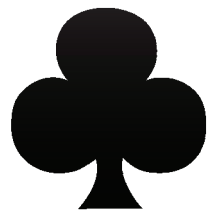

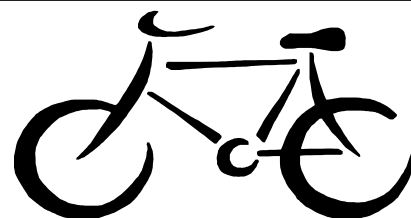

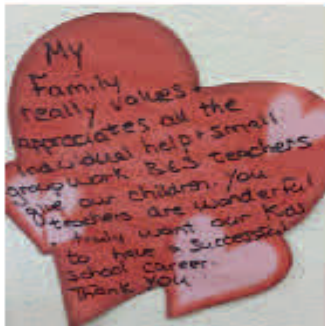

The Town of Balgonie office now has a **debit machine** which may be used to make payments for any bills with the Town of Balgonie. Credit cards are not accepted for payment due to the high transactions fees.

Any payments made to the Balgonie Recreation Board can be paid with cash or cheque only. The debit machine is only for Town payments.

## **ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS:**

**Taxes and Utility Bills may be paid electronically through your online banking website. The payments would be under Town of Balgonie Taxes and Town of Balgonie Utilities.**

**(Do not choose Balgonie Water—this payee is a previous business and is not connected with the Town of Balgonie.)**

**Please contact the Town office to obtain your account numbers.**

Electronic payments for Utilities and Taxes are a convenient way to pay your bills, but they are not instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is receipted by our office before any penalties apply. The bank requires time to process the payment and advise the Town.

**TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS** are open to the public. They are regularly scheduled on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of every month starting at 6:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Balgonie Administration Building.

**Town of Balgonie Residents:** Loraas Disposal Drivers have reported concerns with some garbage and recycling carts in Balgonie such overfilled containers and waste contaminated recycling carts.



They include:

**Recycling carts:** All recycling materials must be contained within the cart. All boxes should be flattened and broken down to fit into the cart. Larger boxes or cardboard pieces will not fit in

the chute on the truck. If your cart has larger cardboard boxes which are not broken down (SEE picture A), the cart **will not be picked up**. It is required that all large boxes and cardboard pieces be flattened or cut up. If recycling carts are contaminated with garbage, the cart **will not be picked up**. (See picture B).



**Garbage carts:** Garbage bags should fit within the garbage carts. If garbage bags are placed on top of the lid, your garbage **will not be picked up**. Overloading the garbage carts make it impossible for the truck operator to safely dump the cart.

It has been an adjustment for all Balgonie residents since the Town has started to receive recycling pickup and garbage pick up bi-weekly. We thank you for all of your efforts in helping Balgonie contribute to a greener environment. By diverting solid waste from the landfill and to the recycling centres, your household is creating a better future for the planet.

Remember there are a lot of things that can be recycled. We can keep our landfills from increasing in size by:

- Rinsing and Recycling all appropriate plastic containers: yogurt, margarine, sour cream, ketchup, salad dressing, shampoo, soap, detergent, milk jugs, plastic s with numbers 1-6
- Rinse and recycle tin cans
- Plastic grocery bags
- Newspapers, magazines, cardboard packaging, cardboard tissue rolls,
- Rinsed out milk cartons, juice boxes and tetra packs
- Plastic packaging, bubble wrap, cellophane wrapping: eg) plastic from paper towel packs, plastic from electronics/toys etc.

If you find that your recycling is overflowing, please flatten cans, plastic and cardboard boxes.

