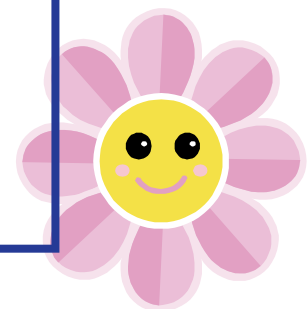

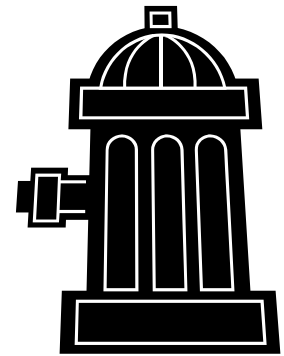

The Hydrants will be flushed throughout the Town on May 6th and 7th. This may produce some discoloration to the water with in the Town. While it is safe to drink, it may discolor laundry. It is advisable to refrain from washing clothing during this time.

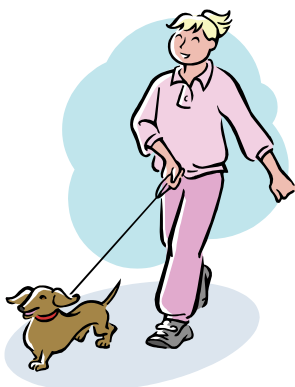
The Town Transfer Station will have spring clean up bins provided in the month of May. Garbage should only be placed in the red Loraas bins. If the bin has been removed to be emptied, please do not leave garbage behind. The Transfer station is not a dump or a landfill. Larger loads from renovations and fence removals should be taken to the Regina landfill.

Tree branch pile— for pruned branches and untreated, unpainted wood only

Grass/Leaf Pile — please empty clippings from all bags

BE A RESPONSIBLE PET OWNER:



- Walk your dog on a leash (there is no off leash area in the Town of Balgonie)
- Pick up after your dog—bring a baggy, pick it up and dispose of it. Keep the Town clean for all to enjoy.
- Spay /neuter your pet
- License your pet with the Town

Fines are applicable if your dog is found unlicensed, running at large or if you fail to pick up after your dog.

Balgonie Water Project:

The Town of Balgonie has started receiving water from Pilot Butte through the transmission line that was built this past year. During this transition phase, there may be some residual water in the system from our previous water sources. For the next month, you may notice changes in the water which you are receiving to your homes. There may be some subtle changes in the odor and taste as the chlorination levels are adjusted to the water supply. The



water from Pilot Butte is filtrated by Reverse Osmosis, which takes the minerals from the water. This may make the water taste slightly different.

After this testing phase of the project, the hardness of the water will be published, so that residents may make any necessary adjustments to their water softening systems.

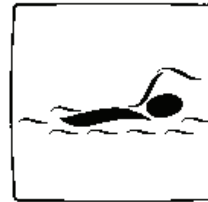
Swimming Lessons Registration Night

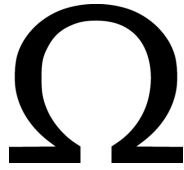

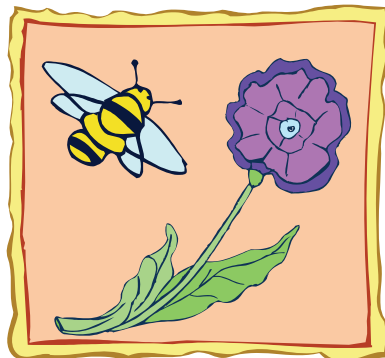
MIDDLE LEVEL DRAMA
