#### **ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS:**

Taxes and utility bills may be paid electronically through your online banking website. The payments would be under Town of Balgonie Taxes and Town of Balgonie Utilities.

(Do not choose Balgonie Water—this payee is a previous business and is not connected with the Town of Balgonie.)

Please contact the Town office to obtain your account numbers.

Electronic payments for utilities and taxes are a convenient way to pay your bills, but they are not instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is receipted by our office before any penalties apply. The bank requires time to process the payment and advise the Town.

The receipts for electronic payments will be available for pickup or mailed or emailed upon request.

**TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS** are open to the public. They are regularly scheduled on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of every month starting at 6:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Balgonie Administration Building.

Council meetings are scheduled for May 11th and 25th, 2015

#### **Reminder to Balgonie Residents:**

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.

#### Fats, Oils, and Grease -

#### Store it, don't pour it.

Pouring fats, oils, and grease down your drain can cause significant problems in your home sewer system as it solidifies in your pipes and causes sewer back up. The result can be property damage and considerable ex-



pense and inconvenience to you and to the Town of Balgonie. Used cooking oils and grease should be cooled and put into a container with a lid for storage that can be put into the garbage receptacle.

#### **Blocked Sewer Drains:**

Blockages in the sewer lines are the homeowner's responsibility. The Town of Balgonie may issue a reimbursement for sewer cleanout only if it is on the Town portion and due to tree roots. A Town of Balgonie should be called to have an employee present when the plumbing company inspects the line. Please call our office to arrange this: 306-771-2284 or after hours 306-535-4235.

Reimbursement for the plumbing costs will not be paid if our office is not called, or if the blockage is due to disposal of improper items.

#### PLEASE PLACE THESE ITEMS IN THE TRASH! DO NOT FLUSH!!

sanitary napkins tampons and applicators q-tips

cotton balls condoms diapers/pull ups

incontinence products sanitary wipes kleenex

paper towels napkins cosmetic pads

cleaning wipes disposable toilet brushes sponges

needles razors grease

All of the above items have been found in Town sewer lift station screens and have caused drainage issues. These materials do not "break down" in the sewer system. These items travel down the sewer system and combine with other items and cause a blockage at some point in the line. These blockages cost property owners directly through blockages to their homes or indirectly through the costs to the Town for removal.

#### **NEW ZONING BYLAW** - Recreational Vehicle Parking

#### NOTICE TO RESIDENTS IN THE TOWN OF BALGONIE

As per the ZONING BYLAW 374/2014, there are now seasonal restrictions on the parking and storage of recreational vehicles such as campers and motor homes which are used for travelling and recreational activities.

#### 5.6.8 Residential Parking

- B) No parking of any class A or C motor home, any travel trailer, fifth wheel trailer, boat or any similar vehicle shall be permitted in any front or side yard of a residence **from November 1 to April 1, inclusive**.
- C) Where recreational vehicle parking is provided for a detached dwelling unit during the period of **April 1 to November 1**, inclusive, the number of recreational vehicles shall not exceed two.
- D) Recreational vehicles may be parked in the front, rear or side yards on a drive way on residential sites from April 1 to November 1 inclusive, provided the vehicle is not within 2 metres (6.57 feet) of the outside edge of the curb.

## **Crime Prevention**

LOCK YOUR VEHICLE DOORS: Recently, there have been some thefts from vehicles in neighbouring communities. Items that are often left out in cars include cash, sunglasses, garage door openers, keys, etc. Please don't leave items in your vehicle which are in plain view and tempting to steal!

<u>REPORT CRIMES:</u> It is important to report <u>all crimes</u> to the White Butte R.C.M.P detachment. Although, you may feel that it is unnecessary to report, the R.C.M.P. use the information received to monitor crime trends. As well, patrols and staffing are allocated based on the statistics of crime. If incidents are not reported, the R.C.M.P. are not getting accurate information about crime in our community.



#### Do Your Renovations Require a Permit?

There is often confusion about what types of renovations require a building permit and what do not. A simple rule of thumb is to ask:

1. Are there any structural changes?

(i.e. If replacing windows, are you simply removing one and inserting another of same size without the need to add or remove any studs or supports? If no supporting headers or lintels are affected and if the size meets NBC requirements for bedrooms, then a permit is likely not required. If however, the new windows are a different size than the existing ones, then the structural frame is affected and may require a building permit.) Painting, replacing flooring, and most cosmetic upgrades that do not affect the structure of the building generally do not require a building permit.

2. Is there a change in occupancy use?

(i.e. is the renovation converting a garage from a storage space to a living space?) Change of use may have NBC/life safety implications that require a building permit or may effect municipal bylaws due to different setback requirements.

3. Are there any life safety implications?

(i.e. installing new windows in bedrooms that do not meet NBC requirements for fire safety, or replacing kitchen cabinets with ones that are now too close to the cook stove.)

When in doubt, please contact Professional Building Inspections to describe your renovation project. These emails will be forwarded to the proper Building Official and the municipality will be CC:ed with the response.

Many residents are recycling and reducing the amount of household waste that goes to the landfill. We can even do better by making sure



everyone in the household is checking labels before tossing items into the trash.

#### Please post this information near your garbage can!!

Things that can go into your blue curbside recycling carts in Balgonie.

- Cardboard and Paper: Cardboard and paperboard such as empty laundry detergent boxes, cereal boxes, tissue boxes, shoe boxes, chocolate boxes, paper and cardboard packaging from Christmas gifts, newspapers, flyers, inserts, junk mail and envelopes, magazines, catalogues, telephone books, paperback books, hardcover books with spines removed, paper bags, toilet paper and paper towel cores, gift and packing paper, paper egg cartons, copier paper, and NCR paper (No carbon required)
- Aluminum & Tin: Soft drink and beer cans, foil trays and pie plates, and household tin cans.
   These items should be rinsed before placing in recycling bin.
- **Plastic**: Containers with logo 1-7, plastic bags, plastic drink bottles and plastic wrap. This would include things like: packaging from toys and electronics, lids from milk jugs and soda bottles, shampoo bottles, hairspray, lotion, cleaning bottles, empty salad dressing bottles, mayonnaise bottles.
- Aseptic Packaging and Cartons: Juice and milk cartons, milk jugs, tetrapak containers, pouches

### How should you prepare recyclables before putting them in the bin?

Flatten all cardboard boxes. Wash and rinse all food and beverage containers. Remove all lids and caps from containers.