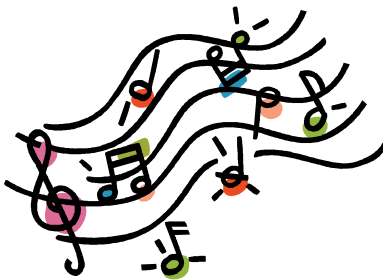

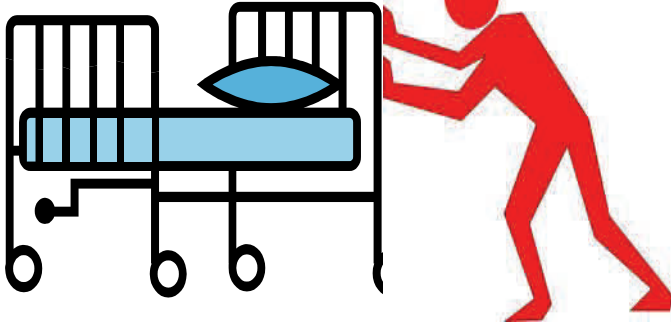

## Firefighter Training

Setting a house on fire on purpose will usually get you arrested but not if you do it for a good cause. Last October, Vale helped local volunteer firefighters coordinate a day-long training exercise on our property. Vale has been selling off a number of unused residential and farm storage buildings. Some of the houses didn't sell so we have been trying to find other useful ways to deal with them. We offered one particular property to local fire departments to use for training exercises. The fire crews from White City, Balgonie, Edenwold and Pilot Butte (who together form the White Butte Fire Commission) took us up on our offer. Together with the Kronau and District Emergency Response team, they conducted a joint training exercise on October 19, 2013 under the direction of trainers from the Saskatchewan Volunteer Firefighters Association. These exercises gave the firefighters the chance to practise techniques they are expected to use in a real-life emergency. Dave Campbell is Balgonie's volunteer fire chief who helped lead the exercise.

*"Joint training is extremely important because our crews so often find themselves working together. The training gives us a chance to get to know each other and become familiar with each other's equipment and capabilities."*

The exercise also allowed the fire crews to test out some new equipment. The Balgonie crew, in particular, was eager to try out new equipment for fighting bush and grass fires. Campbell describes the house fire as one of the largest training exercises in recent years. Altogether, 48 firefighters took part in the training. The exercise began at 8 a.m. and involved a controlled burn of two garages and the house. The scenario involved several stages – or "evolutions" – of a house fire, beginning with a "cold smoke" on the second floor followed by active live fires on the main floor.

*"We used a smoke generator to get visibility practically down to zero. This gave us an opportunity to train our firefighters in techniques for searching a house under limited visibility,"* says Campbell.

The teams also underwent refresher courses on how to spot a fire, the effect of water and cold on a house fire, the dangers of back-draft and how to keep oneself safe in a fire. The training followed strict provincial guidelines designed to ensure the safety of the firefighters, other buildings in the area and the environment. As part of this, there were no more than five students per instructor during the live fire stages. "We wanted to take full advantage of the training opportunity and Vale wanted to minimize the amount of post-fire clean up so we kept re-burning the house until it was basically just a pile of ash.

*"The exercises wrapped up at about 6 p.m."*

According to Campbell, everyone involved was grateful for the experience.

*"Everything went very well. We were all very impressed with the level of instruction and the emphasis on safety. Of course, safety is rule number one in firefighting. Joint training opportunities like these help us stay safe by making sure that we are all comfortable and familiar with each other when a real emergency arises."*

As part of the White Butte RCMP Detachment commitment to policing the communities surrounding the City of Regina, we have made contributing to safe roads one of our major objectives. Each month the White Butte Detachment members concentrate their enforcement efforts within your communities on specific offences from the Traffic Safety Act.

For the month of March, our focus will be on enforcing speed limits. The lawful speed limit within the Province of Saskatchewan is 80 km/hr. Lawfully posted speed limits on our Provincial highways are 100 km/hr unless the highway is divided at which point it increases to 110 km/hr.

Another speed limit that travellers will be familiar with is 60 km/hr. This speed limit is in effect in construction zones and the fine triples when there are workers present. The zone will indicate if there are workers present with proper signage. Even if there are no workers present the speeding fine will still apply so long as the speed limit sign is posted. The speed limit also drops to 60 km/hr when there are emergency vehicles (police, fire or ambulance) stationary on the road and their emergency lights are activated. The 60 km/hr speed limit is also in effect when a tow truck has its lights on and is providing assistance. In both of these circumstances the speed limit applies to all lanes of travel on that roadway and the fine starts with a base fine of \$140.00. The last circumstance where the 60 km/hr speed limit is in effect is when passing Department of Highways equipment that has its warning lights in operation whether that vehicle is moving or stationary.

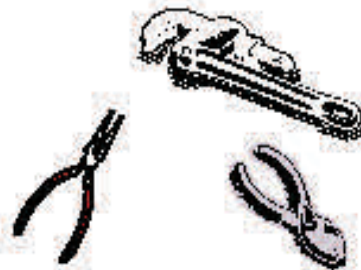
