tin cans. These items should be rinsed before placing in recycling bin.
- **Plastic**: Containers with logo 1-7, plastic bags, plastic drink bottles and plastic wrap. This would include things like: packaging from toys and electronics, lids from milk jugs and soda bottles, shampoo bottles, hairspray, lotion, cleaning bottles, empty salad dressing bottles, mayonnaise bottles.
- Aseptic Packaging and Cartons: Juice and milk cartons, milk jugs, tetrapak containers, pouches

How should you prepare recyclables before putting them in the bin?

Flatten all cardboard boxes. Wash and rinse all food and beverage containers. Remove all lids and caps from containers.

Sorry, we do not accept the following in the **Loraas Single Stream Recycling carts.** 

- Glass
- Household garbage, organics, or hazardous waste
- Waxed, plasticized or food contaminated paper, cardboard cups or plastic plates
- Soiled tissues, napkins and paper towels
- Confetti shredded paper
- Styrofoam or other foam packing materials
- Auto parts or batteries



## **DRAFT RULES**

#### **AUCTION**

- Team bidding points = 1000 points
- Minimum bid = 10 points.

#### **SCORING**

- Player scoring 1 point / goal 1 point / assist
- Goalie scoring 1 point / win 2 points / shutout -1 point / goal -1 point / assist

#### **DRAFT ORDER**

- The 1<sup>st</sup> round (1 selection per team) draft order is determined at the auction by the bidding teams.
